

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RESTORATION

I William B. Cochrane, do hereby certify that on the 15th day of June 19 78, I found evidence of the Southwest Section corner of Section 9 Township 33 North, Range 14 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Description of original monument and accessories and subsequent restorations:

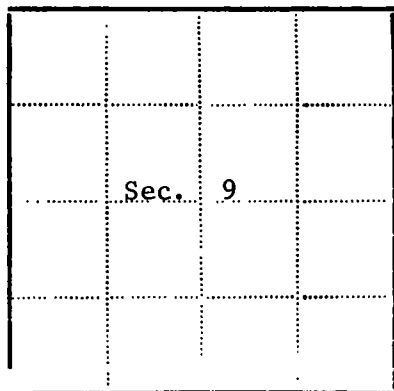
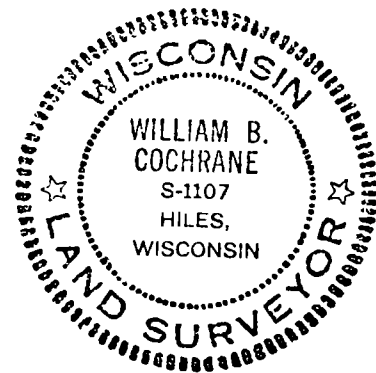
Surveyed in 1865 by J.L. Nowlin  
North between Sections 16 and 17. 80.0 chains set post corner to Sections 8,9,16 and 17  
Spruce, 5", N4°W, 10 lks.  
Spruce, 5", N19°E, 40 lks.  
Spruce, 6"  
Spruce, 6"  
6 chains South leave swamp E&W

Description of corner evidence found:

4x4 old scribed cedar post and a new 3x3 scribed cedar post.  
3/4" diameter, iron pipe alongside old post  
From the old post a possible spruce stump mound bears N4°W, 10 lks.  
No other stump evidence was found. 6 chains south leave the swamp bears East and West.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the location of this corner:

I replaced the old post with a 2 inch diameter aluminum Berntsen monument, 5 feet long with an aluminum cap stamped:  
T33N R14E, S8, S9, S16, S17, 1978, S-1107  
From which the following bear:  
Tamarack, 6", N69°E, 35.14 feet  
Spruce, 4", S49°W, 23.05 feet  
Tamarack, 4", N75°W, 22.73 feet  
Set a steel sign post NE, 0.50 feet
