Population decreased by 537 over the last 5 years and is projected to decrease by 109 over the next 5 years.


Median household income is **\$8.1K below** the national median household income of \$55.3K.

As of 2017 the region's population **declined by 2.0%** since 2012, falling by 537. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.4%** between 2017 and 2022, losing 109.

From 2012 to 2017, jobs increased by 4.6% in Juneau County, WI from 10,077 to 10,540. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 3.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.4% to 61.8% between 2012 and 2017.

Concerning educational attainment, **9.0% of Juneau**County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree
(9.4% below the national average), and **8.4% hold an**Associate's Degree (0.5% above the national average).

The top three industries in 2017 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI has 4,262 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 5,453.




Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 2,353 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,588.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 4,004 people 65 or older, while there are 5,125 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Juneau County, WI has 11.98 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.22 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation LQ






Top Occupation Earnings
