

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. West corrected between Sections 1 and 12, set Quarter Section Corner Post to Sections 1 and 12, from which the following bear;

Birch	10"	S80°E	24 1ks.
Hemlock	10"	N45°W	11 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

The corner position was re-established at proportionate distance between the Northeast and Northwest Section Corners of Section 12, and in the Center Line of State Highway 70.

No original corner evidence was recovered.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the re-established corner position, set a railroad spike flush with the surface of State Highway 70, from which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;

R. Pine	13"	N32°E	.101.49 feet
R. Pine	10"	N22°W	119.61 feet

Witness Corner ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" aluminum pipe monument) bears S32°W, 120.79 feet Stamped; Witness Corner, T40N R14E, 1/4, S1, S12, 1985, S-1107, N32°E, 120.79'

Steel Sign Post bears SE, 0.50 feet from Witness Corner.


