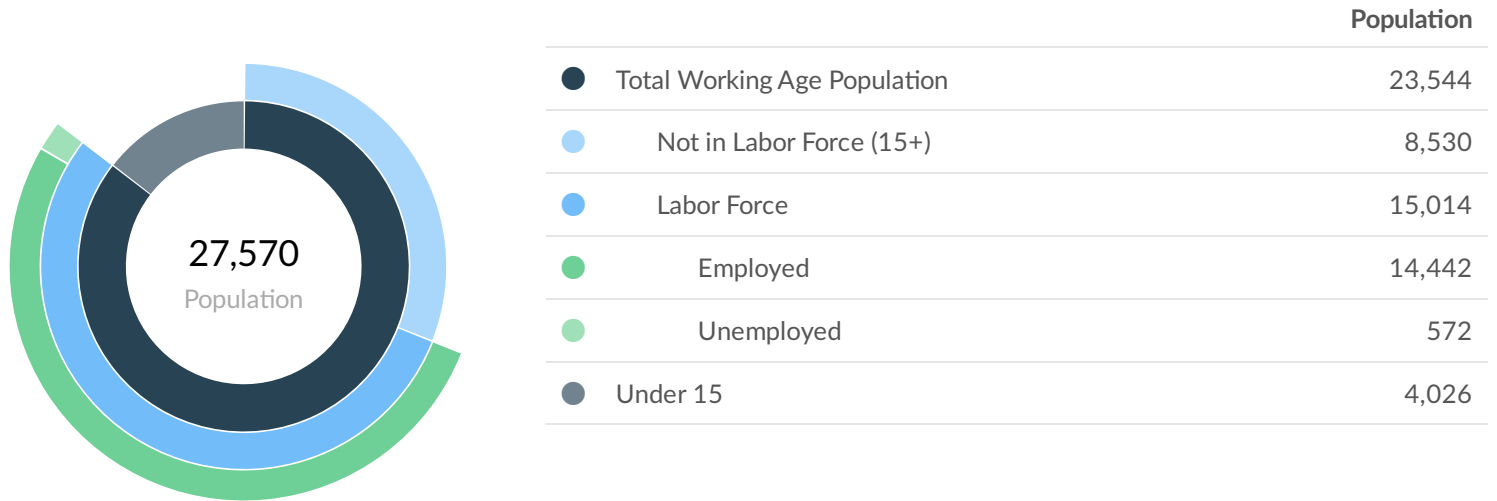
Median household income is **\$4.2K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2014 to 2019, jobs **increased by 0.9%** in Lincoln County, WI from 11,992 to **12,095**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 7.9% by 7.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 64.6% to 63.8% between 2014 and 2019**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.0% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.9% below the national average), and **11.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2019 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Insurance Carriers, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

