
U. S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS:

This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through 1).

(a) (dentify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system. O . Corner monument restored.

Section corner common to Sections 27, 28, 33 and 34, T.34N., R.15E., Forest County, Wisconsin.




(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

In 1859, James McBride set corner post and the following bearing tress: Tamarack, 6", N.24°W., 22 links (14.52 feet), Tamarack, 7", N.46°E., 33 links (21.78 feet), Spruce, 7", S.37°W., 20 links (13.20 feet), Tamarack, 7", S.37°W., 47 links (31.02 feet), 5.00 chains South, stream 20 links wide bears East. 9.00 chains East, stream 20 links wide, runs Northeast.

In 1906, Nathan Smith's highway survey recovered original witness stumps and a stake set by W.L. Harris.

On June 10, 1993, Alan D. Harrison (RLS) restored the corner using retracement of N. Smith's 1906 survey, the center-line of an old road and creek calls East and South.
