
Median household income is \$14.9K below the national median household income of \$57.7K.

- As of 2019 the region's population increased by 2.8% since 2014, growing by 589. Population is expected to increase by 1.9% between 2019 and 2024, adding 424.
- From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 6.3% in Vilas County, WI from 8,837 to 9,396. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.9% by 0.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.7% to 60.6% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.2% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.7% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment Rate Trends

Vilas County, WI has 2,588 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,510.




Vilas County, WI has 2,149

veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.264.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,350 people 55 or older, while there are 10,890 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,691 racially diverse people, while there are 3,334 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ





Top Industry GRP









Top Occupation Earnings


2018 Median Hourly Earnings
