

### **Economy Overview**

Population decreased by 33 over the last 5 years but is projected to grow by 204 over the next 5 years.

Median household income is **\$8.8K below** the national median household income of \$57.7K.


#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2018 the region's population declined by 0.1% since 2013, falling by 33. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2018 and 2023, adding 204.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs increased by 4.2% in Juneau County, WI from 10,084 to 10,503. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 8.2% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.0% to 60.4% between 2013 and 2018.
- Concerning educational attainment, 8.7% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (9.9% below the national average), and 9.0% hold an Associate's Degree (1.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.







### **Labor Force Participation Rate Trends**






### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Juneau County, WI had a January 2019 unemployment rate of 3.92%, decreasing from 6.46% 5 years before.








Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,292 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 5,504.




Juneau County, WI has 2,281 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.545.

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,576 people 55 or older, while there are 9,555 here.




**Violent Crime**

**Property Crime** 


Juneau County, WI has 11.94 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 24.21 per 1,000 people.








### **Top Growing Industries**






### Top Industry LQ






#### **Top Industry GRP**








