

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.6% since 2015, growing by 123. Population is expected to decrease by 0.4% between 2020 and 2025, losing 78.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 0.6% in Langlade County, WI from 8,700 to 8,649. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 6.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.8% to 58.6% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.3% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.






Unemployment Rate Trends

Langlade County, WI had an August 2020 unemployment rate of 6.65%, increasing from 6.08% 5 years before.






Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 1,609 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,096.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,654 racially diverse people, while there are 1,235 here.








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ





Top Industry GRP













Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings






