Cochrane do herebertify that on the 23rd da of December 19 88, I found evidence of the East Quarter corner of Section 6  Township 39 North, Rang R13E Fourth Principal Meridian as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessorie as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. South corrected between Sections 5 and 6, at 38.73 chains, set Quarter Section Post to Sections 5 and 6, from which the following bear;

Birch	6"	S1½°E	269	lks.
Birch	8"	S14°W	232	lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 3"x3"x24" squared cedar post in a mound of rock. From cedar post N40°W, 7.70 feet, found a location tag on a 20" Y. Birch stump.

The adjacent property owner, Marv Shultz, had informed Lowell Petersen of the Eagle River Ranger District that he had bought the property from Morris Roberts and that the wood post was always accepted as the corner position.

I accept the wood post as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

In place of wood post, set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N, R13E, 1/4, S5, S6, 1988, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;