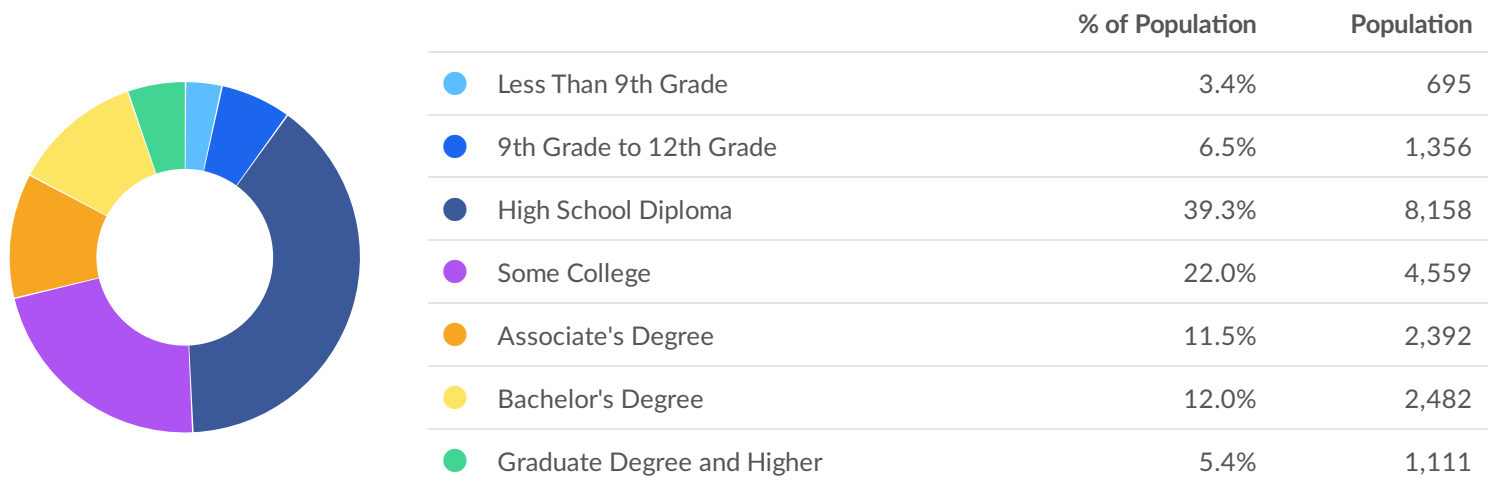

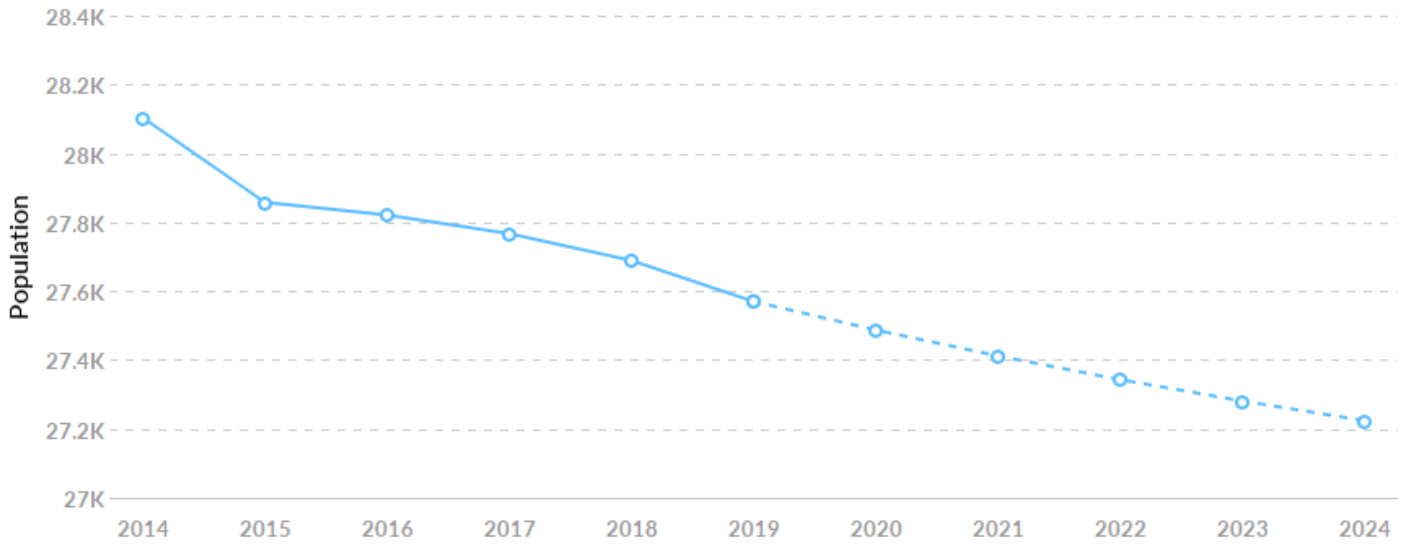

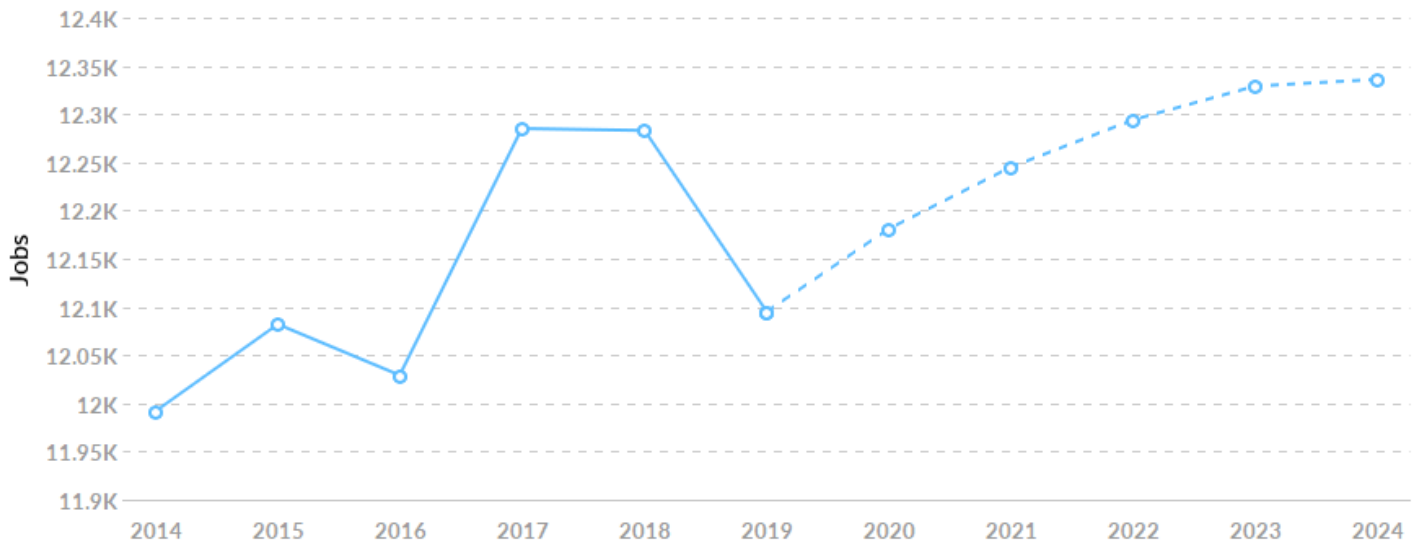

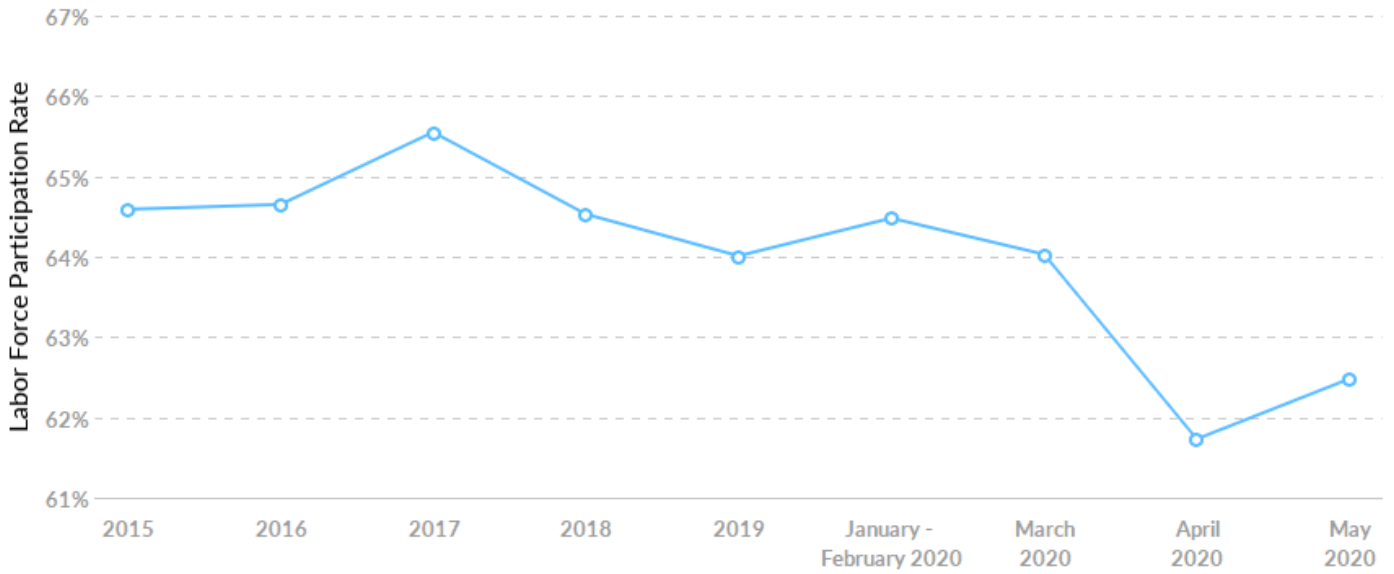
Job Trends

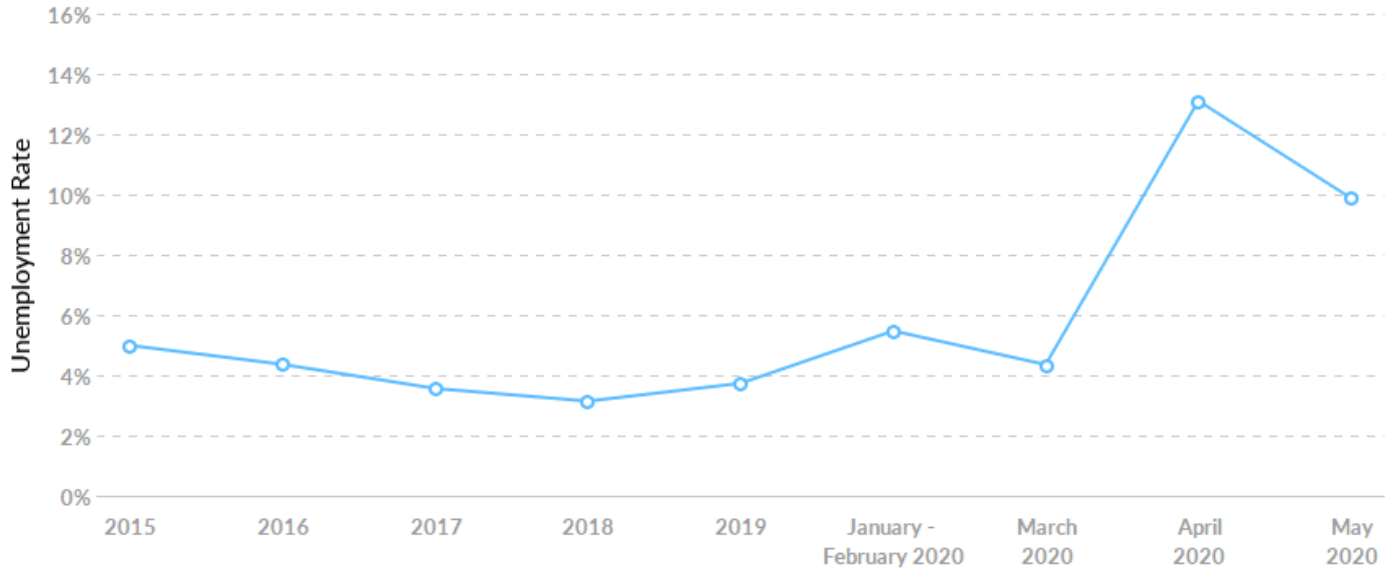

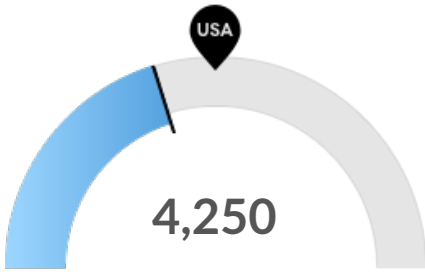
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lincoln County, WI had a May 2020 unemployment rate of 9.87%, **increasing from 4.99%** 5 years before.



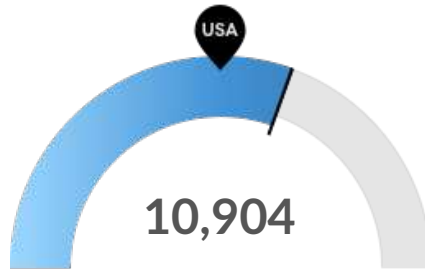

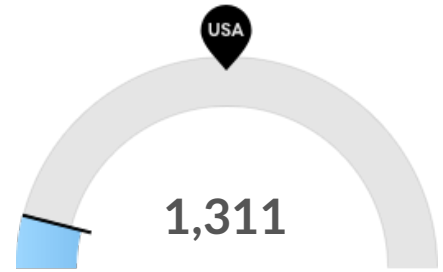
Millennials

