Population grew by 993 over the last 5 years and is projected to grow by 1,089 over the next 5 years.

Jobs (2018)

Jobs grew by 4,771 over the last 5 years and are projected to grow by 1,822 over the next 5 years.

Median household income is \$1.1K below the national median household income of \$57.7K.

Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population increased by 0.7% since 2013, growing by 993. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2018 and 2023, adding 1,089.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 6.6% in Marathon County, WI from 72,447 to 77,218. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.8% by 1.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 66.4% to 68.0% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.7% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.9% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Management of Companies and Enterprises.







Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Marathon County, WI had an October 2018 unemployment rate of 2.28%, decreasing from 6.70% 5 years before.








Millennials

Marathon County, WI has 24,066 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 28,112.




Marathon County, WI has 8,912 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7,892.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 38,694 people 55 or older, while there are 42,846 here.




Violent Crime

Property Crime


Marathon County, WI has 11.42 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation LQ






Top Occupation Earnings

Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 2,352 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 23% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide, Welding Technology/Welder, and Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic).
