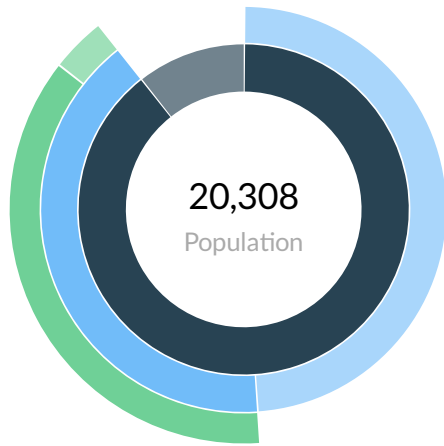
Median household income is **\$16.5K below** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 1.4%** since 2015, growing by 280. Population is expected to **increase by 0.8%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 157.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 5.6%** in Adams County, WI from 5,977 to **5,640**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.1% by 8.7%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 46.8% to 45.3% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.7% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.4% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.

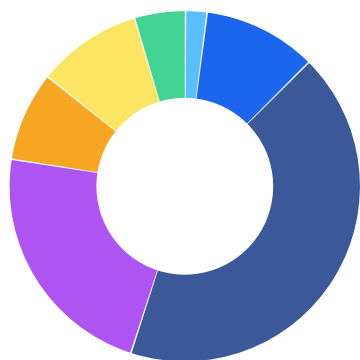

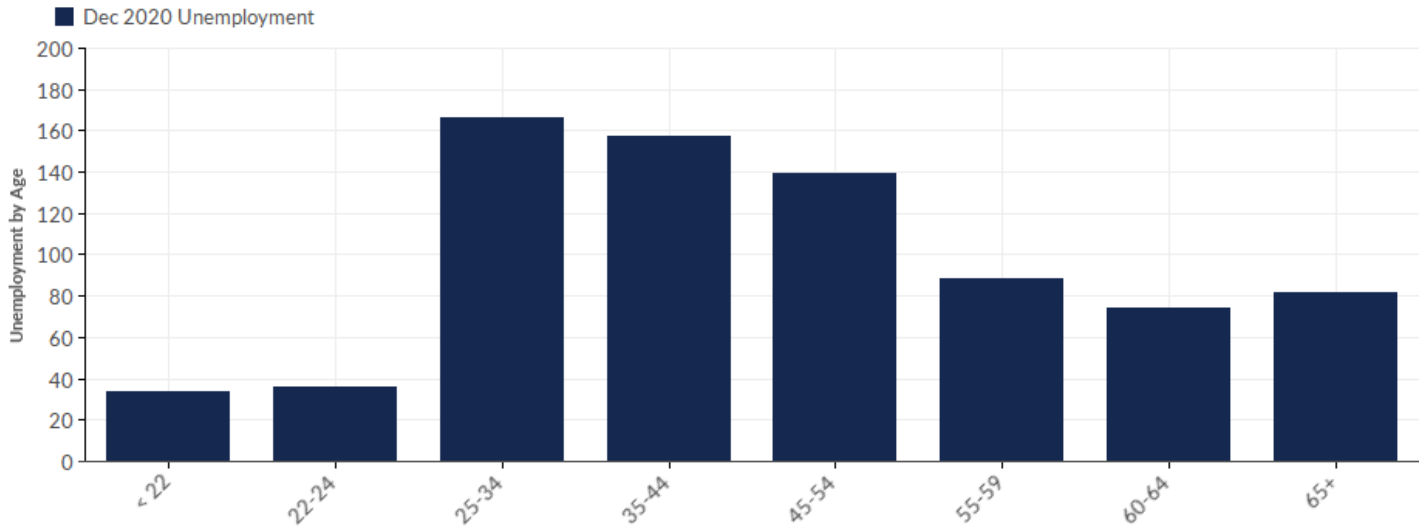

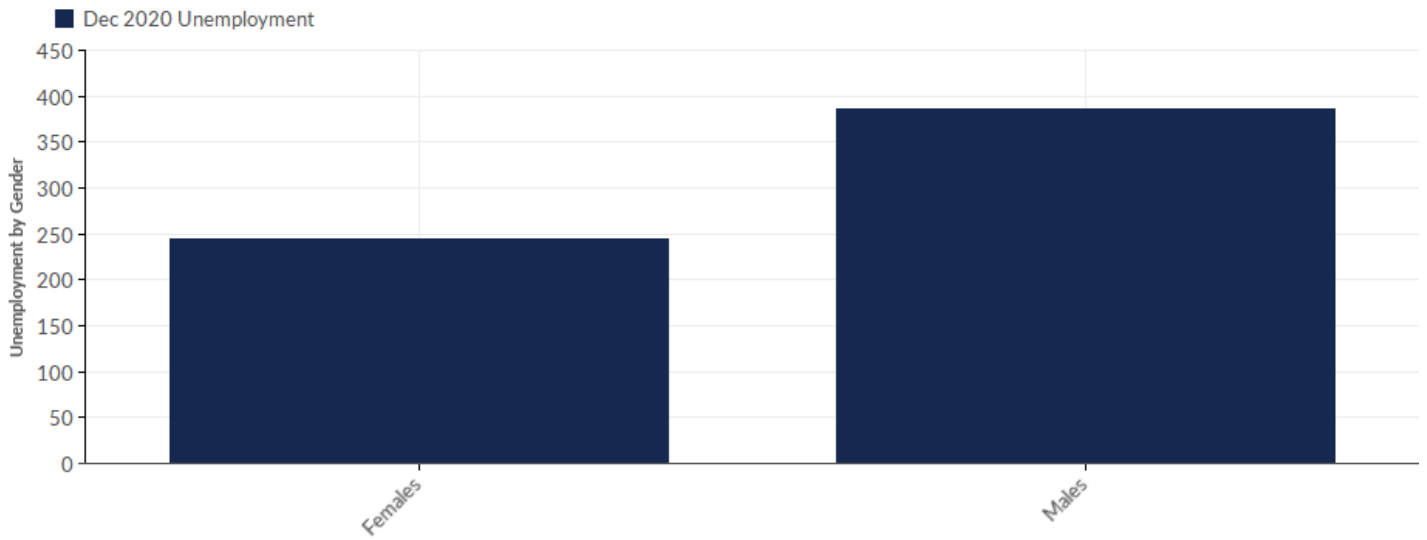

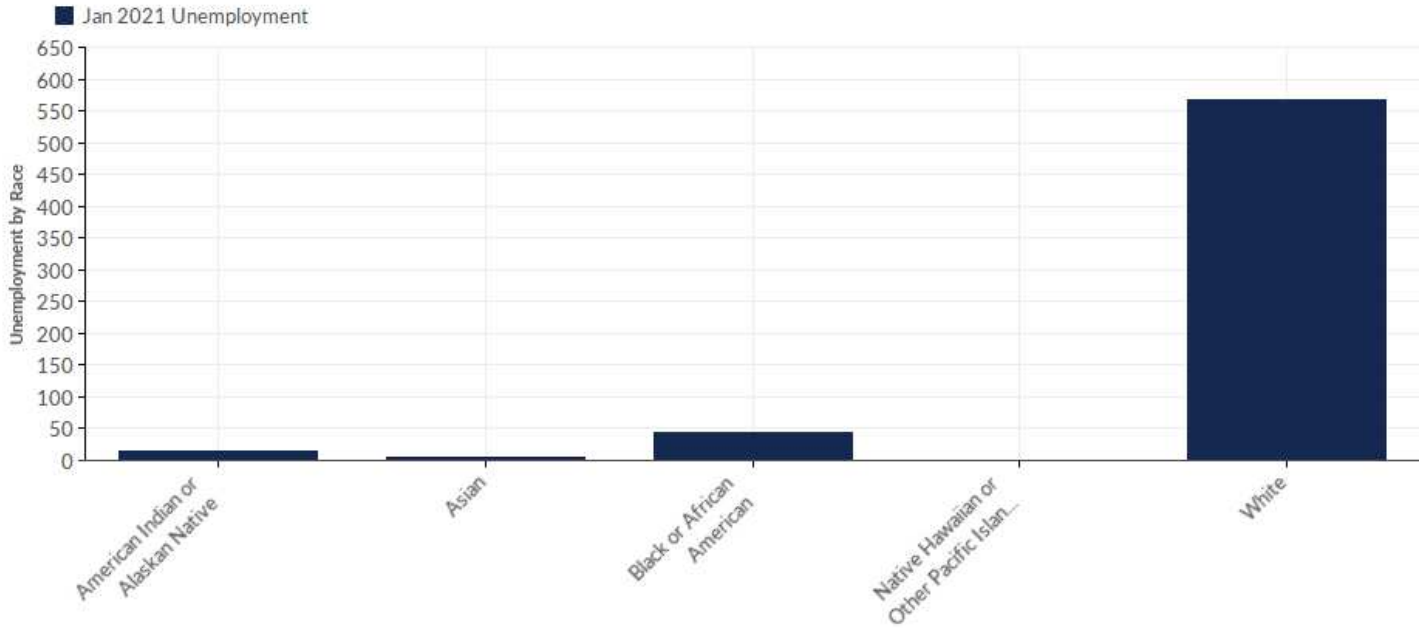

