
Median household income is \$11.8K below the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2017 the region's population **declined by 2.8%** since 2012, falling by 579. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.7%** between 2017 and 2022, losing 341.

From 2012 to 2017, jobs increased by 3.8% in Adams County, WI from 5,943 to 6,169. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.6% by 3.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.1% to 47.2% between 2012 and 2017.

(10.5% below the national average), and **7.8% hold an**Associate's Degree (0.1% below the national average).

The top three industries in 2017 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Traveler Accommodation.










Unemployment Rate Trends

Adams County, WI had a November 2017 unemployment rate of 4.18%, decreasing from 10.94% 5 years before.





Adams County, WI has 2,414 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,183.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,058 people 65 or older, while there are 5,692 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Adams County, WI has 22.47 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.22 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation LQ






Top Occupation Earnings
