

Mr. Rein's Northwest section corner located the improvements near the section corner in section 35. Are residents claimed that these improvements should actually be in Section 36. After an extensive search of the tax records in the Forest County Court House and deeds of the properties in the NW 1/4 of section 36 and the NE 1/4 of Section 35 and set of survey field notes of Raymond Leigh from 1939 the corner positions as set by James D. Rein were found to be out of position.
