Economy Overview

Population (2018)

Population decreased by 1,016 over the last 5 years and is projected to decrease by 563 over the next 5 years.

Jobs (2018)

Jobs decreased by 3,822 over the last 5 years and are projected to decrease by 898 over the next 5 years. \$51.6K

Median Household Income (2017)

Median household income is **\$6.0K below** the national median household income of \$57.7K.

Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **declined by 1.4%** since 2013, falling by 1,016. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.8%** between 2018 and 2023, losing 563.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs declined by 8.4% in Wood County, WI from 45,746 to 41,925. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.8% by 16.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.4% to 59.2% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.6% below the national average), and **11.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Outpatient Care Centers, General Freight Trucking, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment Rate Trends

Wood County, WI had an October 2018 unemployment rate of 2.77%, decreasing from 7.26% 5 years before.








Millennials

Wood County, WI has 11,970 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 15,145.




Wood County, WI has 5,574 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4,252.

Property Crime


Wood County, WI has 18.99 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP





Largest Occupations






Top Growing Occupations






Top Occupation LQ






Top Occupation Earnings

Educational Pipeline

In 2017, there were 897 graduates in Wood County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 4% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide, "Business Administration and Management, General", and Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse.