Lincoln County, WI has 4,250 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,693.



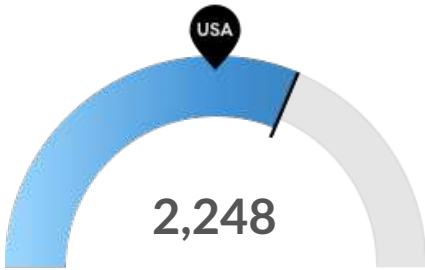
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,015 people 55 or older, while there are 10,904 here.



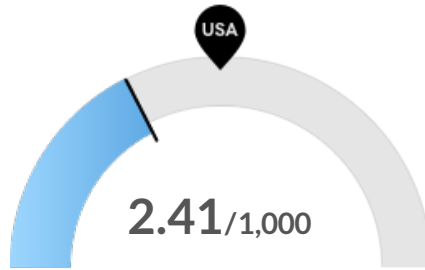
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,970 racially diverse people, while there are 1,311 here.



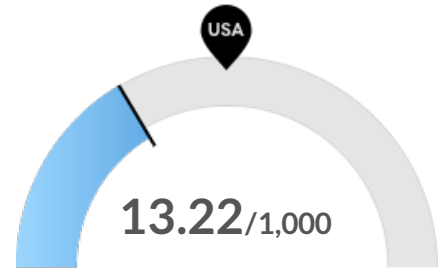
Veterans

Lincoln County, WI has 2.41 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.87 per 1,000 people.

