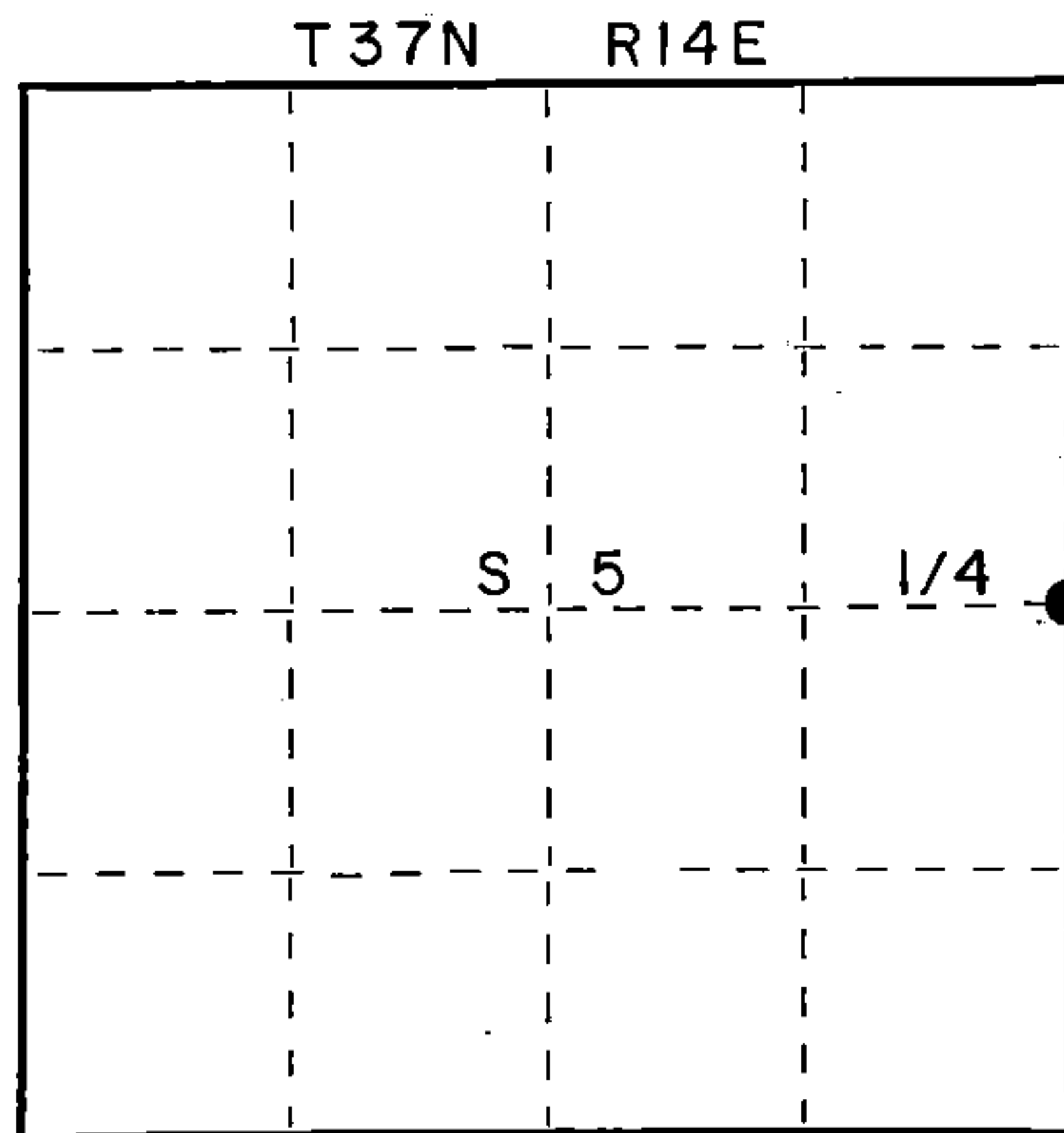

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner established by J.L. Nowlin, Deputy Surveyor, in 1865  
from which Fir 5" bears N54 E 20 lks and Fir 6" S80 W 10 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered an old cedar stake rotted off at ground level. Found old stake  
point, also old beaver blazes on Hemlock 10" S80°E 12.22' and cedar 10"  
S35°W 35.70'.

Corner perpetuated by Consolidated foresters and P.T. Hansen, Registered  
Land Surveyor since the late 1930's.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.  
Set a 2 1/4" aluminum Forest County monument with 3 1/4" alloy cap stamped:  
Monument projects 18" above ground.
