Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. North between Sections 1 and 2, 79.41 chains, set Section Corner Post to Sections 1 and 2, from which the following bear;

Birch 14" S16°E 159 1ks. Fir 4" S36°W 84 1ks.

Intersect correction line 37.27 chains East of Corner to Sections 35 and 36, T41N R14E.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was recovered.

The corner position was re-established at proportionate distance and on line between the Standard Quarter Corner of Section 36, and the Standard Section Corner common to Sections 35 and 36, T41N R14E.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the re-established corner position, set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter aluminum pipe monument, 5 feet long, 4 feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T41N R14E, S1, S2, T40N, 1984, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;