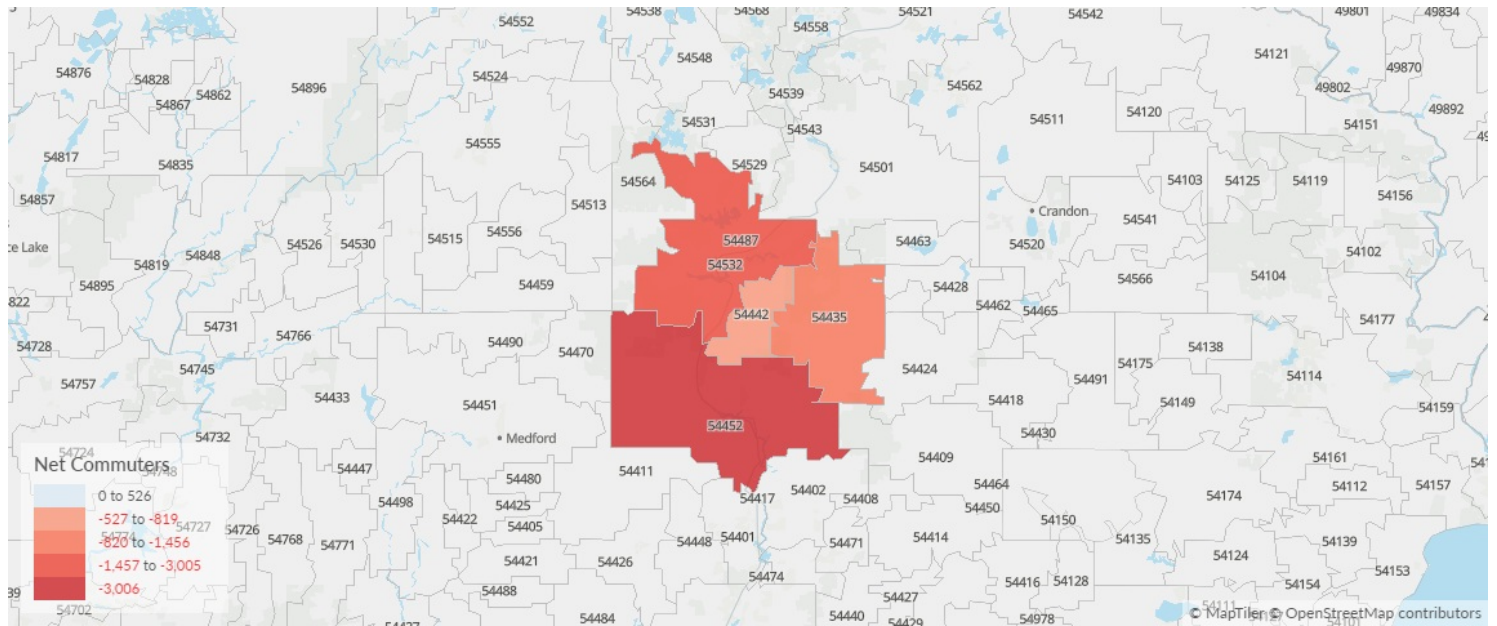


Property Crime

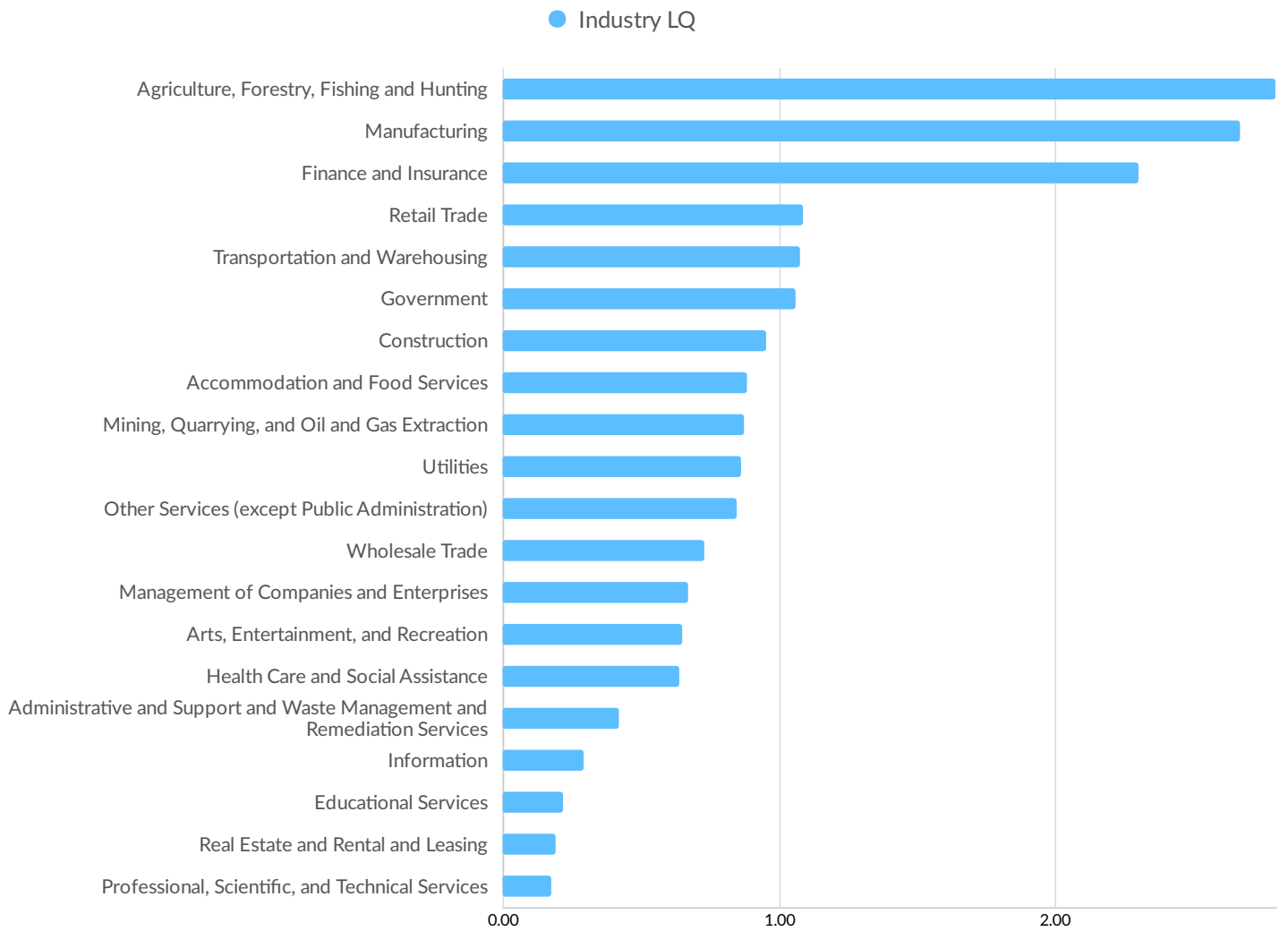

