- Concerning educational attainment, **20.6% of Portage County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.8% above the national average), and **9.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.7% above the national average).






Unemployment Rate Trends

Portage County, WI had a May 2020 unemployment rate of 10.08%, increasing from 4.59% 5 years before.












Top Industry GRP




2019 Gross Regional Product








Top Occupation Earnings






