

The following corner references: 6" N81°E Maple 12.01 ft. 7" South Maple 6.11 ft. SSP 🦜 NW 0.5 ft. Filed a Certified Land Corner Restoration form in the Forest County Register of Deed's Office, Document #113303.
 - In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff recovered monument in place and the corner references listed in the Certified Land Corner Restoration form filed in 1977.
