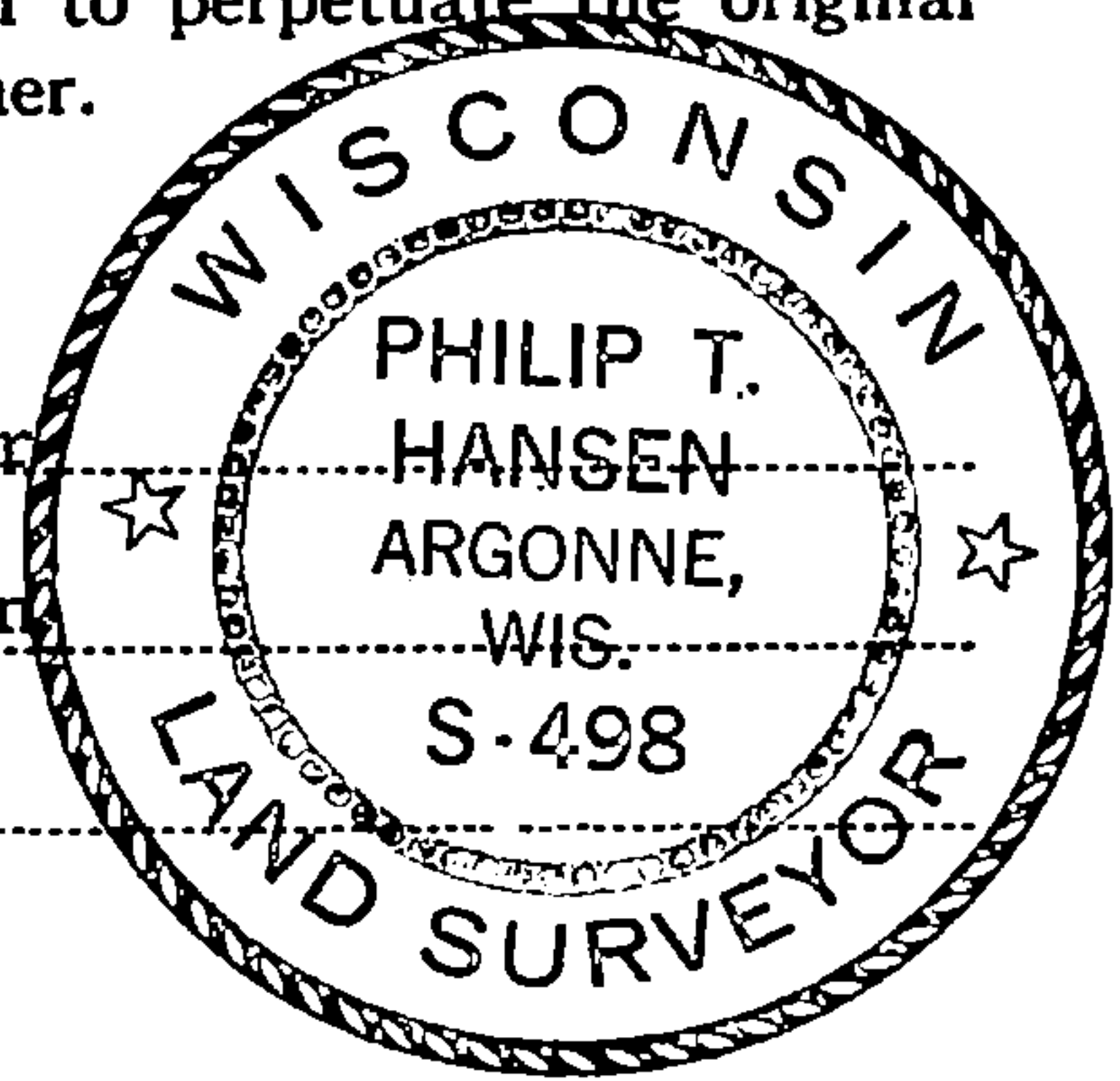

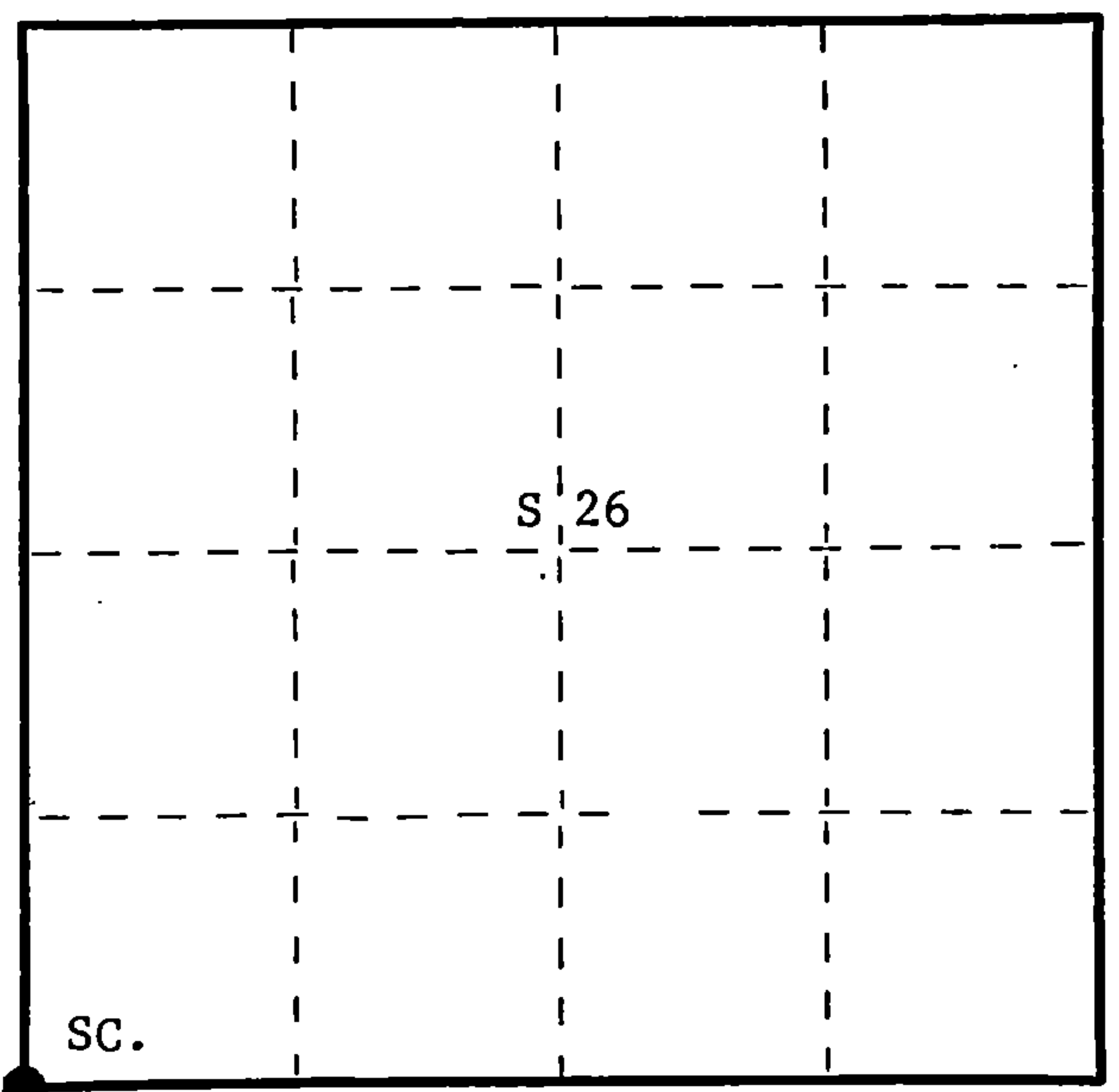

History of original corner establishment: Original corner established by James McBride, Deputy Surveyor, in 1859.

No record of any subsequent surveys made.

This corner recovered by Ray Leigh in 1945. Recovered old wooden stake with an old iron pipe wired to it. Replaced old wood stake with 4" cedar post, squared and scribed.

Description of corner evidence found: Recovered 4" cedar post, squared and scribed S.26, 27, 34, and 35 in poor condition. Also recovered an old wooden squared cedar stake and a 1-1/2" iron pipe wired to it.

