

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty and Alex McDill.

In 1974, William B. Cochrane, Land Surveyor with the Forest Service, restored the corner position according to Land Corner Certificate Document # 107236. At the corner position, set a 2" diameter galvanized iron pipe, 3 feet long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet in the ground, with a brass cap stamped; T39N, R13E, R14E, S25, S30, S31, S36, 1975, S-1107.

In 1985, Cochrane found the monument as described above and the following bearing trees;






