Description of corner evidence found:

Railroad records indicated corner was located in the center of the East-West town road. At the North and South Sixteenth corners of Sections 8 and 9 old fence corners were recovered. The distance was then doubled from the respective Section corners to locate the Quarter corner.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Set 2 1/2" diameter aluminum pipe monument, 30 inches long, 3 feet in the ground with an aluminum cap stamped T37N, R12E, 1/4, S8, S9, 1987, S-1665. Established the following bearing trees which are blazed, scribed, painted and tagged.

> White Birch 10" S50°E 23.89 feet Black Ash N62°E 31.14 feet Tamarack N48°W 82.59 feet Red Maple S84°W 102.67 feet Steel sign post 14.1 feet Southeast


