

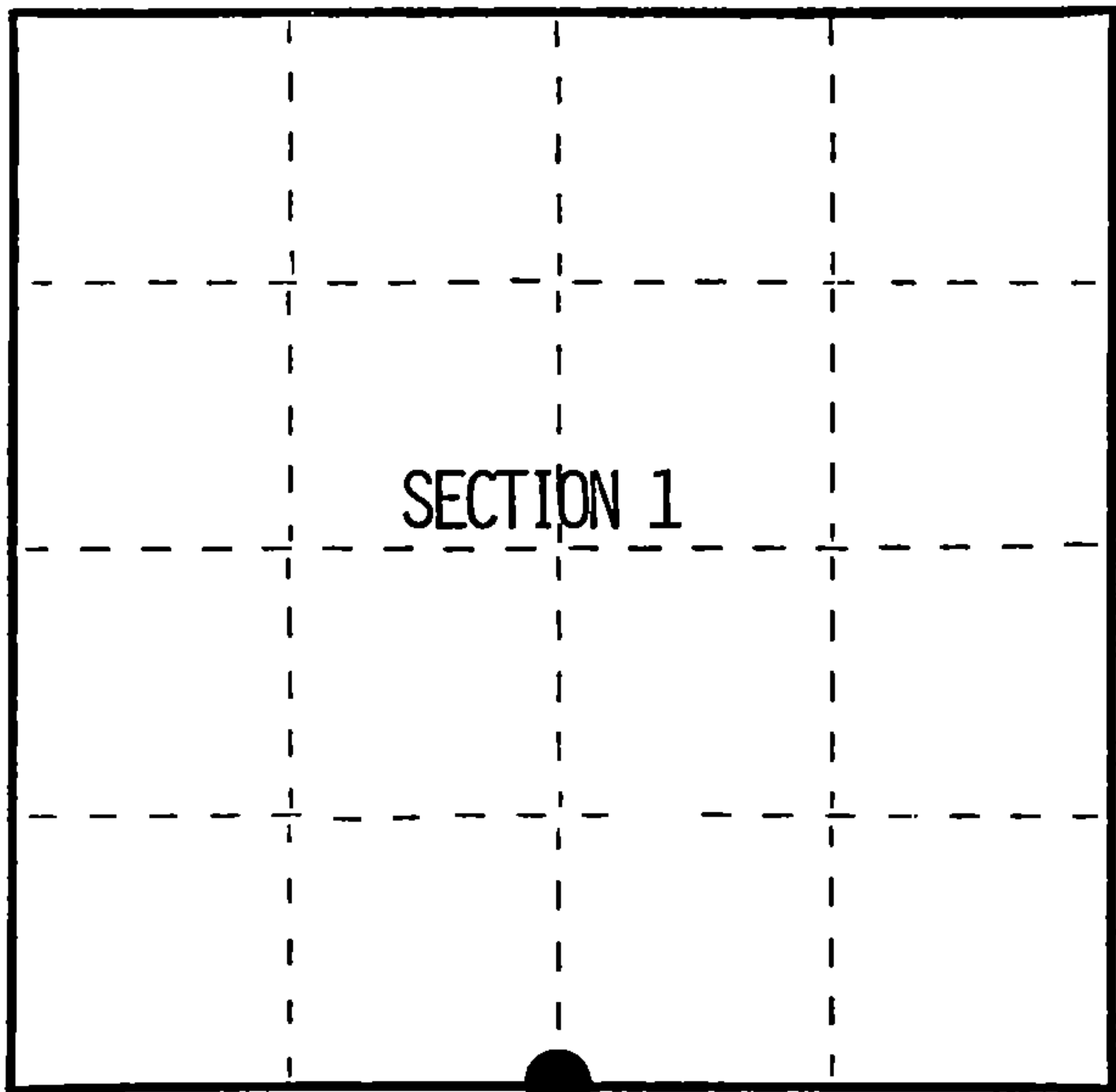

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At mid point between opposing Section Corners, set a 2½"X36" aluminum pipe monument
2½ feet in the ground with an aluminum cap stamped: T38N, R13E, 1/4, S1, S2, 1992,
S-1107. from which the following bear:

Maple	8"	N64°E	17.07 feet
Steel sign post		Northwest	1.00 feet

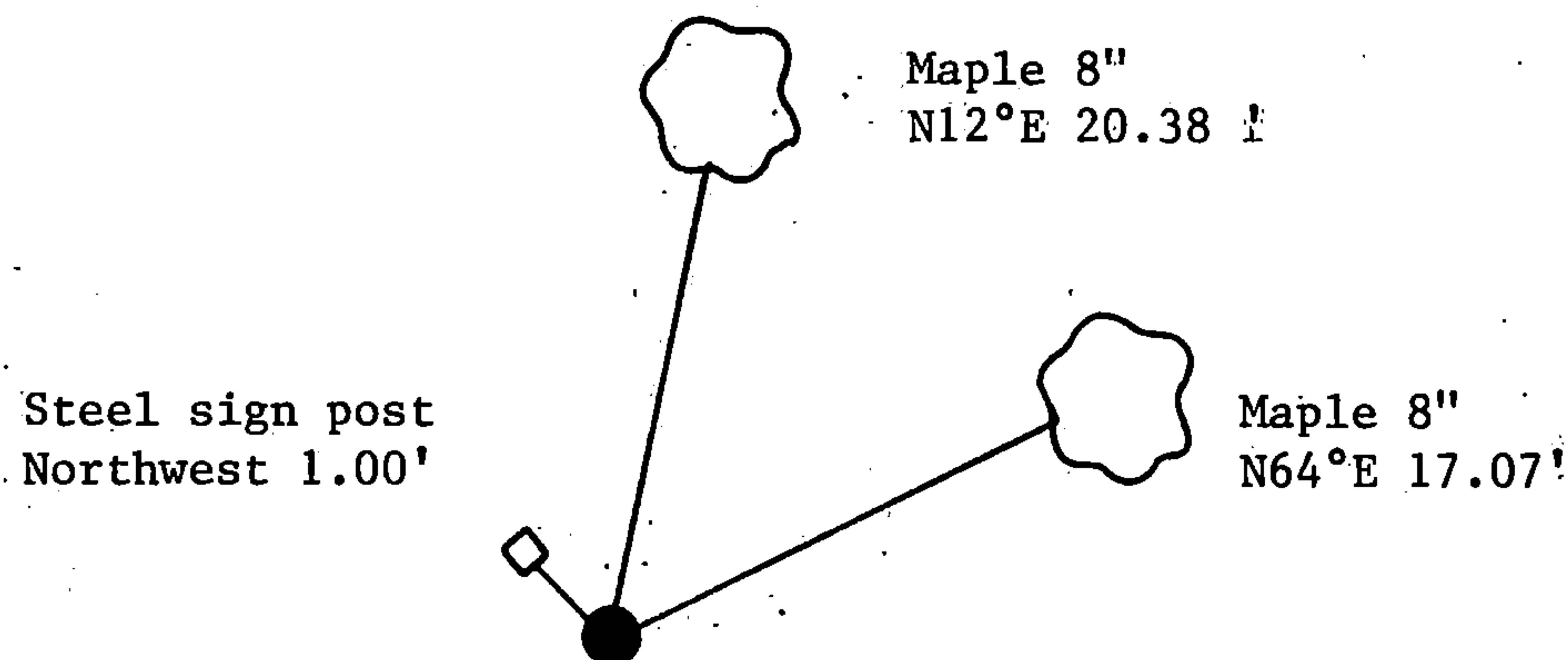