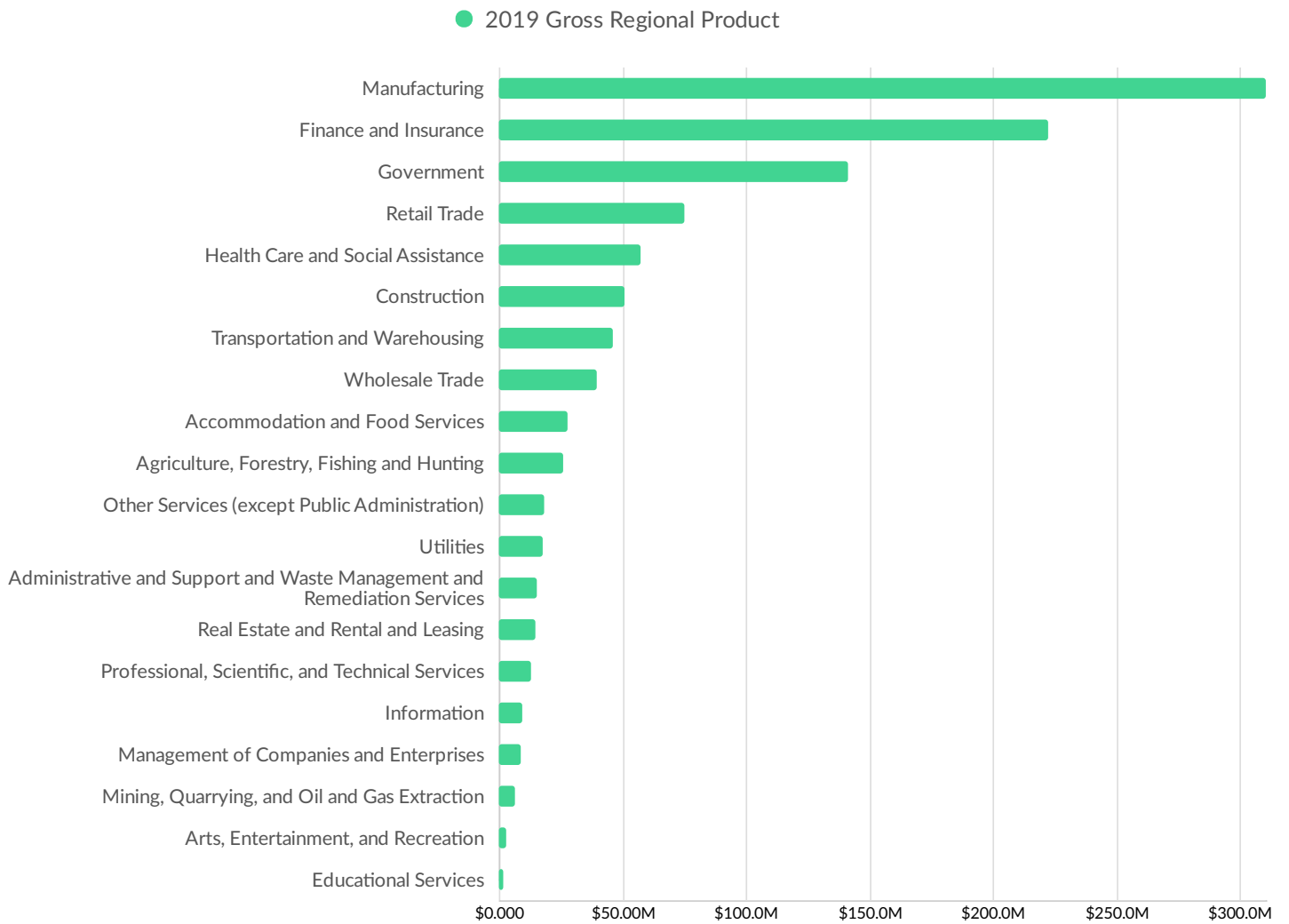

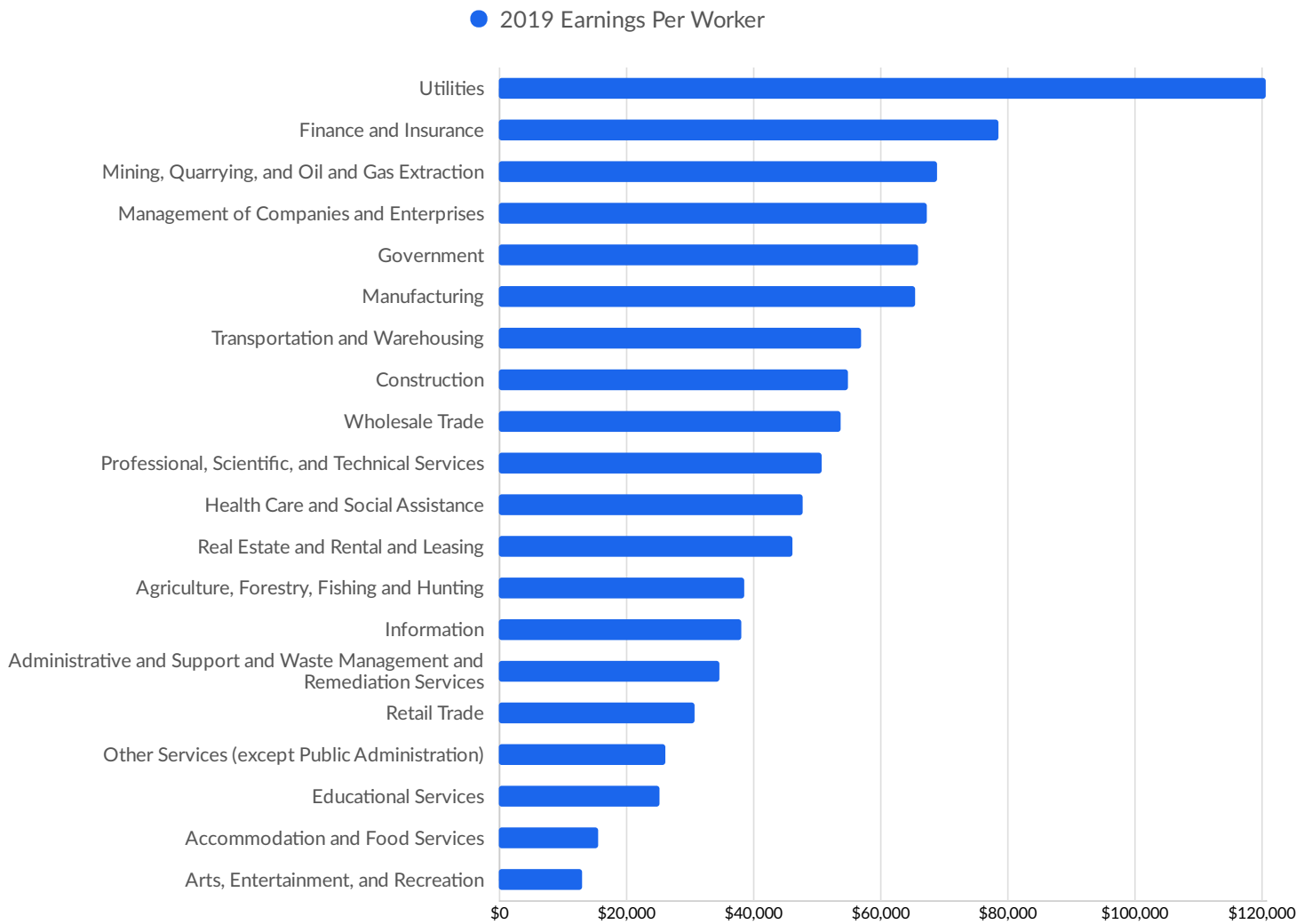

