
Jobs (2018)

Median household income is **\$11.8K below** the national median household income of \$55.3K.



As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 2.7%** since 2013, falling by 559. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.3%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 265.

From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 2.4%** in Adams County, WI from 5,901 to **6,040**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.4% by 5.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 50.1% to 48.9% between 2013 and 2018**.

Concerning educational attainment, **8.2% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.4% below the national average), and **7.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.1% below the national average).

The top three industries in 2018 are Crop Production, Traveler Accommodation, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.




Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,844 racially diverse people, while there are 1,832 here.






Adams County, WI has 2,372 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,208.

Adams County, WI has 2.05 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries








Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations



Occupation Jobs Growth




Top Occupation Earnings

Educational Pipeline
