
Median household income is \$11.8K below the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2017 the region's population **declined by 3.4%** since 2012, falling by 680. Population is expected to **decrease by 2.2%** between 2017 and 2022, losing 417.

From 2012 to 2017, jobs declined by 0.6% in Langlade County, WI from 8,796 to 8,747. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.6% by 8.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 59.7% to 60.7% between 2012 and 2017.

Concerning educational attainment, **10.1% of Langlade**County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree
(8.3% below the national average), and **8.2% hold an**Associate's Degree (0.3% above the national average).

The top three industries in 2017 are Crop Production, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).










Unemployment Rate Trends




Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 1,714 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,126.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,929 people 65 or older, while there are 4,523 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Langlade County, WI has 35.85 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.22 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP








Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation LQ






