


INSTRUCTIONS:

This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through 1).

(a) Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system.

O = Corner monument restored.

Quarter Corner Common to Sections 3 and 10, Township 37 North, Range 16 East, Forest County, State of Wisconsin.



- (b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence o any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.
 - In 1859, James McBride set a wood post at the corner and selected the following bearing trees: Cedar 6" N17°E 14 1ks. Cedar 8" S48°W 24 1ks.
 - In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff found no evidence of original corner. Restored by using single proportionate measurement between NW and NE corner of Section 10. Set a 2" dia. driveable aluminum Bernstein monument and selected the following corner references; Balsam 9" N25°E 14.90 ft. Balsam 7" S85°W 10.38 ft. SSP S07°W 1.40 ft.
 - In 1990, John Schulke recovered monument in place and on North side of a ravine. Recovered the following corner references; SSP S12°W 1.40 ft. Southwest Balsam tree up rooted and Northeast Balsam tree snapped off. The following new corner references;

 - 1. 2" dia. driveable alum. Monument stamped to identify the corner.
 - 2. SSP S12°W 1.40 ft.
 - 3. SSP N59°W 2.3 ft.
 - 4. Spruce 7" N10°E 66.35 ft.
 - 5. Balsam 8" N16°E 80.79 ft.