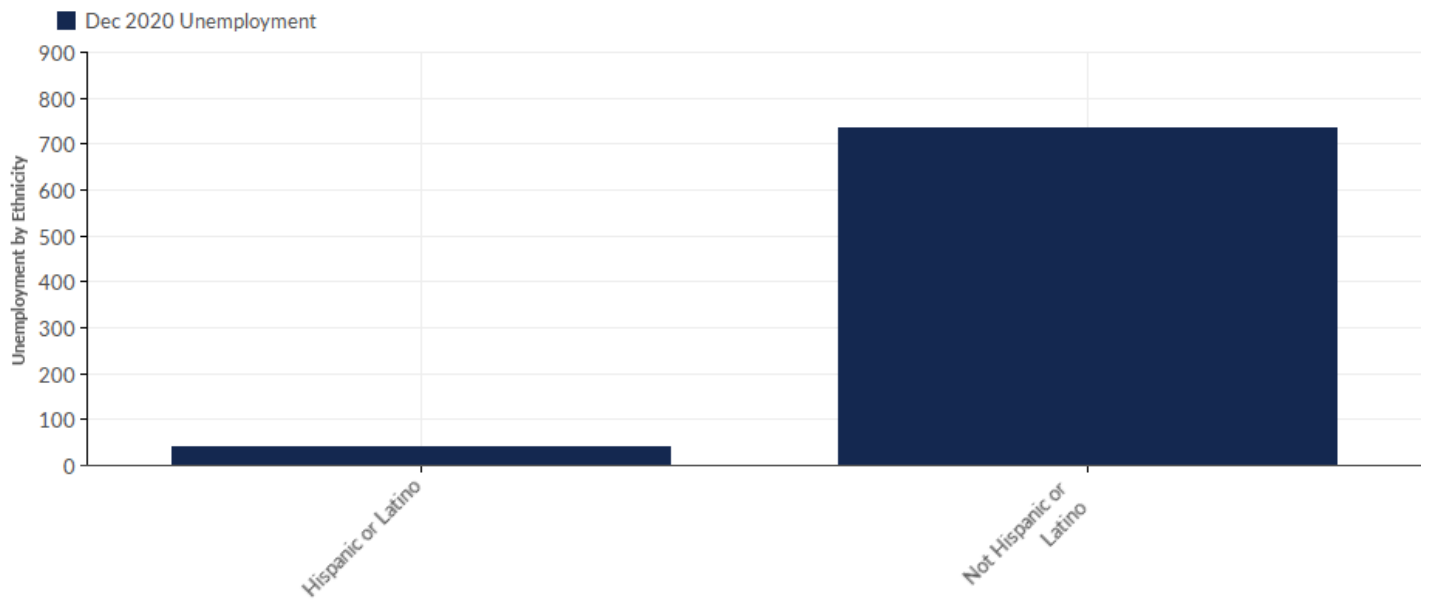

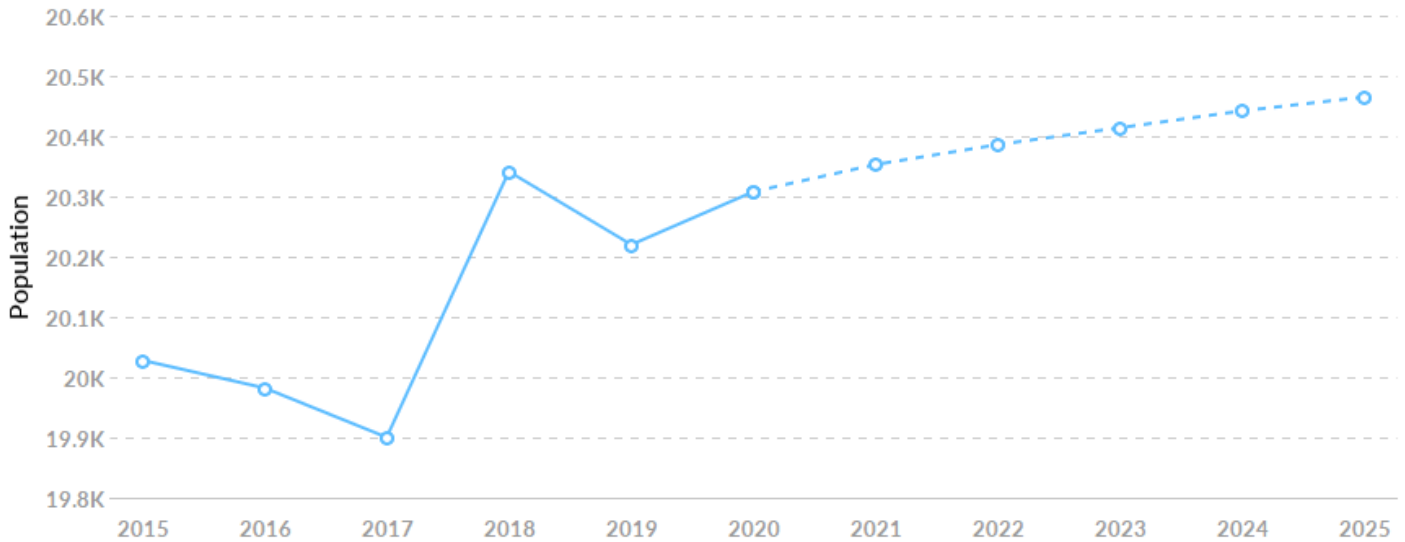

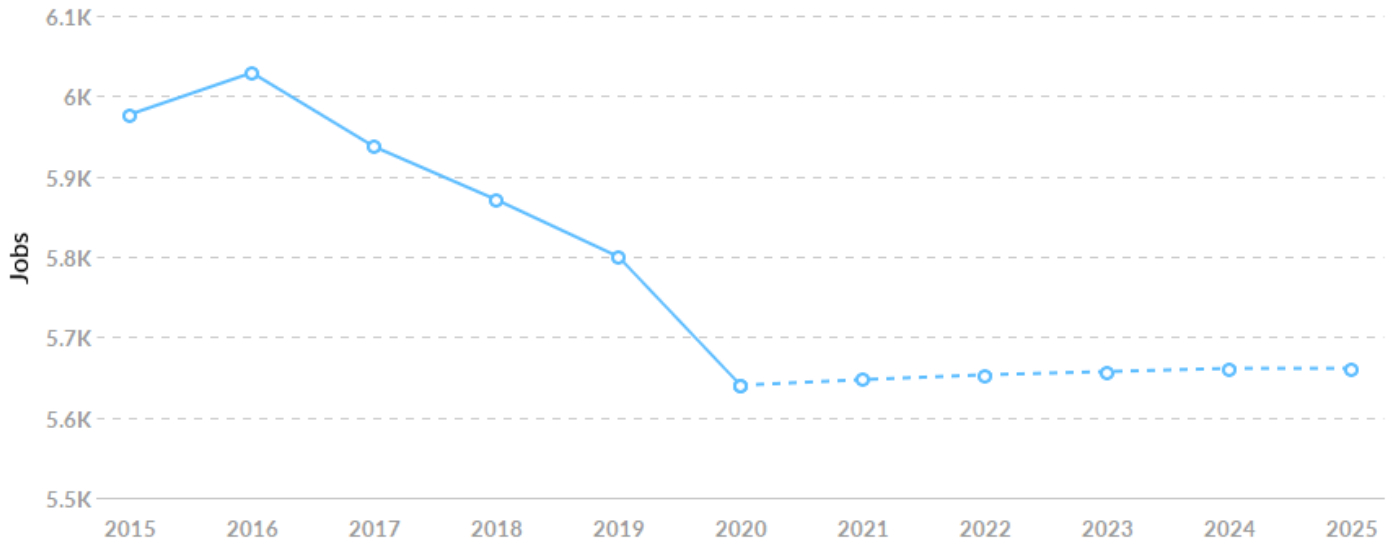

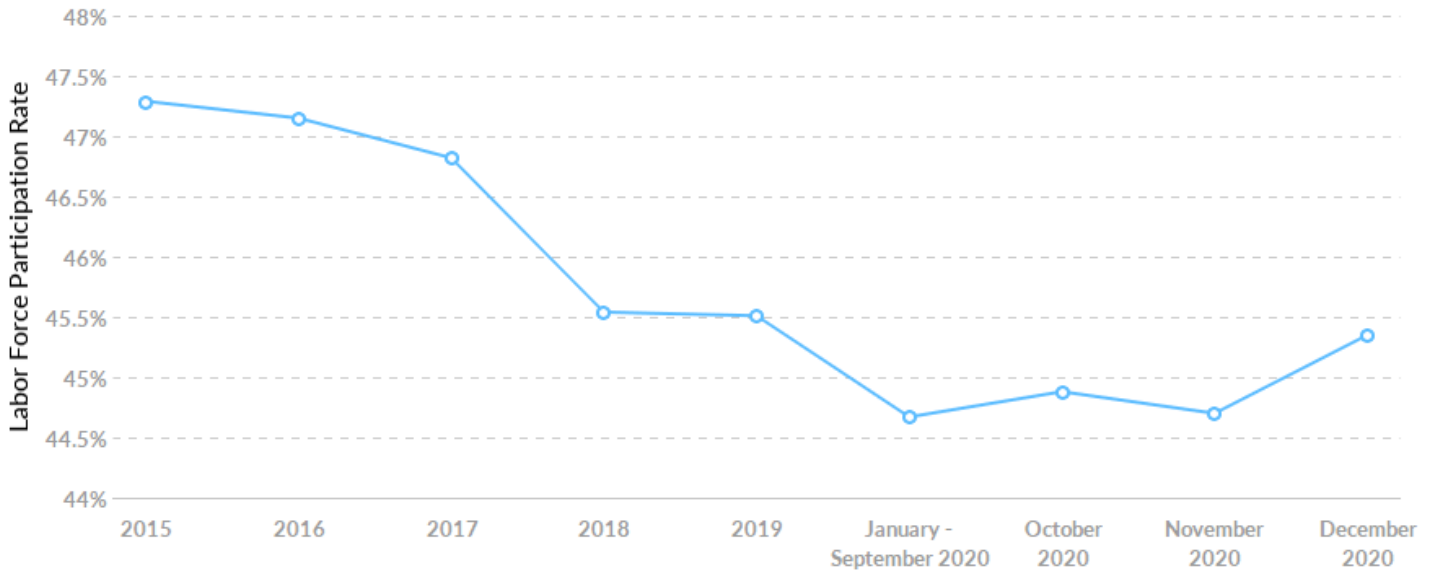
Job Trends

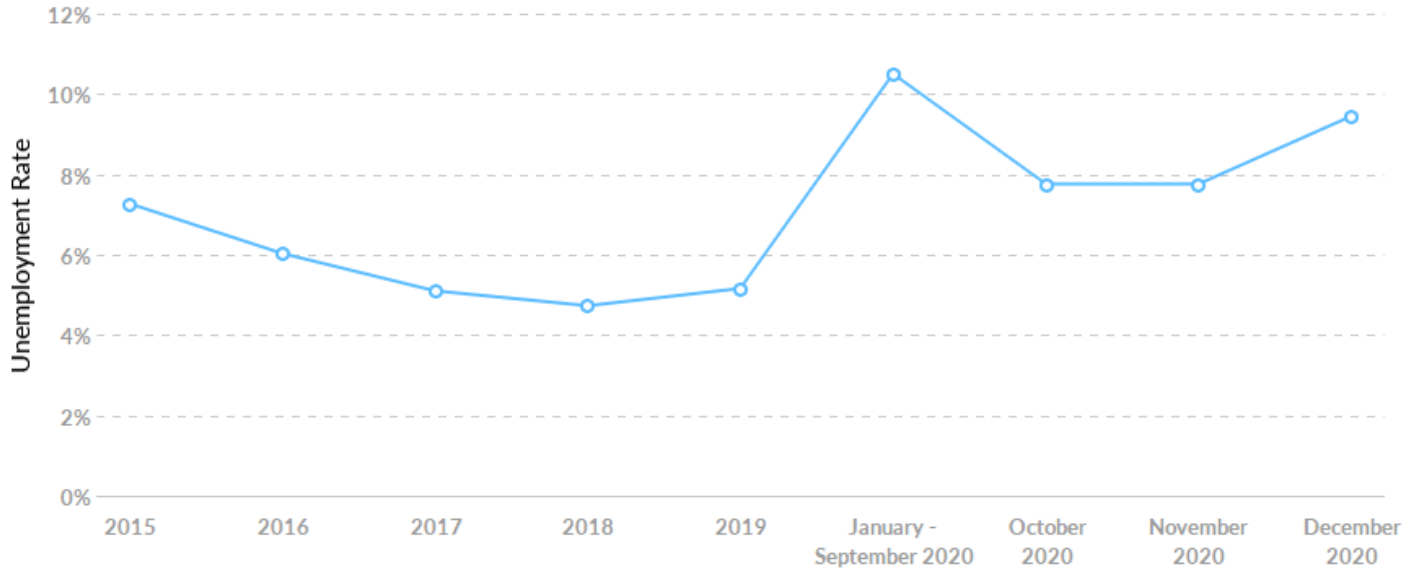

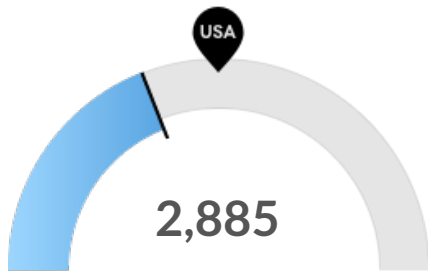
Unemployment Rate Trends

Adams County, WI had a December 2020 unemployment rate of 9.45%, **increasing from 7.27%** 5 years before.



