

At the point determined for the location of the corner I emplaced a:

*#GALVANIZED IRON PIPE, THREE FEET LONG, ONE INCH IN DIAMETER, WITH AN ALUMINUM CAP DENOTED AS, KIMBERLY-CLARK CORP T34N S 1/16 BTWN 24 & 19 R13-14E SPERHAKE RLS 463 11-15-62".

Description as to how corner was located.

Since both the quarter section corner one quarter mile north, and the section corner one quarter mile south have been previously established, with a distance between them of $40.12\frac{1}{2}$ chains, the 1/16th corner was set $80.06\frac{1}{4}$ chains from either corner, on a straight line between them.
