


See previous Land Corner Restoration - E-9 - September 1, 1975 - Surveyor 887 - Thomas R. Arnott - THENCE:

November 17, 1997 - Surveyor 2070 - Michael E. Weber - indicates this position as "aluminum capped monument found in place" on Forest Co. Surveyor File #341309-19971117.

June 29, 2004 - Surveyor 1910 - Matthew E. Hoglund - indicates this position as "2" county aluminum mon. found" on Forest Co. Surveyor File #341309-20040629.

September 7, 2003 - I found the very bottom of a Berntsen cast aluminum monument, with the magnet intact in the center of the monument. I also found 1 of Arnott's bearing trees. I set a new Forest County aluminum monument in place of the existing monument, being a 0.20' diameter pipe with a 0.27' diameter cap. I established 3 new bearing trees as shown below.

A-E 7.08(3)(e) 1865 Surveyor set a post, 1981 Surveyor set a 2.5" aluminum pipe with an alloy cap, subsequent surveyors found the same, as did I in 2023.

A-E 7.08(3)(f) I accept this monument as a FOUND PERPETUATED LOCATION of the corner. A-E 7.08(3)(g)(h) This corner was not determined through lost-corner-proportionate methods.

A-E 7.08(3)(i) I, Jeffrey L. DeMuth, Professional Land Surveyor No. S-2656, hereby certify that the comer location on this record was determined by me or under my direction and control, and that this U.S. Public Land Survey Monument Record is correct and pomplete to the best of my knowledge, and belief.