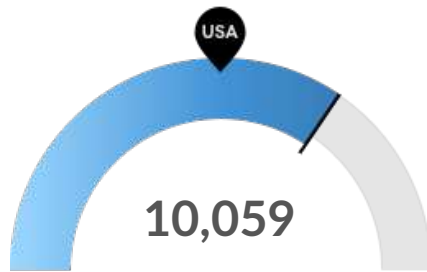

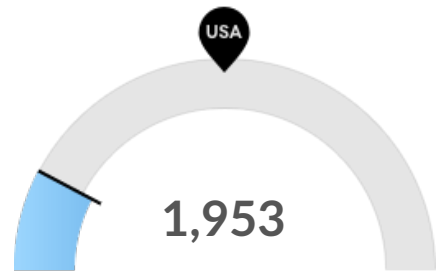
Millennials

Adams County, WI has 2,885 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,169.



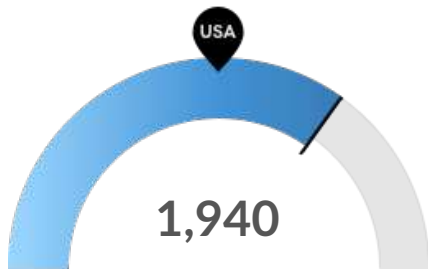
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,945 people 55 or older, while there are 10,059 here.



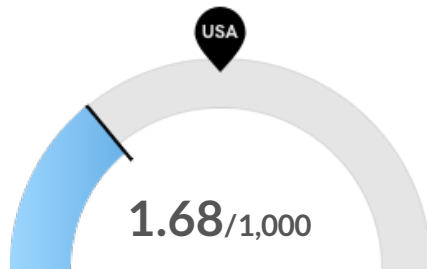
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,065 racially diverse people, while there are 1,953 here.



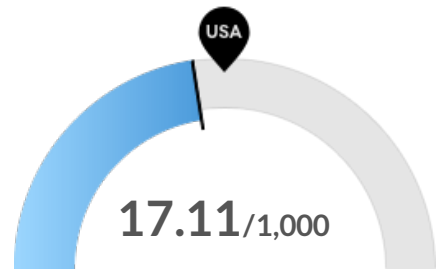
Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1.68 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

