

As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 2.0%** since 2013, falling by 381. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.1%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 203.

From 2013 to 2018, jobs **declined by 0.6%** in Langlade County, WI from 8,784 to **8,729**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.4% by 8.0%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 61.1% to 61.5% between 2013 and 2018**.

Concerning educational attainment, **9.4% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.2% below the national average), and **9.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% above the national average).

The top three industries in 2018 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment Rate Trends

Langlade County, WI had a July 2018 unemployment rate of 4.44%, decreasing from 9.08% 5 years before.





Langlade County, WI has 2,743 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 3,968.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,524 racially diverse people, while there are 1,178 here.




Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 0.95 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.75 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries



Industry Jobs Growth




Top Industry GRP






Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Earnings
