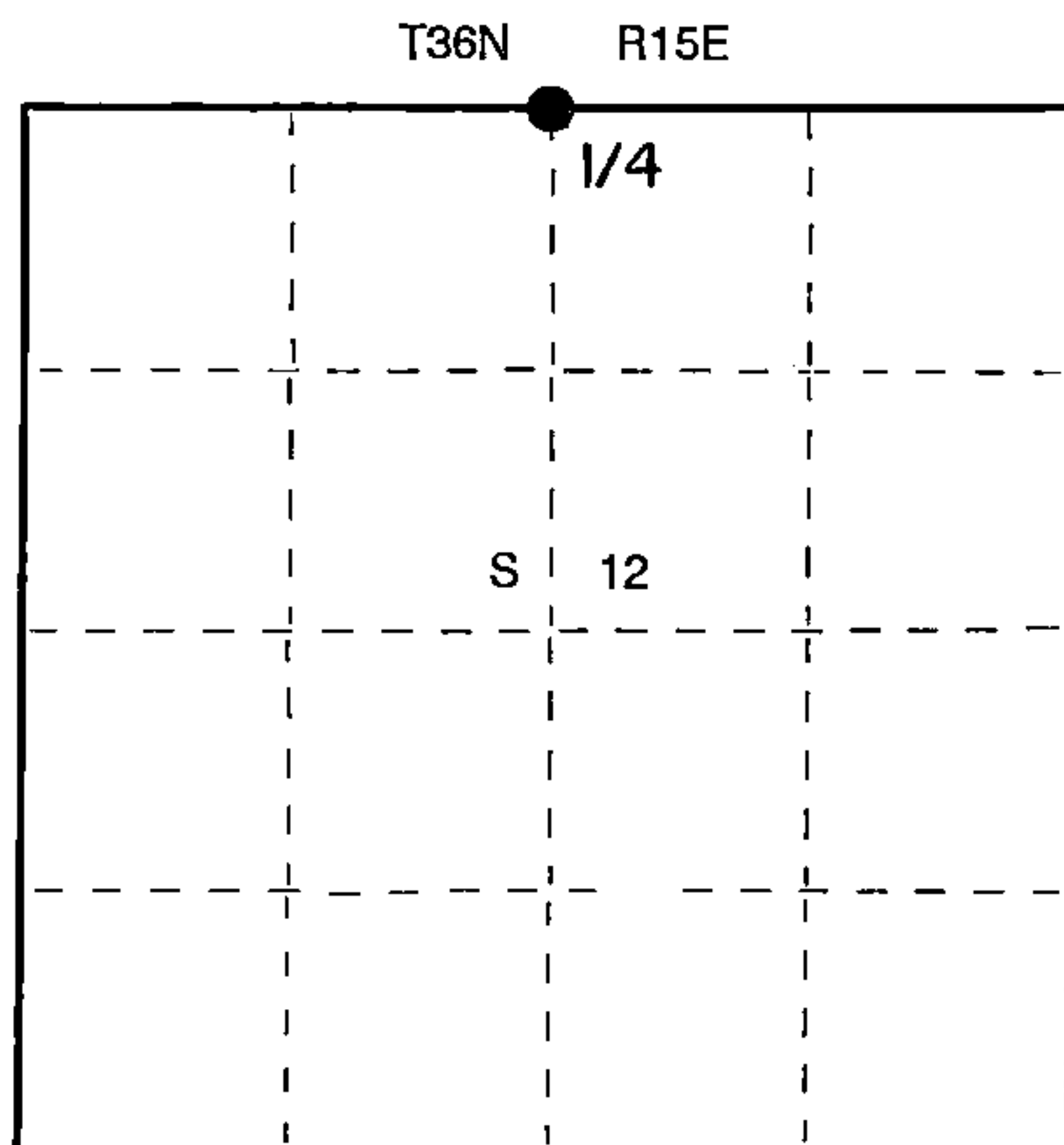

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established by A. Curtis, Deputy Surveyor in 1858 from which 10" Fir bears
N36W, 11 lks. and Aspen bears S48E, 10 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

Re-established Quarter Section Corner by proportional measurement. Total distance from
previous northwest and northeast Section Corner of Section 12 is 5221.22'. Set Quarter
Section Corner 2610.61' intermediate.