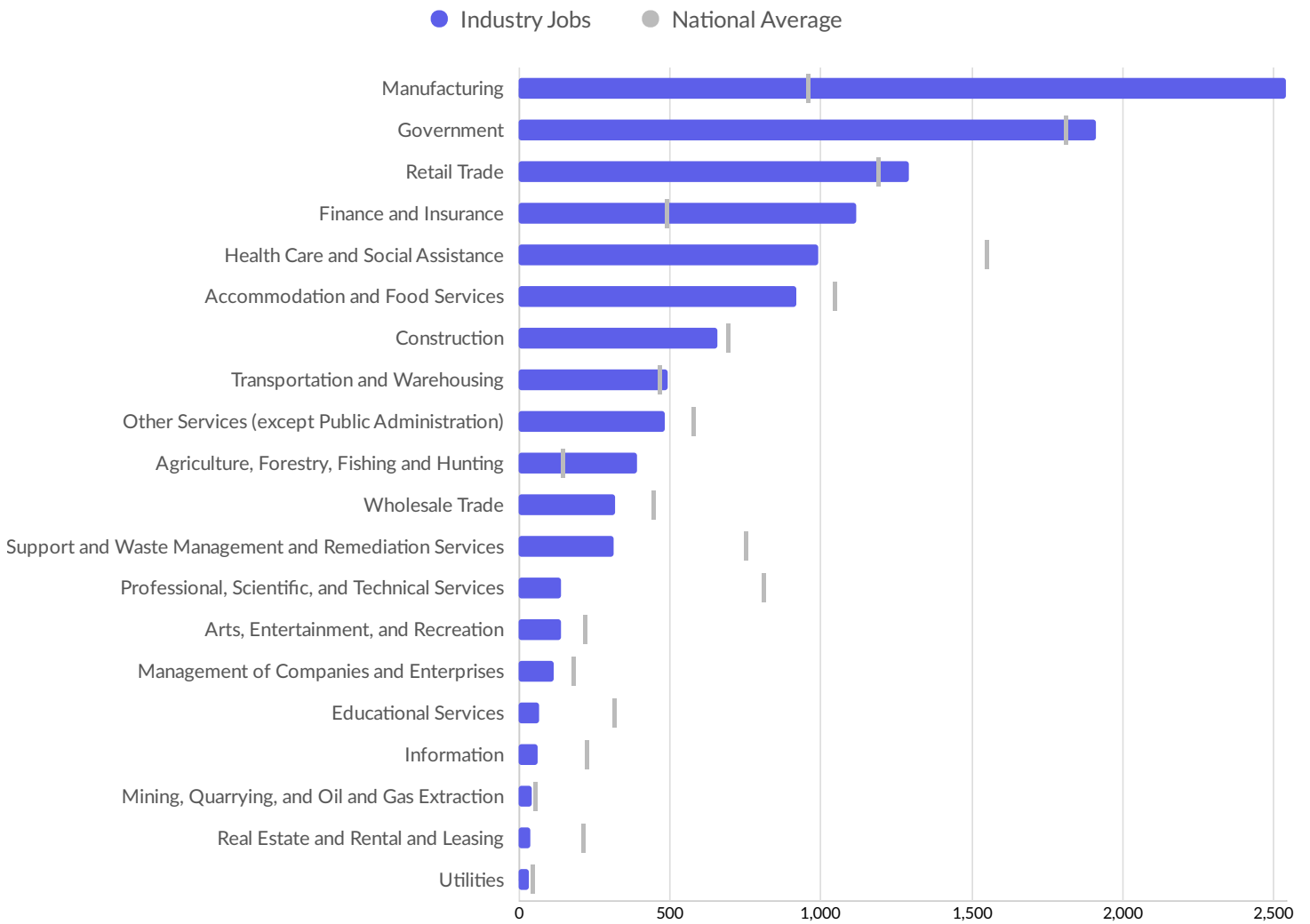

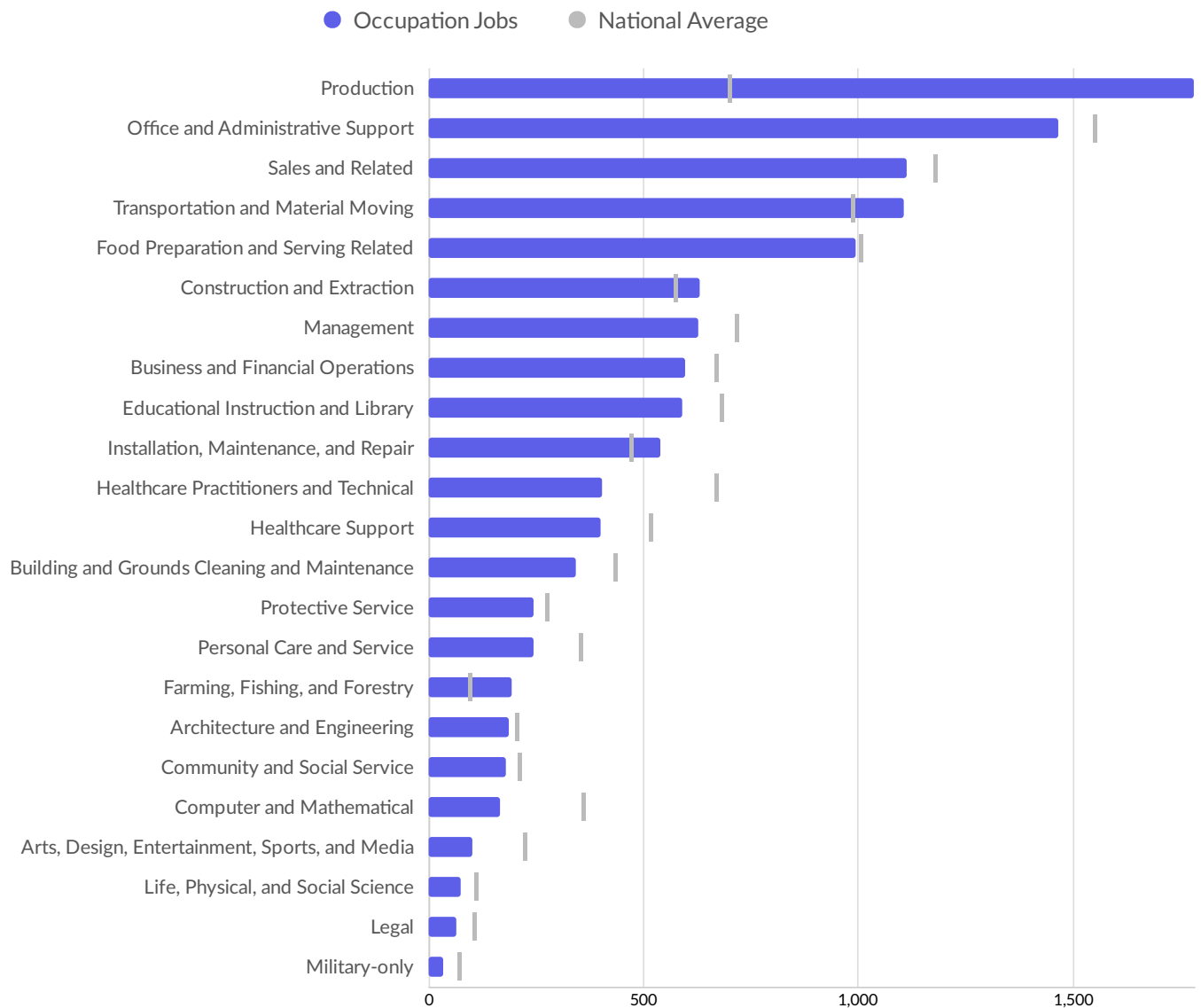

