
Regional average earnings per job are \$13.1K below the national average earnings of \$69.6K per iob.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.1% since 2015, growing by 192. Population is expected to increase by 0.1% between 2020 and 2025, adding 409.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 1.4% in Centergy from 174,065 to 176,579. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 62.9% to 63.0% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, 15.7% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (3.3% below the national average), and 11.8% hold an Associate's Degree (3.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






















Top Industry GRP













Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings








