- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 0.7**% since 2015, falling by 519. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.5**% between 2020 and 2025, losing 370.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs increased by 3.4% in Wood County, WI from 40,644 to 42,037. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 6.2% by 2.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 56.6% to 60.2% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.3% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.8% below the national average), and **12.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Outpatient Care Centers, General Freight Trucking, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.






Unemployment Rate Trends

Wood County, WI had an August 2020 unemployment rate of 6.24%, increasing from 5.50% 5 years before.








Millennials

millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 15,051.






Wood County, WI has 5,487 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 4.156.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 21,463 people 55 or older, while there are 26,964 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 29,118 racially diverse people, while there are 5,816 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Occupations







Top Occupation Earnings


2019 Median Hourly Earnings





Unique Average Monthly Postings




