- As of 2019 the region's population **declined by 0.0%** since 2014, falling by 148. Population is expected to **increase by 0.2%** between 2019 and 2024, adding 684.
- From 2014 to 2019, jobs increased by 3.1% in Centergy from 172,131 to 177,468. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 63.1% to 63.0% between 2014 and 2019.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.5% below the national average), and **11.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.












Top Growing Industries



Top Industry LQ




Top Industry GRP




2019 Gross Regional Product








Top Occupation Earnings








Unique Average Monthly Postings