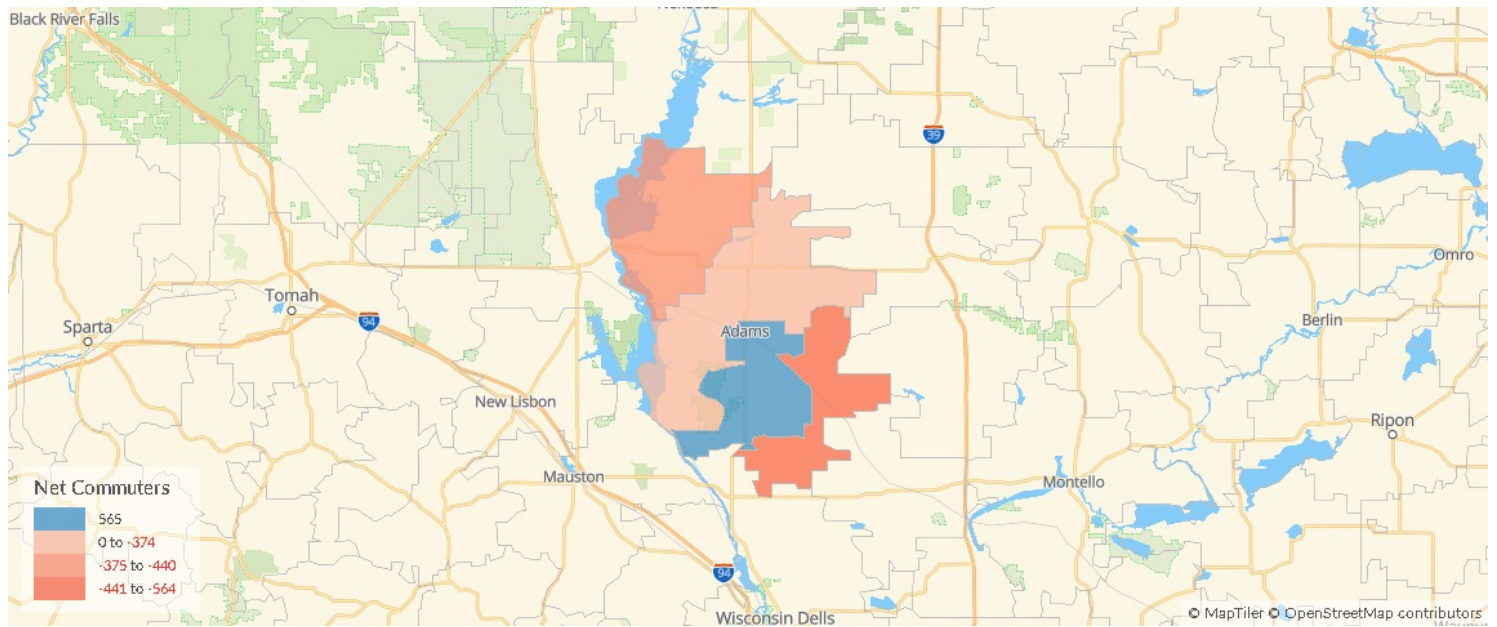


Property Crime

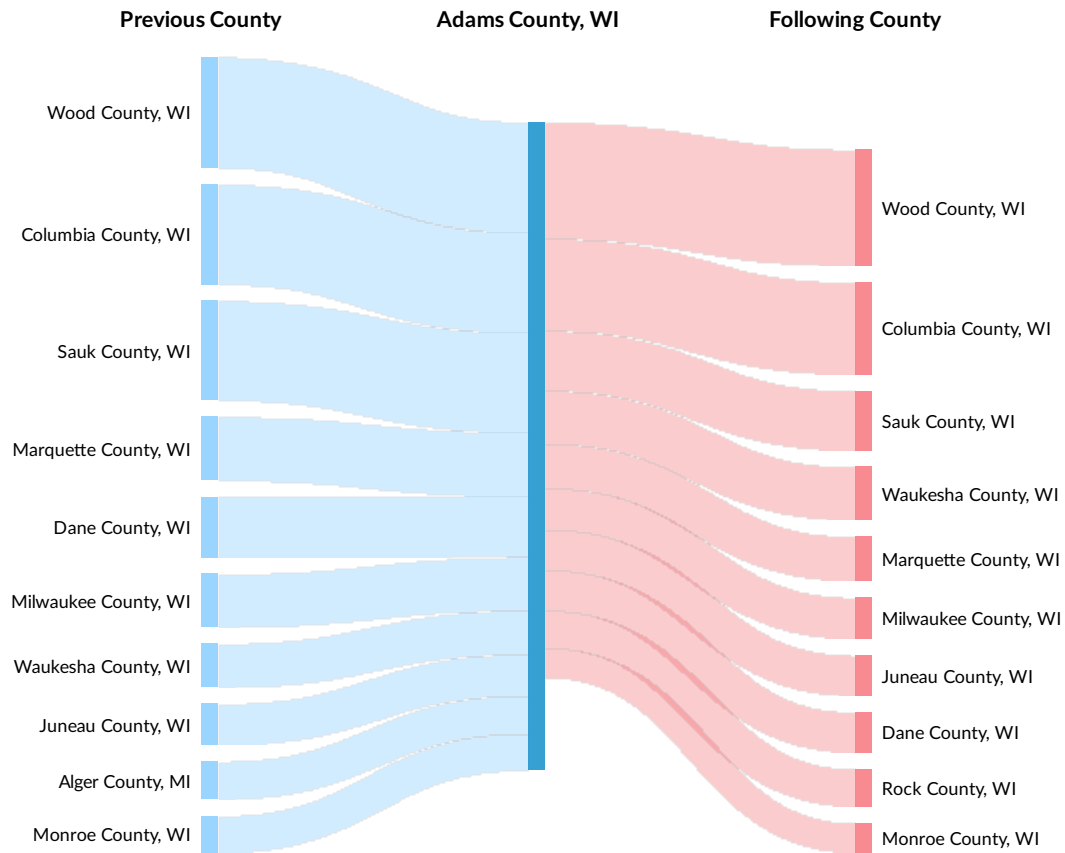

