Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 1.6**% since 2015, growing by 432. Population is expected to **increase by 1.2**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 317.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 2.1% in Juneau County, WI from 10,404 to 10,627. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 4.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 61.1% to 61.1% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.3% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.8% below the national average), and **9.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.










Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI had an August 2020 unemployment rate of 6.06%, increasing from 5.14% 5 years before.






Millennials

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,846 people 55 or older, while there are 9,843 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 10,645 racially diverse people, while there are 2,300 here.




Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 2.44 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime





Top Industry GRP















Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings






