

 - In 1973, Jean Resvick recovered the following bearing trees: Balsam N21°W 27.98 ft. Maple N85°E 26.93 ft. From the bearing trees set a 2" dia. galvanized iron pipe, filled with concrete, with brass cap stamped to identify the corner. Placed a steel sign post NW a distance of 0.3 ft. from the monument. Recorded a Certified Land Corner Restoration form filed in the Forest Co. Register of Deed's office, Document #104447.
