Tamarack S48°E 23 1ks Tamarack

Description of corner evidence found:

No original corner evidence found. I restored corner position by lost corner proportionate methods on line and at the mid-point between the northeast and southeast section corners of Section 10.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.


