- As of 2019 the region's population **increased by 1.1**% since 2014, growing by 286. Population is expected to **increase by 1.1**% between 2019 and 2024, adding 281.
- From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 2.9% in Juneau County, WI from 10,219 to 10,520. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.9% by 4.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.7% to 62.0% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.0% below the national average), and **9.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI had a July 2019 unemployment rate of 3.11%, decreasing from 6.46% 5 years before.





Juneau County, WI has 4,596 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,472.




Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 2,281 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,542.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,705 people 55 or older, while there are 9,656 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,545 racially diverse people, while there are 2,198 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ





Top Industry GRP










Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2018 Median Hourly Earnings






Top Posted Occupations
