

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.5% since 2015, growing by 354. Population is expected to increase by 0.3% between 2020 and 2025, adding 244.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 0.2% in Portage County, WI from 38,675 to 38,751. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 6.0%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.0% to 66.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **20.4% of Portage County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.4% above the national average), and **10.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Insurance Carriers, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (State Government).





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.5% since 2015, growing by 354. Population is expected to increase by 0.3% between 2020 and 2025, adding 244.




Unemployment Rate Trends



Millennials


Portage County, WI has 12,491 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 14,592.






Veterans

Portage County, WI has 3,971 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4.036.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 20,808 people 55 or older, while there are 21,739 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Portage County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 28,230 racially diverse people, while there are 6,454 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry LQ






Top Industry GRP














Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings






Unique Average Monthly Postings


