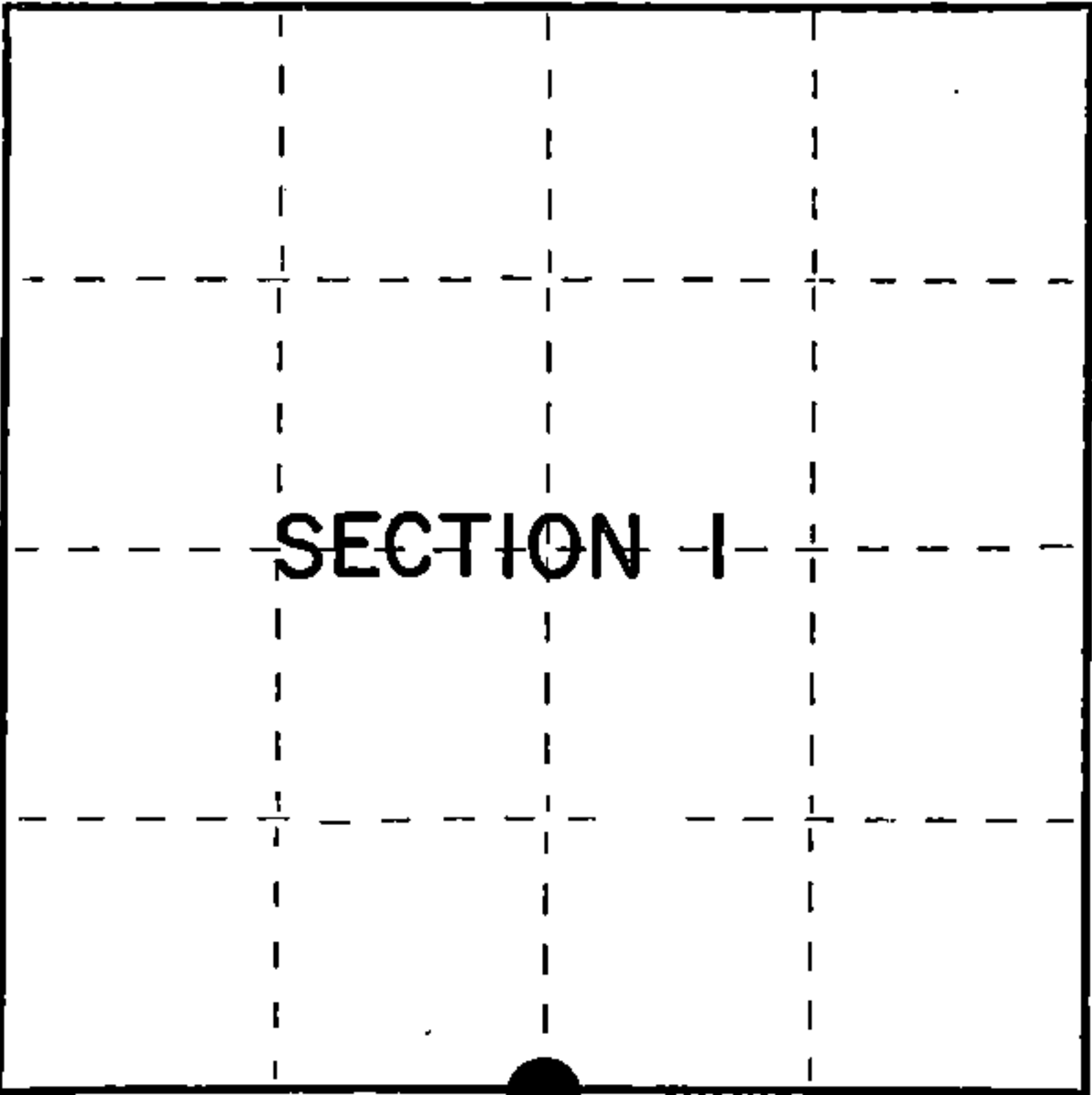

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by H.&J.L. Nowlin. West corrected between Sections
1 and 12, 40.20 chains, set Quarter Corner post to Sections 1 and 12, from which
the following bear:

Hemlock	24"	S15°E	15 lks.
Fir	12"	N 3°W	20 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No original corner evidence was recovered.