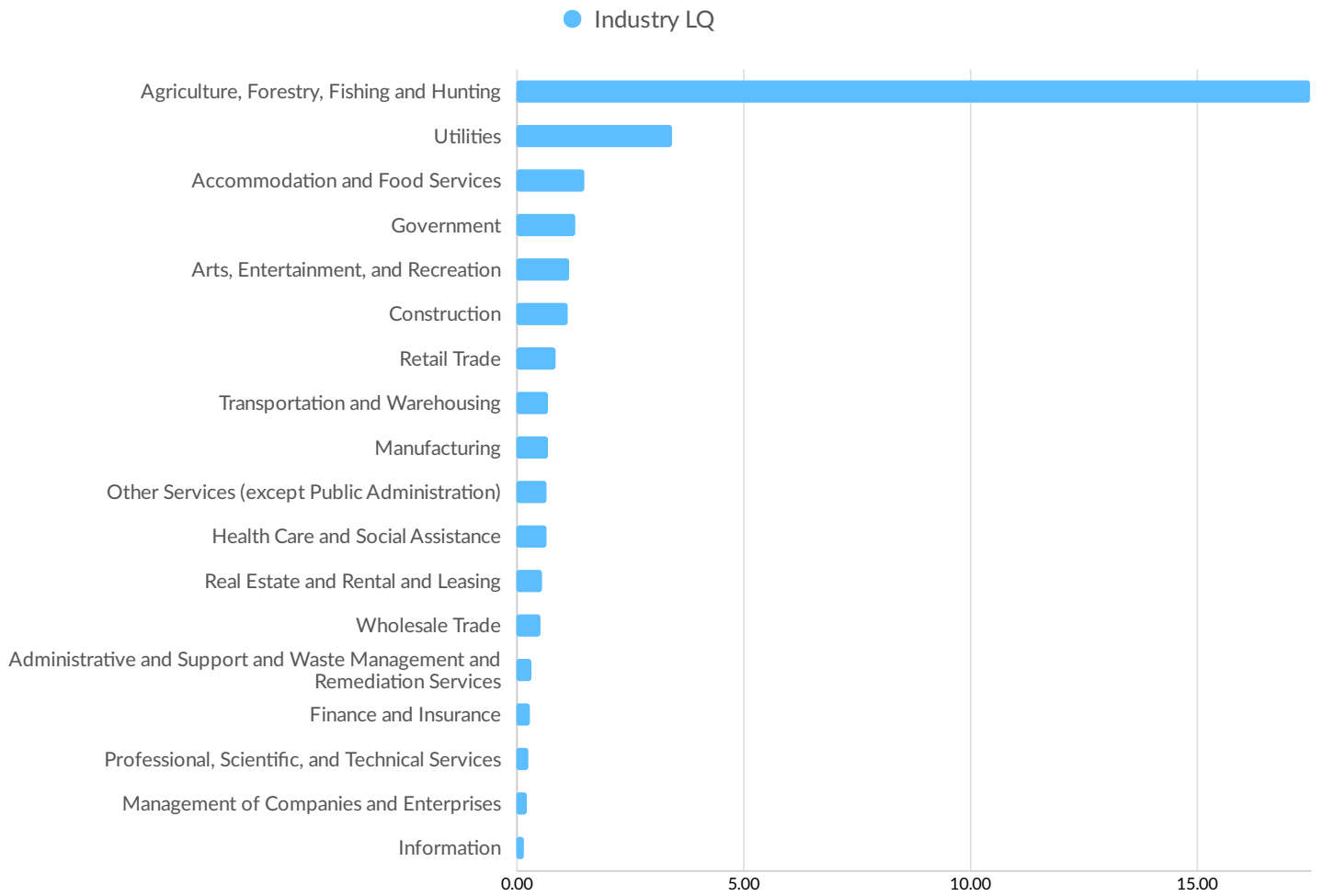

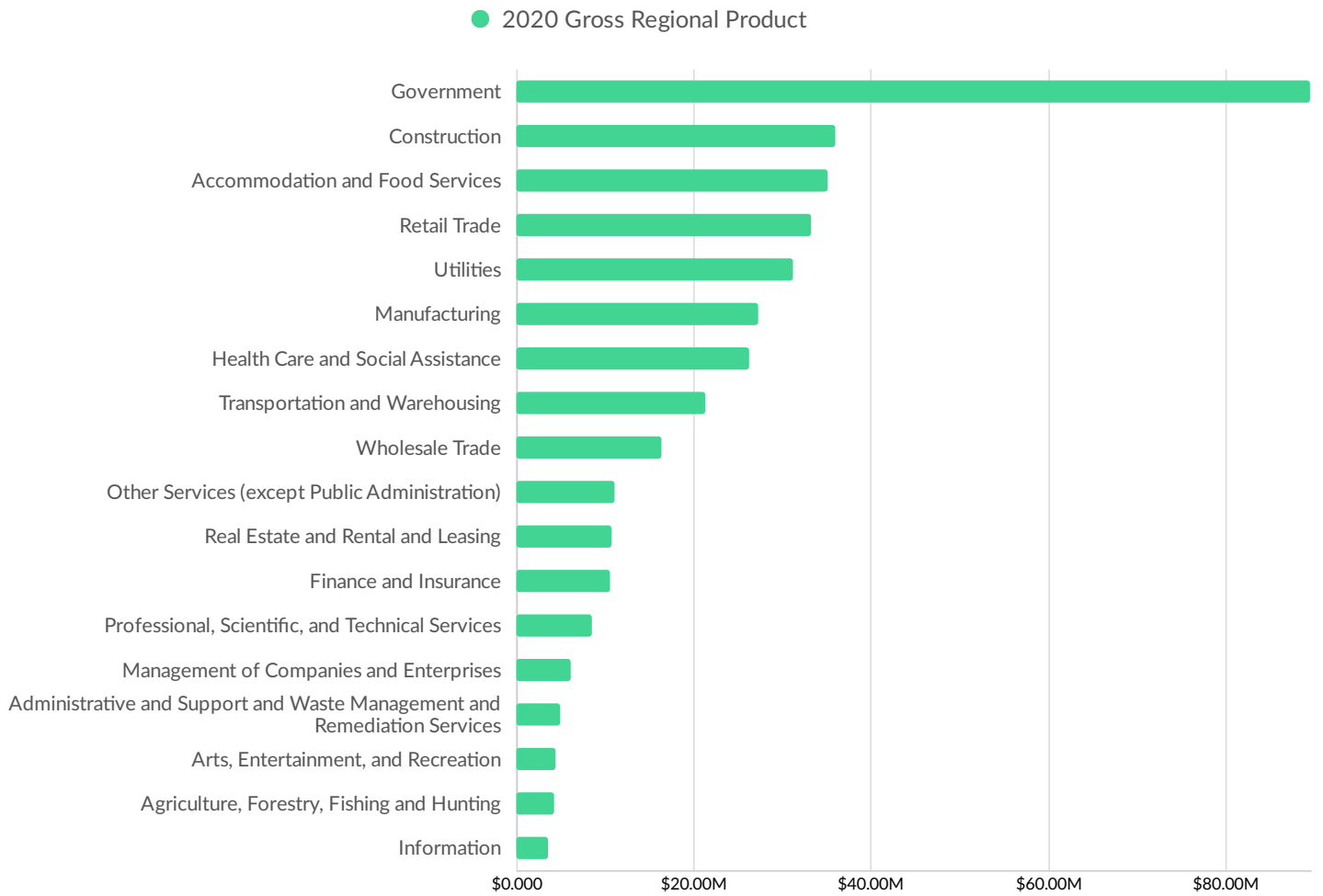
Top Growing Industries



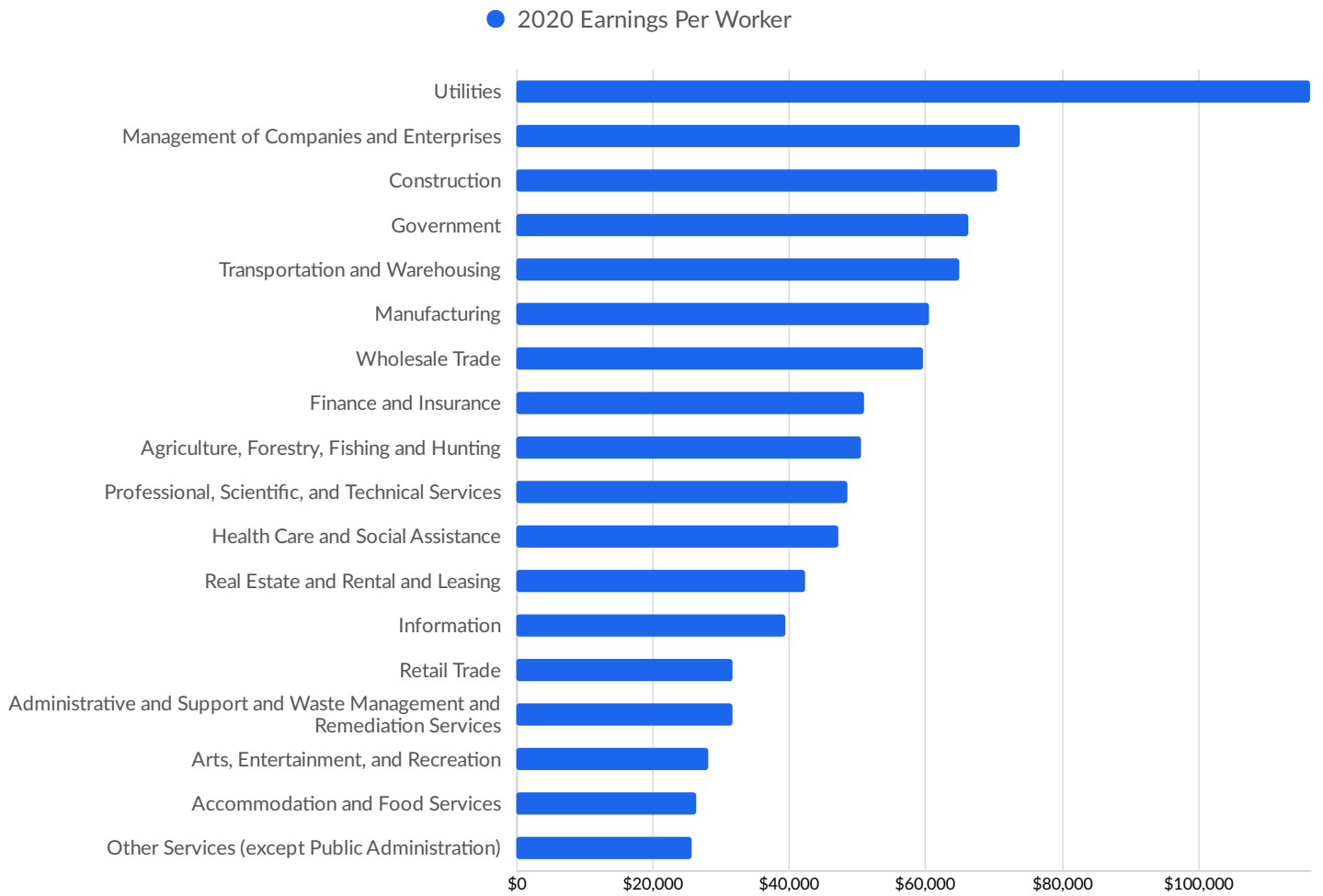
