


(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

In 1859 James McBride set a wood post and the following bearing trees; Hemlock, 7", N.74°W., 19 links (12.54 feet), Hemlock, 7", S.10°W., 39 links (25.74 feet), 4.50 chains East leave swamp, 12.00 chains West over lake.

In 1910 and 1911 Nathan Smith R.L.S., found the witness corner with both of the original bearing trees. Measured East 45.90 chains (3029.40 feet), to section corner. Also measured West 36.14 chains (2385.24 feet) to section corner.

On November 15, 1993, Alan Harrison, R.L.S., restored the corner by retracement of N. Smiths North Section line and utilizing the occupation within Section 27 for verification of corners location. Set a $2\ 1/12$ " x 36" Aluminum Monument and new bearing trees as noted below.