There was no trace of any OBT's visible in the area.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced 4" cedar post with 2-1/2" Berntsen, A-1 Federal Monument, aluminum with magnet installed in cap and base. Pipe projects 18" above ground. Set 4" cedar post and old cedar post beside new pipe. Cap stamped -

S498

T37N R15E

This corner sets in a tag alder marsh, no trees near for BT's. Set two witness corners, 1-1/2" iron pipe with 2" brass cap stamped.

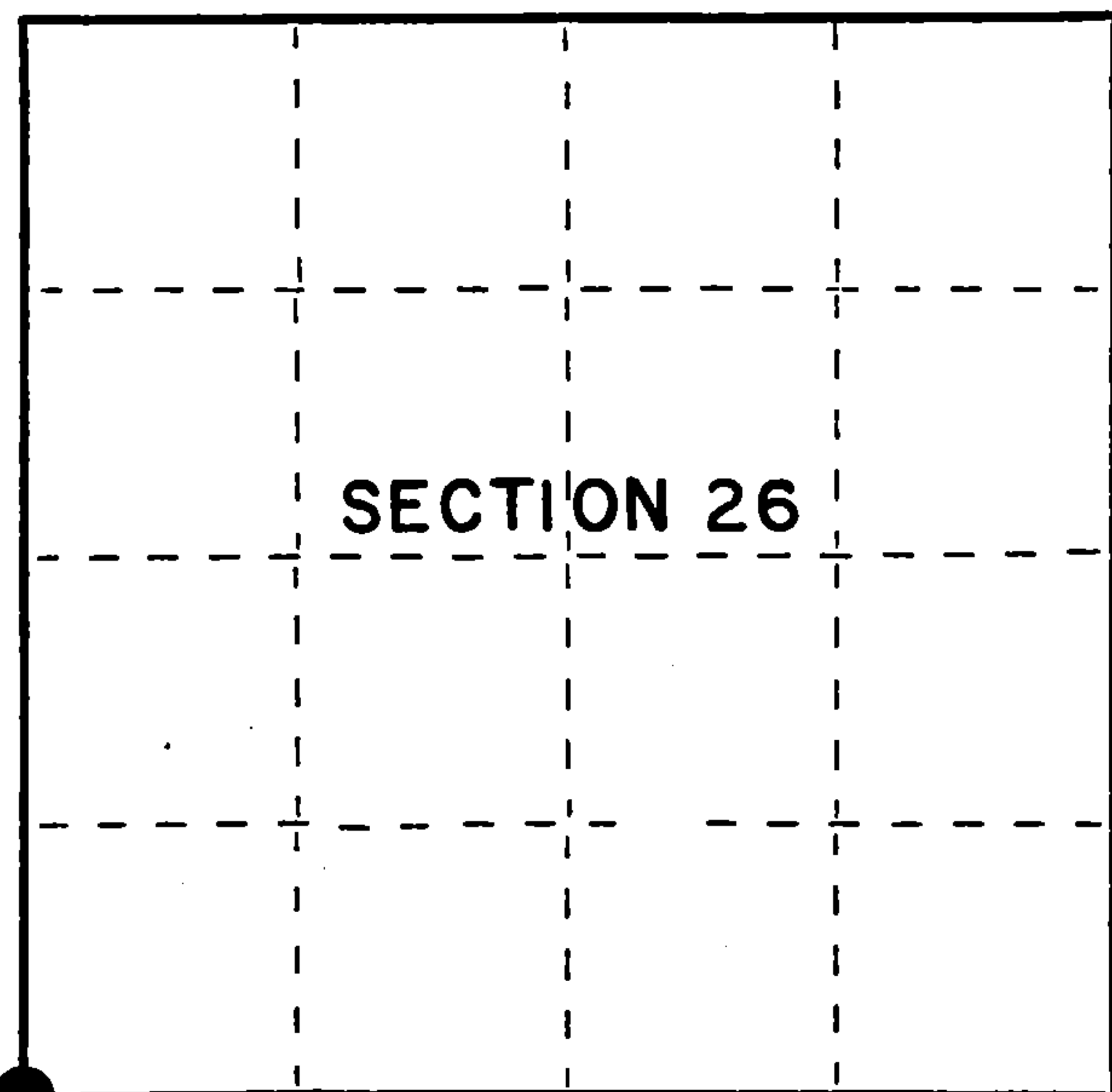

## History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by J. L. Nowlin, deputy surveyor.

In 1945, Ray Leigh recovered an old wooden stake with an old iron pipe wired to it.  
He replaced old wood stake with a 4" cedar post, squared and scribed. In 1975, Philip  
T. Hansen RLS recovered the 4" cedar post in poor condition, marking corner position.  
He replaced the cedar post with a 2½" Berntsen, A-1 Federal Monument with an aluminum cap.  
from which the following bear: (Corner sets in a tag alder marsh and set 2 witness corners)  
1½" dia. iron pipe with 2" brass cap stamped W.C. S 15 lks  
1½" dia. iron pipe with 2" brass cap stamped W.C. West 25 lks

~~Description of corner evidence found:~~ On 7/13/83, Milo Stefan RLS U.S.F.S. found the above described  
monument and set 2 steel sign posts: Steel sign post NW 2.3 feet  
Steel sign post NE 1.7 feet

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found the monument and reference bearing objects as described above

Steel sign post	Northeast	1.7 feet
Steel sign post	Northwest	2.3 feet
1½" dia. iron pipe with brass cap	North	9.90 feet