Top Industry LQ



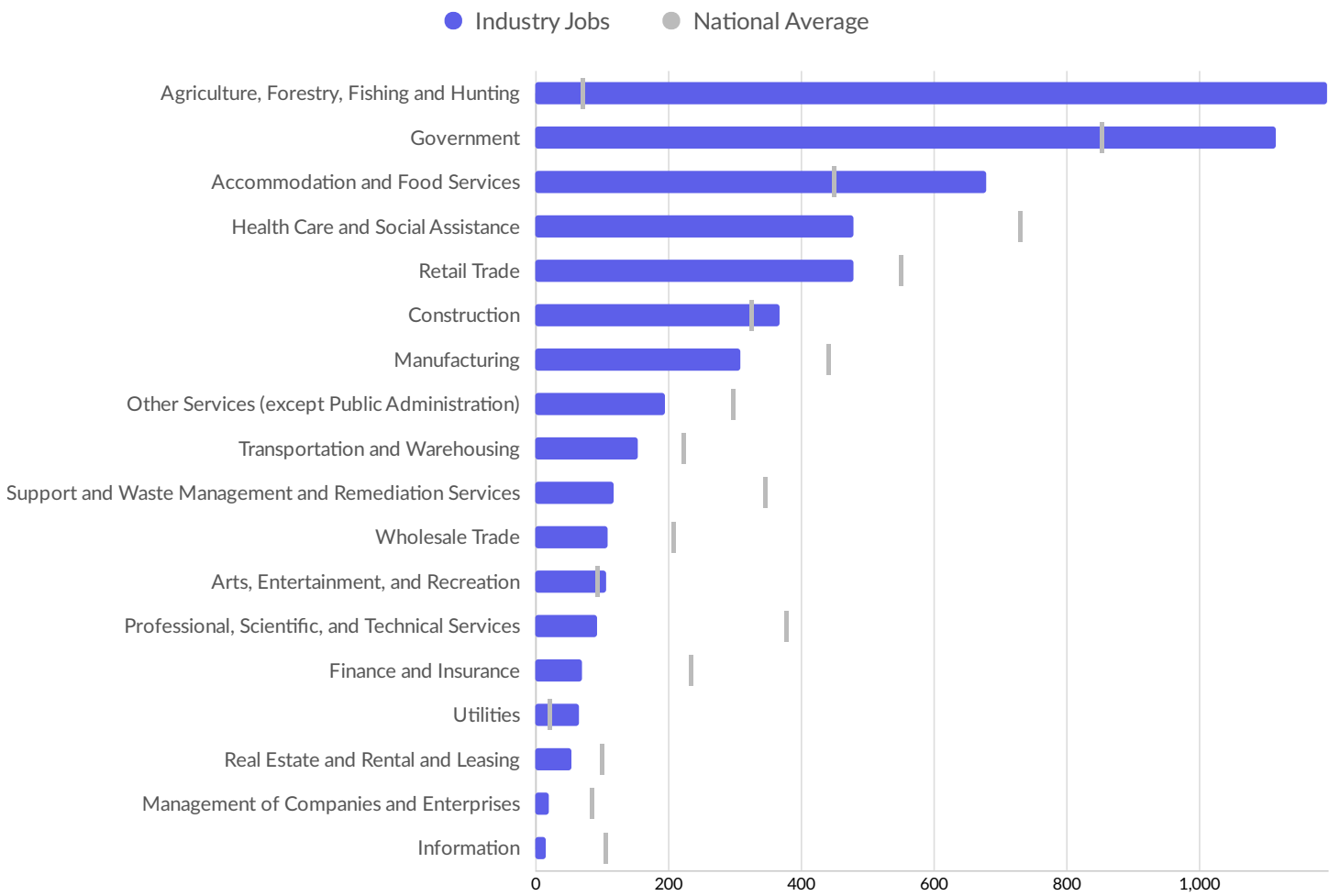

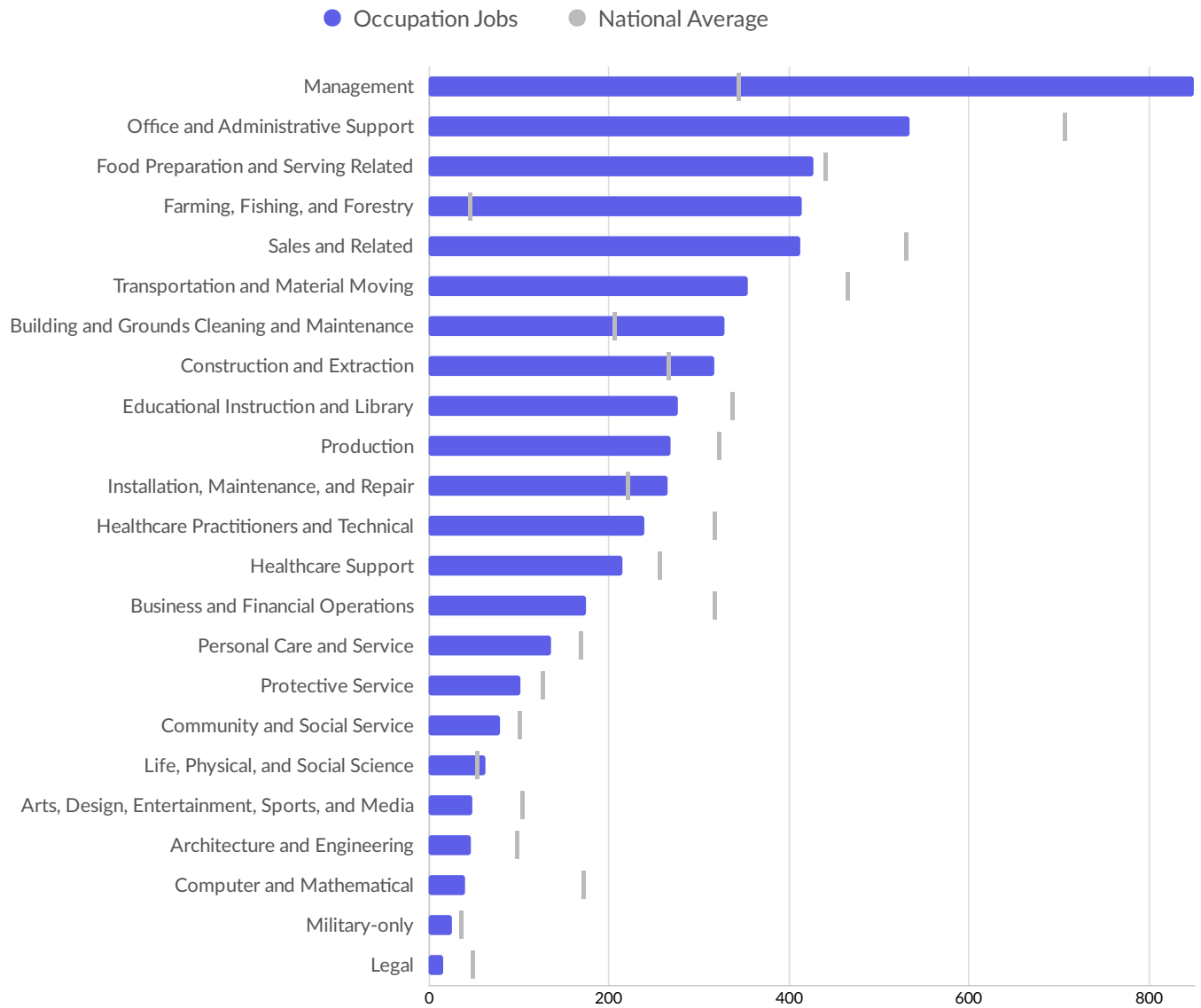

