- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 3.9% since 2015, growing by 833. Population is expected to increase by 2.4% between 2020 and 2025, adding 544.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 8.3% in Vilas County, WI from 8,924 to 9,663. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 6.2% by 2.1%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 55.3% to 50.9% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.8% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% below the national average), and **8.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).







millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,576.






Vilas County, WI has 2,094 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.249.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,525 people 55 or older, while there are 11,149 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,853 racially diverse people, while there are 3,350 here.




Property Crime





Top Industry GRP















Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings






