
## U. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT S. RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS:

This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through 1).

(a) Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system. O . Corner monument restored.

West One Sixteenth Corner Common to Sections 3 and 34, Township 37 and 38 North, Range 16 East, Forest County, State of Wisconsin.

  - In 1982, Kim Pritzlaff established the corner and set a 2" dia. driveable aluminum Berntsen monument stamped to identify the corner. The following corner references: 11" bears S20°W, 55.94 ft. Balsam Fir 9" bears S59°E, 36.14 ft. Balsam Fir Steel sign post bears S14°E, 1.35 ft.
  - In 1990, John Schulke recovered monument in place and flush to the ground. Also, recovered the following corner references: 14" Balsam bears S26°W, 55.92 ft.

bears S59°E, Dead Balsam 36.14 ft.

Steel sign post bears S/SE, 1.4 ft.

The following new corner reference: Aspen 8" bears N63°E, 13.29 ft.