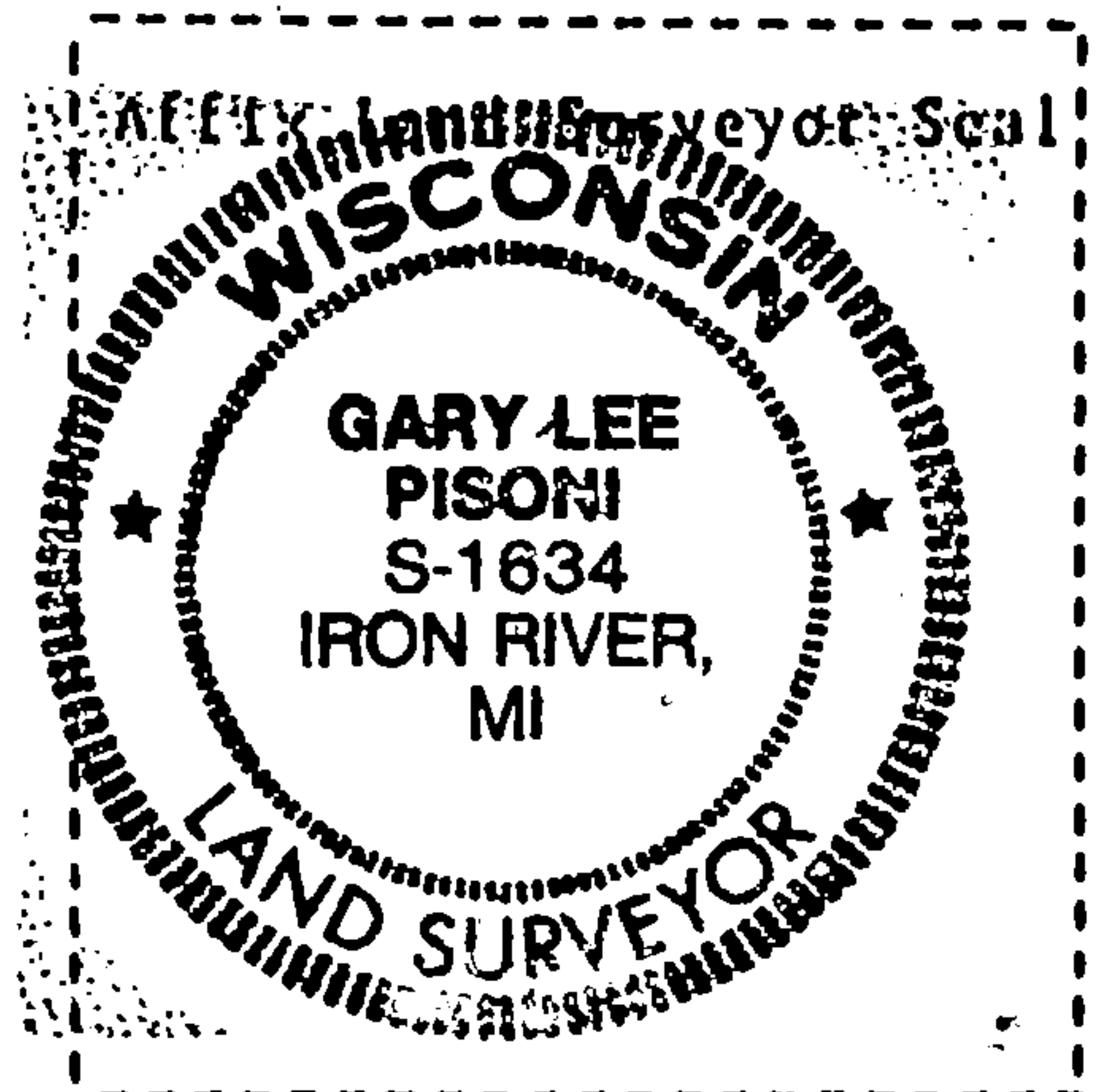
