



Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system. O = Corner monument restored.

Quarter Corner Common to Sections 4 and 9, Township 37 North, Range 16 East, Forest County,



(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

In 1859, James McBride set a wooden post at the corner and the following bearing trees: 12" Hemlock S25°E, 33 1ks. Hemlock, 14" N36°W, 43 1ks.

In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff recovered corner position by the following bearing trees: Hemlock stump 14" bears N36°W, 43 lks. Hemlock stump 12" bears S25°E, 38 lks. Set a 2" dia. driveable aluminum Berntsen monument at the corner position and the following corner references: Maple 7" bears S68°E, 12.96 ft. 8" bears S02°W, 24.81 ft. Maple Steel post bears S45°W, 2.0 ft.

In 1990, John Schulke recovered monument in place and the following corner references: Sugar Maple 8" bears S02°W, 24.82 ft. Sugar Maple 9" bears S65°E, 12.94 ft. Steel sign post bears SW, 2.1 ft. The following new corner references: 13" bears S86°W, 39.37 ft. Basswood