No evidence of original or other corner or accessories. Corner position
sets on north edge of old clearing. Tested original call west of re-established
corner to swamp 3.25 chs. Distance very good.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.
Set a 2 - 1/4" Aluminum Forest County Monument with 3 - 1/4" alloy cap.
Monument projects 7" above ground.

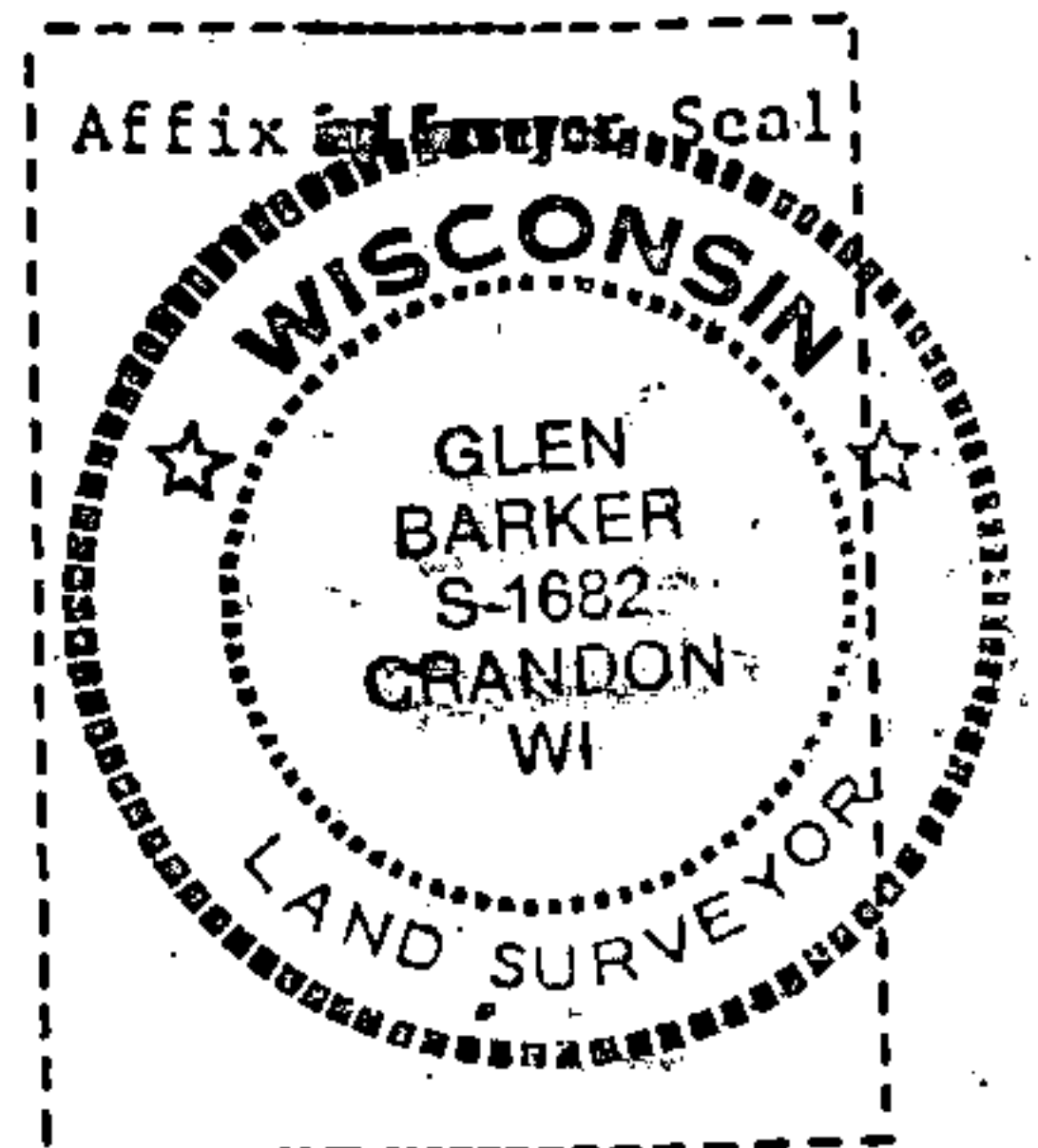