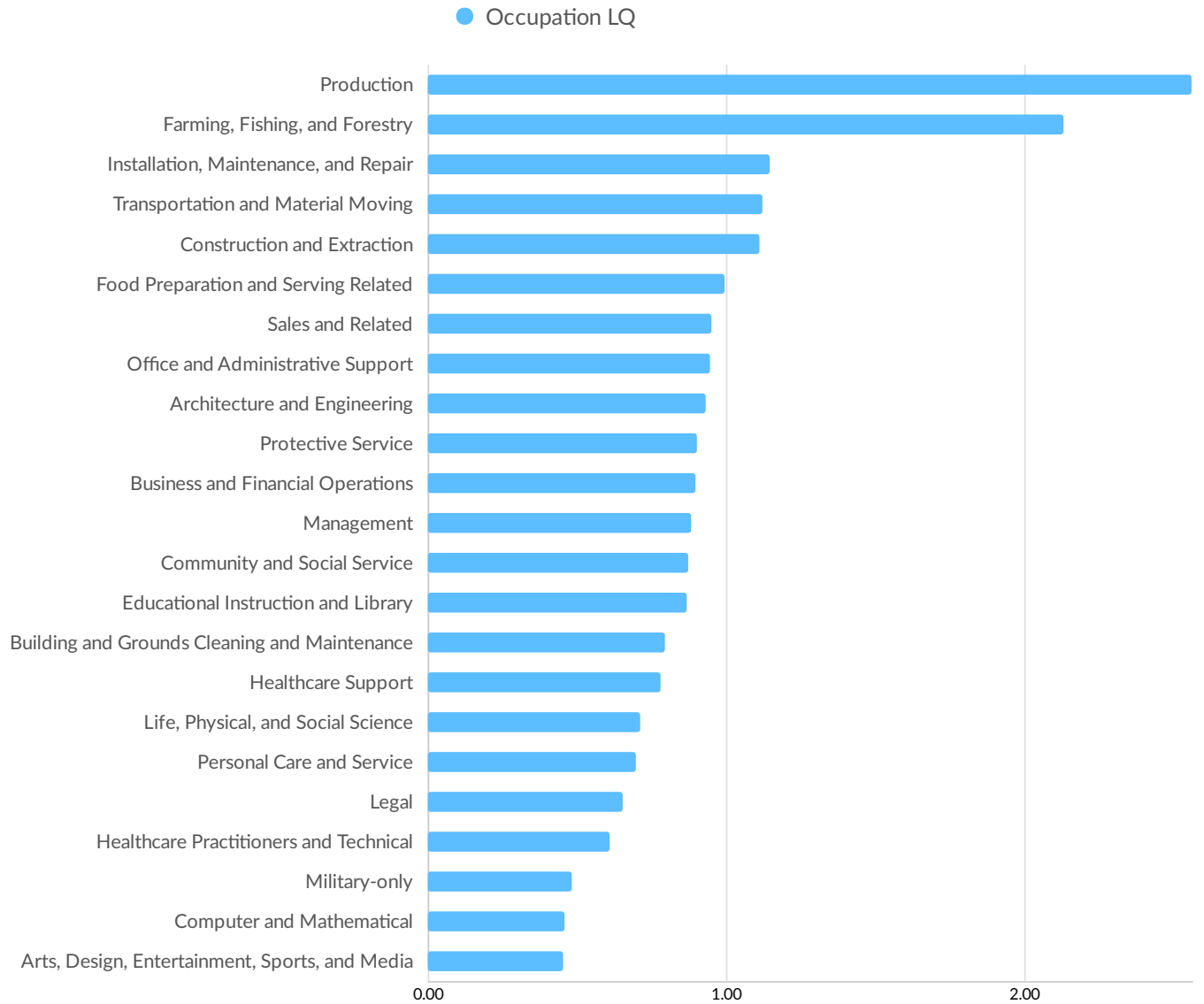

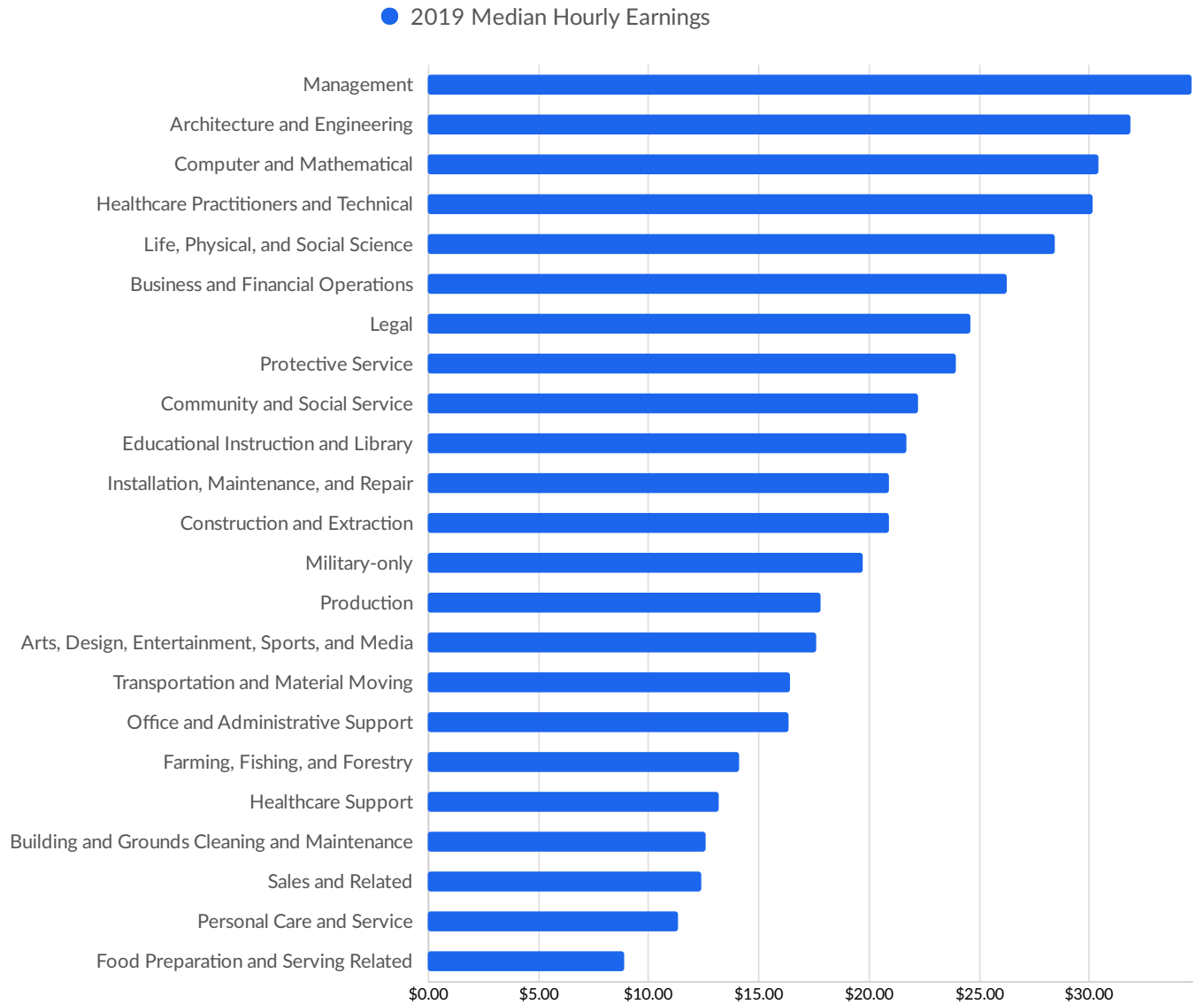

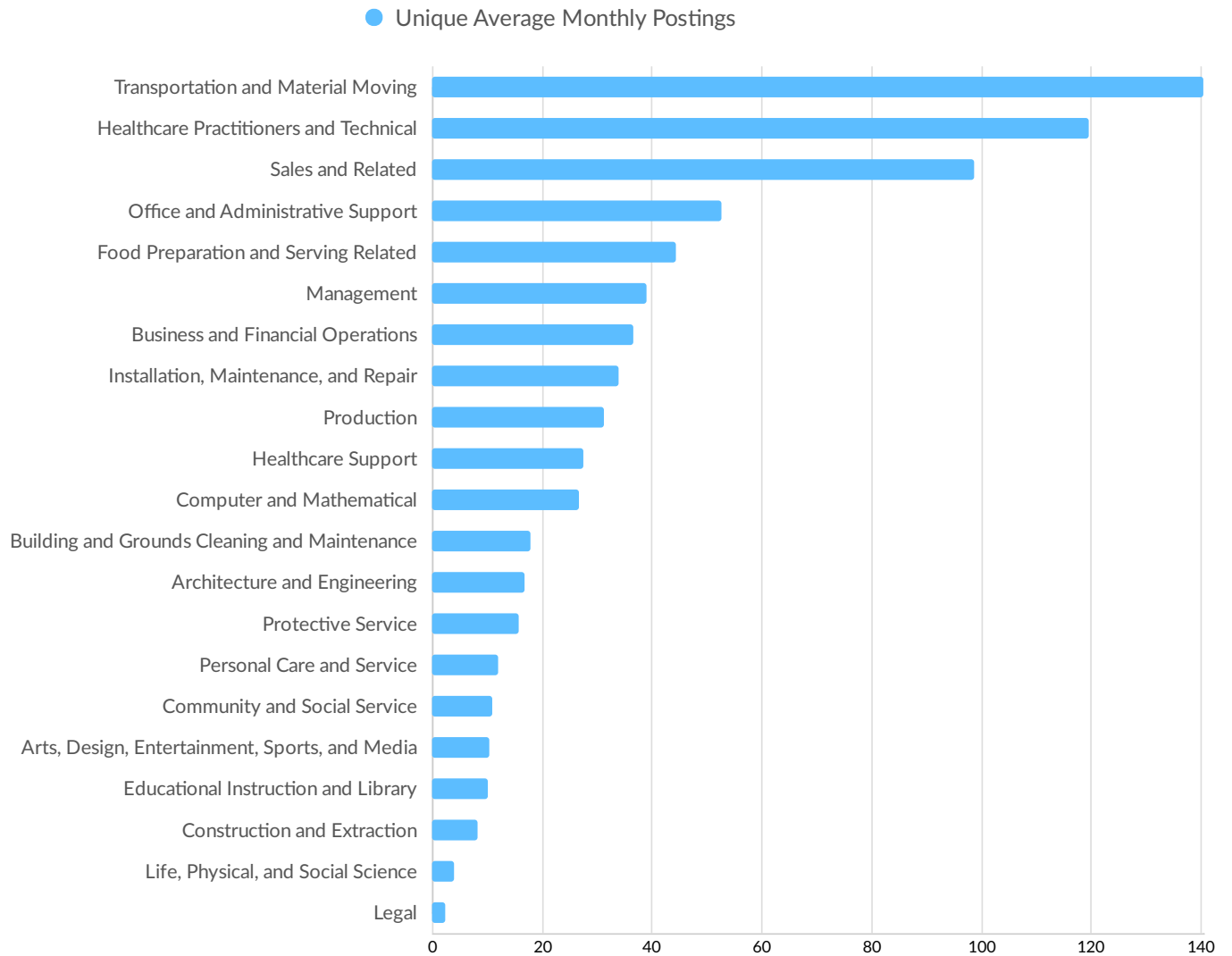

