





In 1985, William B. Cochrane, Land Surveyor with the Forest Service, found a 6"x6" squared Cedar post 1 foot above ground. In place of post, set a 2½ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 2½ feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N, R14E, S28, S29, S32, S33, 1985, S-1107. Blazed and scribed the following;

Maple N46°E 80.45 feet 14" Maple S20°E 78.73 feet 11" S50°W Maple 119.10 feet 7" N16°W Maple 108.09 feet Steel Sign Post Southwest 4.00 feet

On 9-28-99, Gary L. Pisoni, RLS, found the monument as described above, found the bearing trees as described below, and made a new bearing tree as described below.