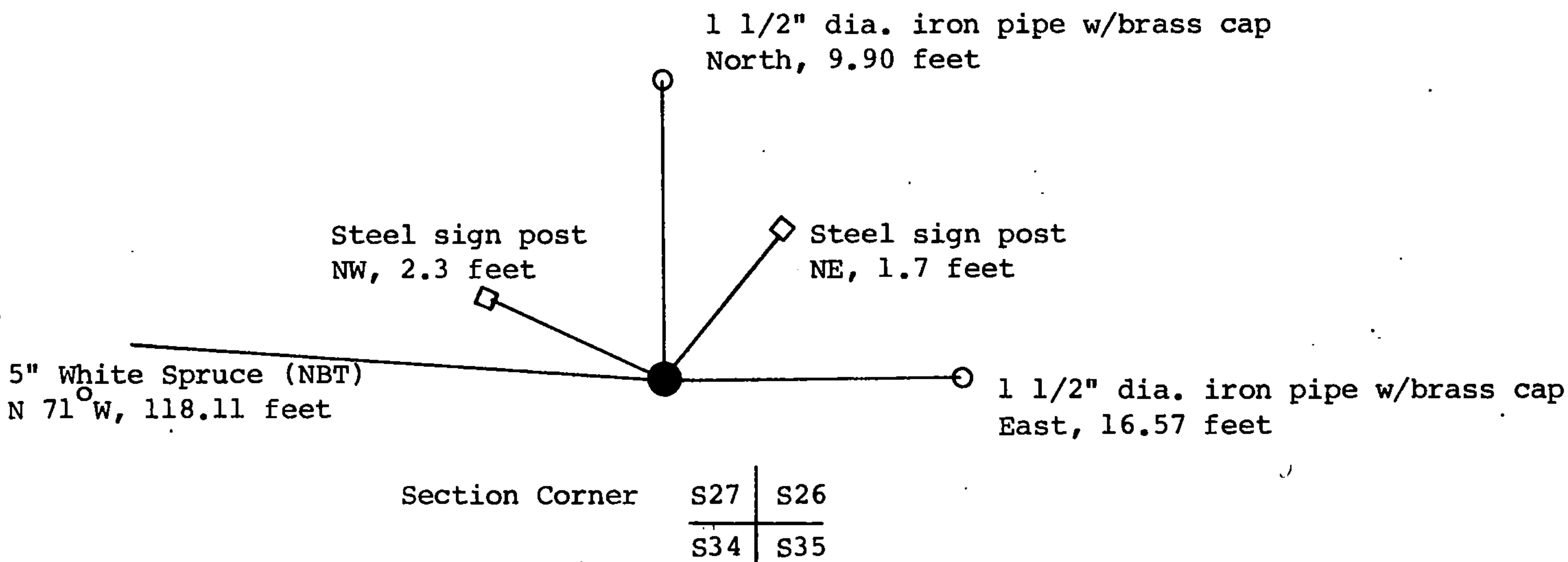