The corner position was restored at proportionate distance and on line between
the Southwest and Southeast Section Corners of Section 1.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the restored corner position, set a 2½" diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet
long, 30 inches in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped: T38N R14E, 1/4, S1,
S12, 1983, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;

R. Pine	6"	N63°E	4.02 feet
R. Pine	6"	N45°W	6.03 feet
Steel Sign Post		SE	0.50 feet

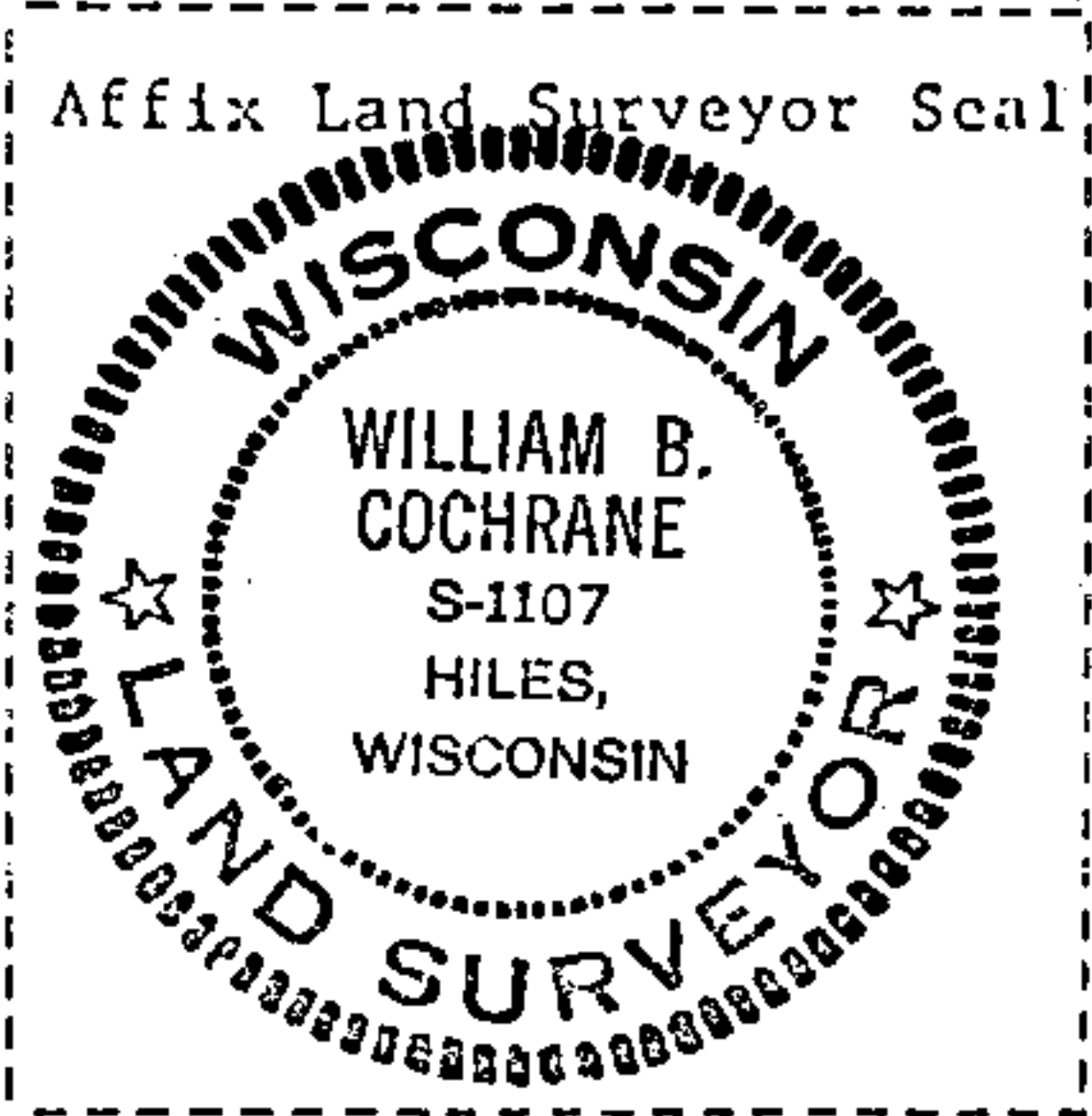
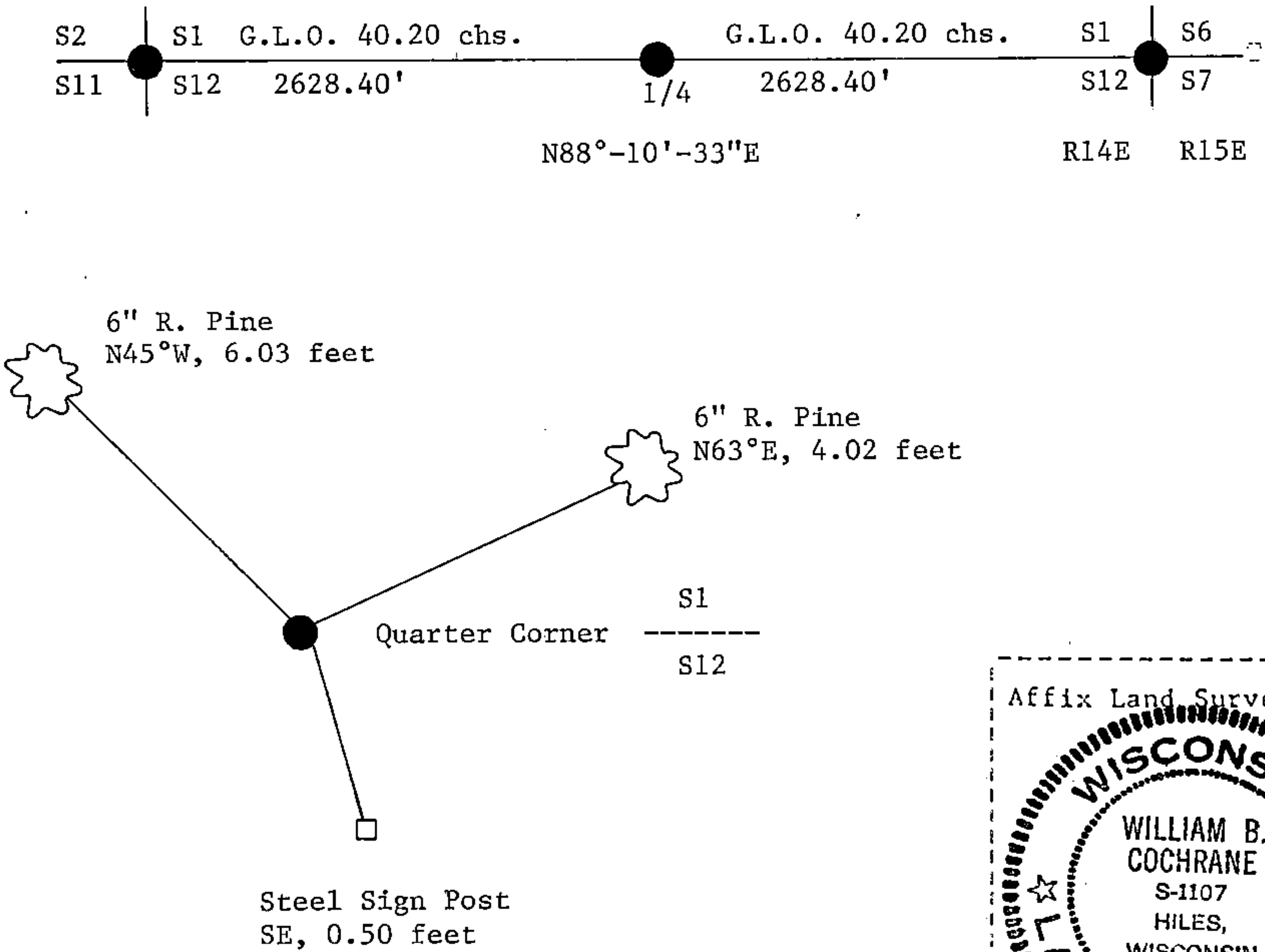
