- From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 3.1% in Juneau County, WI from 10,216 to 10,528. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.3% by 4.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 59.9% to 60.0% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.0% below the national average), and **9.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.








#### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Juneau County, WI had an October 2019 unemployment rate of 2.45%, decreasing from 6.46% 5 years before.






Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,596 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,472.




**Retiring Soon** 

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,705 people 55 or older, while there are 9,656 here.




**Racial Diversity**

Juneau County, WI has 2 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.
















