

No original corner evidence was found. At the corner position I found an ancient fence corner and steel fence rail on the South side of Sportsmans Lane. An ancient, fallen, post and wire fence runs South and East from corner post. This position measures 2642.99 feet to the Section corner to the East and 2668.03 feet to the Section corner to the West. I accepted the ancient fence corner as the best available evidence of the One-quarter corner position and monumented this location.