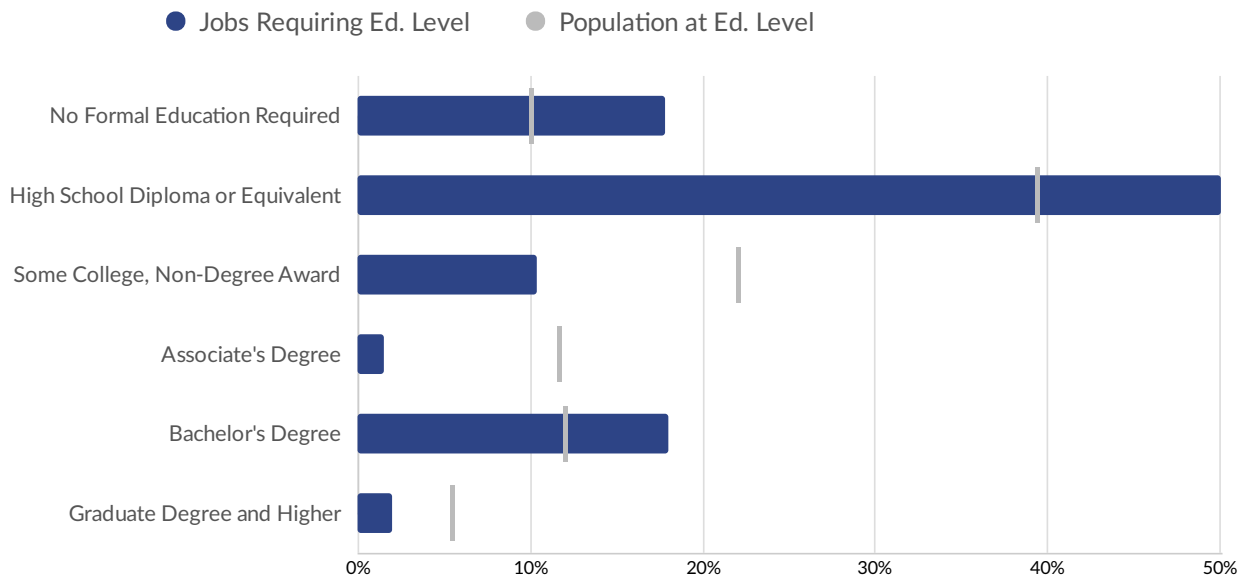

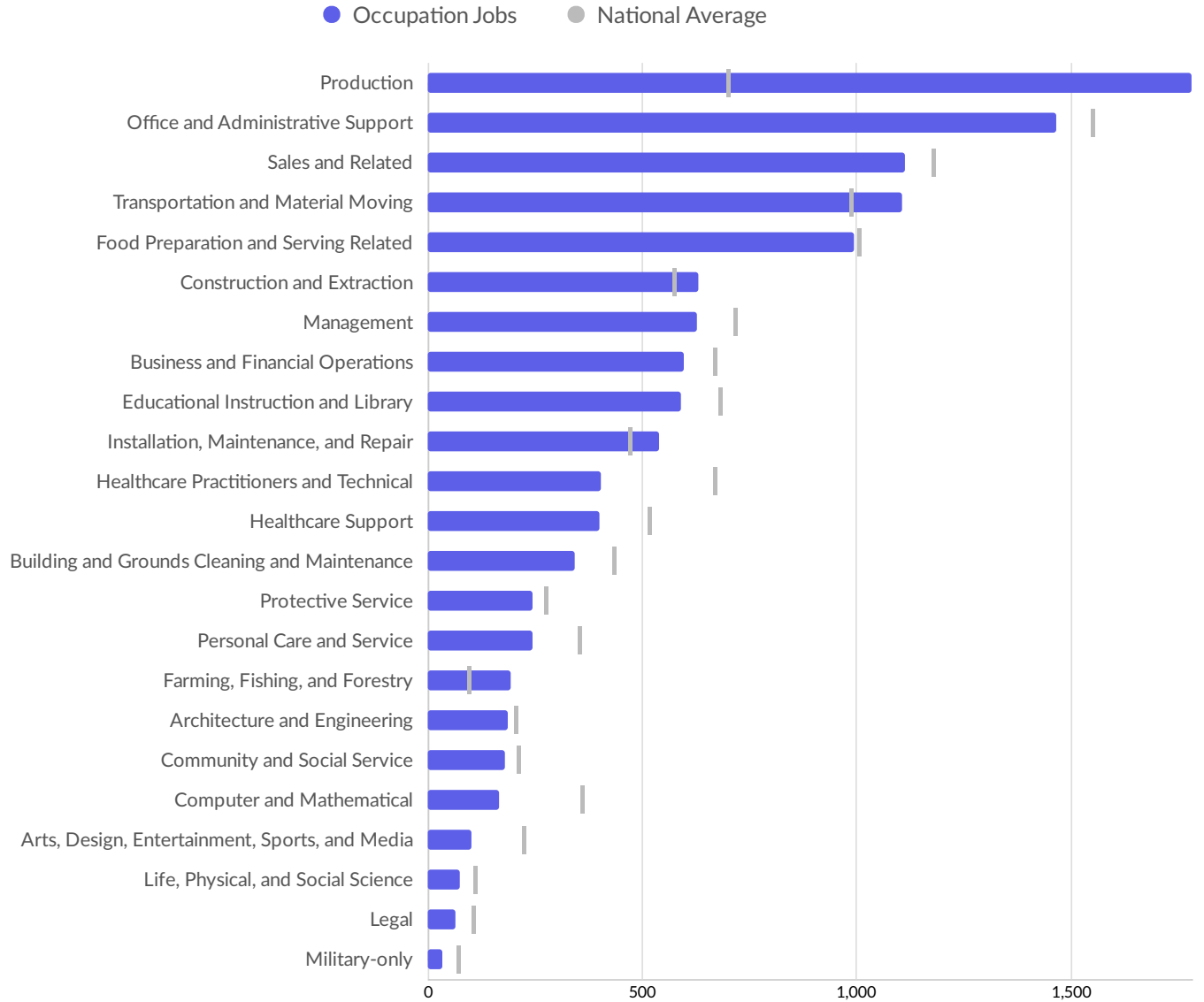
