

Unknown Forest County Surveyor File # 341319 is a partial copy of a map by an unknown surveyor in the southwest quarter of Section

19. The map shows a bearing on the north-south quarter line that lines up with the found 1-1/4" dia. iron rod.

10/08/2025 I found and accepted a 1-1/4" dia. iron rod 3" above grade at the corner location along with four existing iron pipes as reference monuments next to bearing trees with blazes and tags. The found iron rod is online between the southeast and southwest corners of Section 18 and seems to match up with the partial survey map in the southwest quarter of Section

19. (File #341319) . The corner is witnessed as shown below.