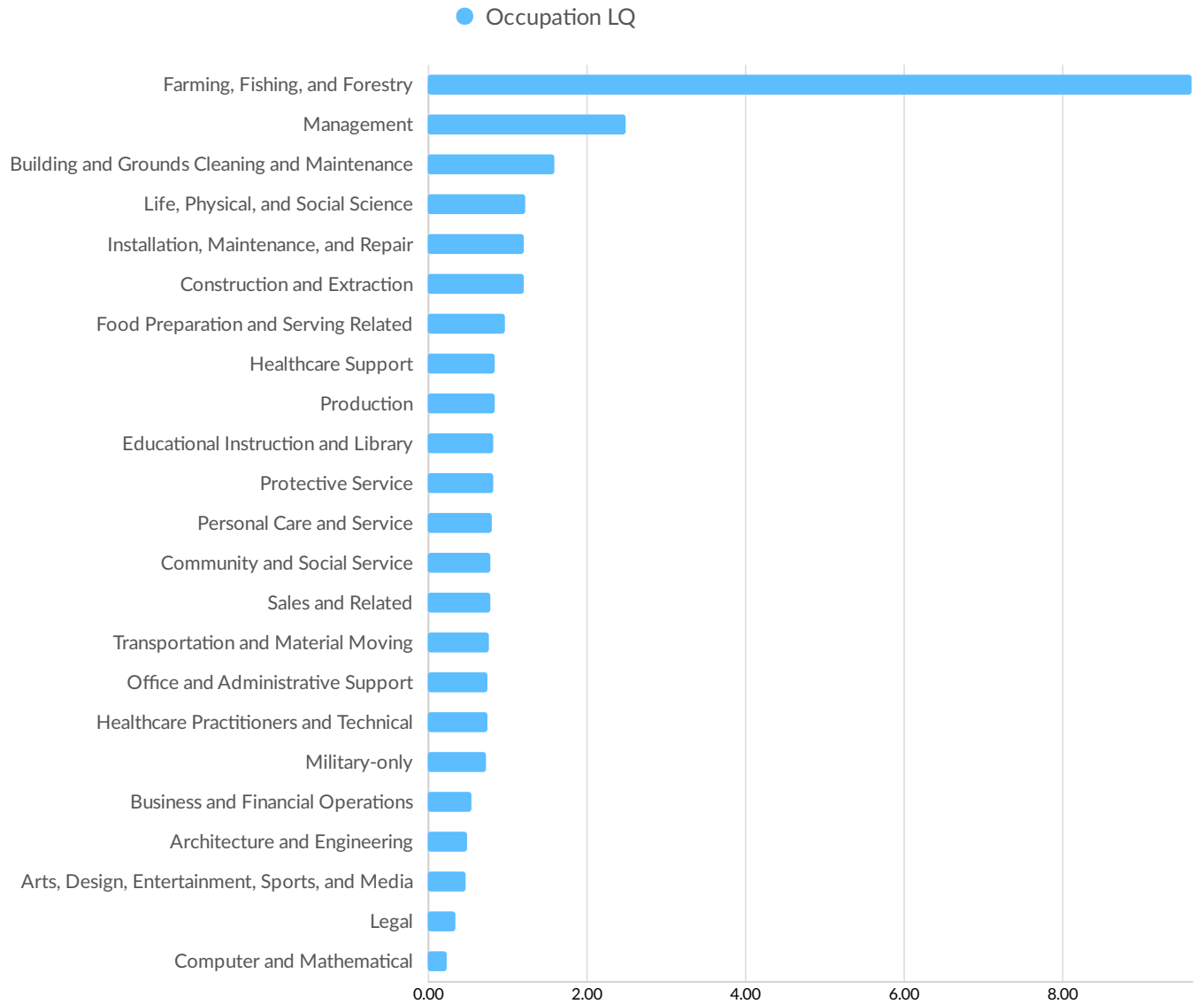

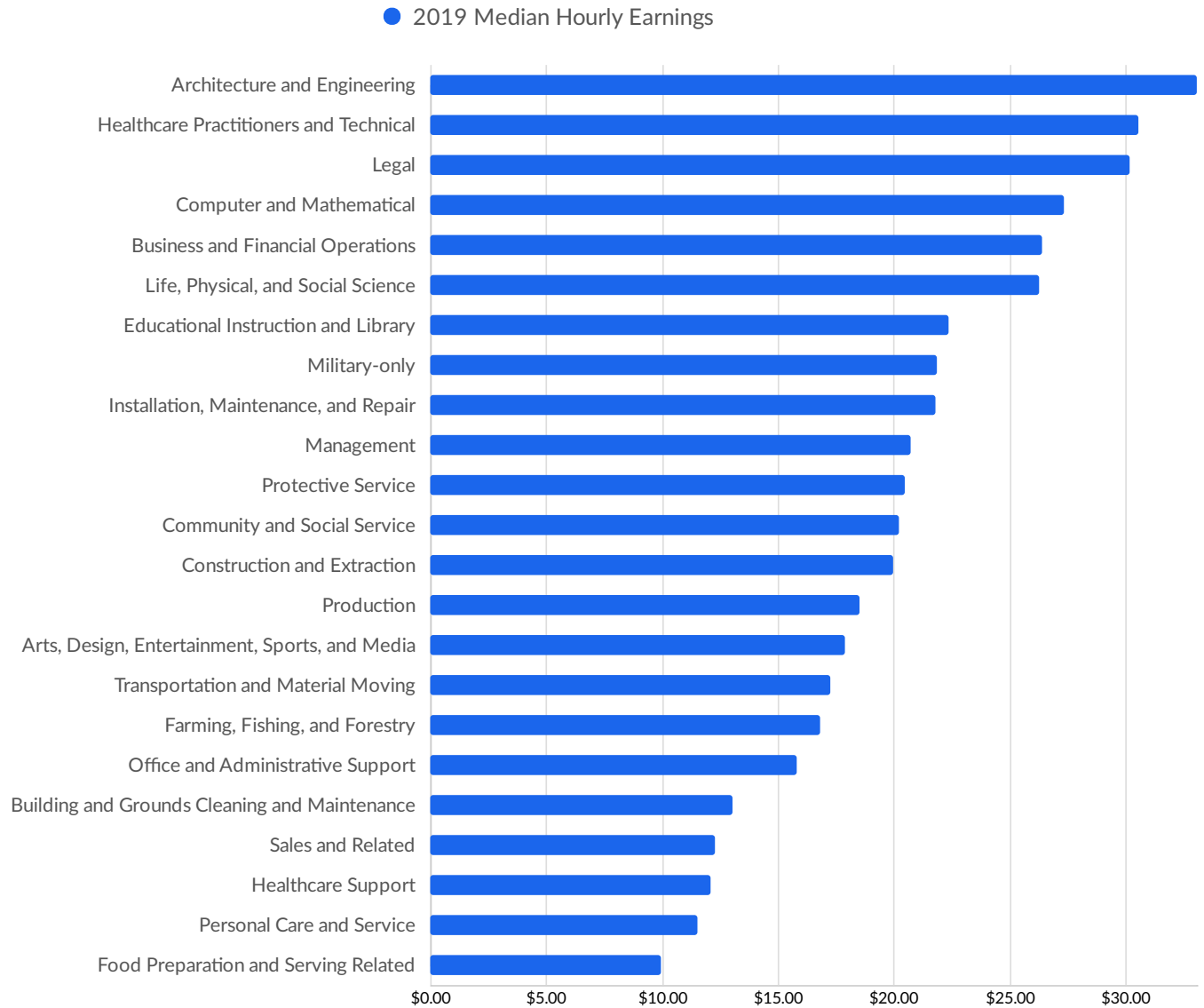

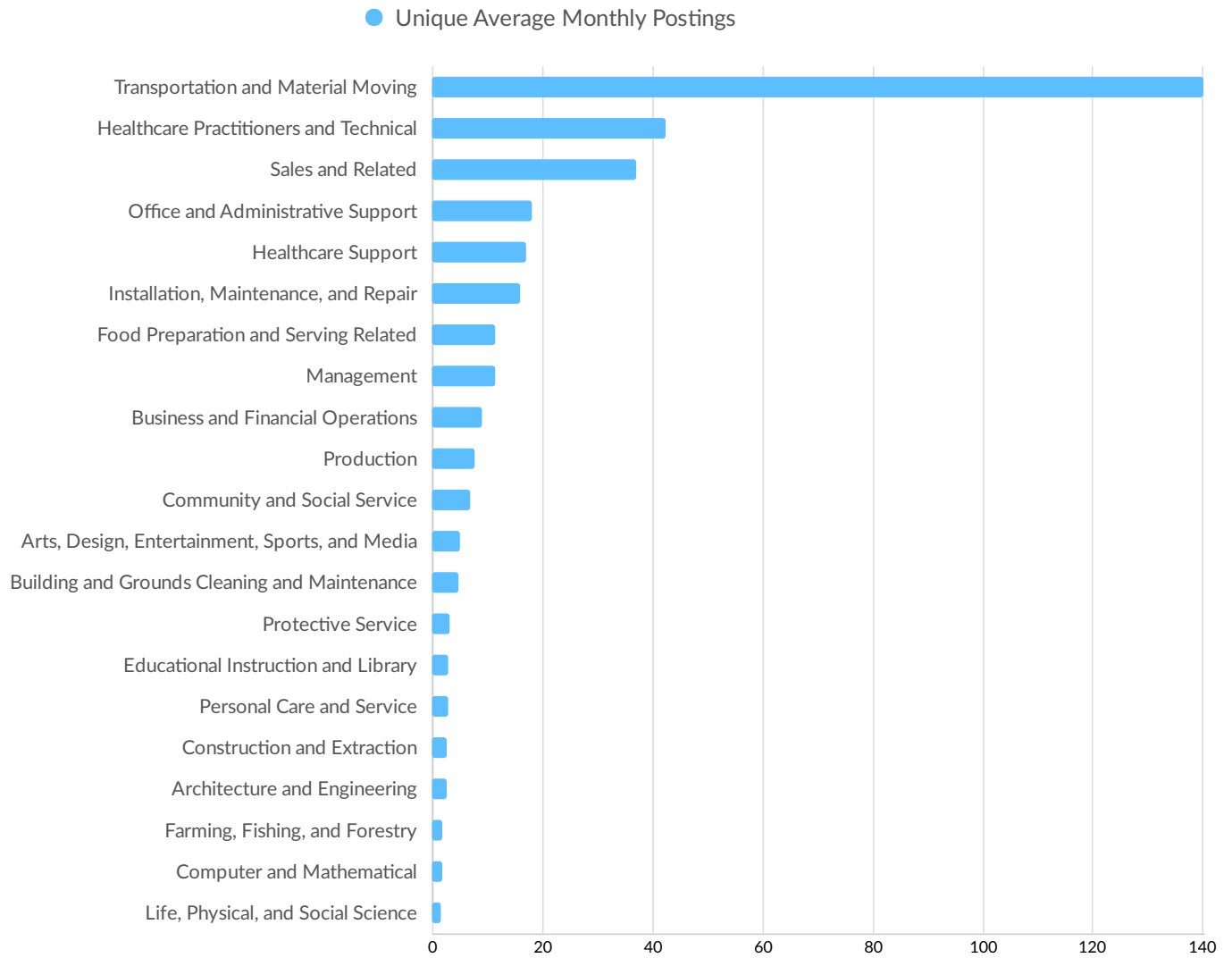

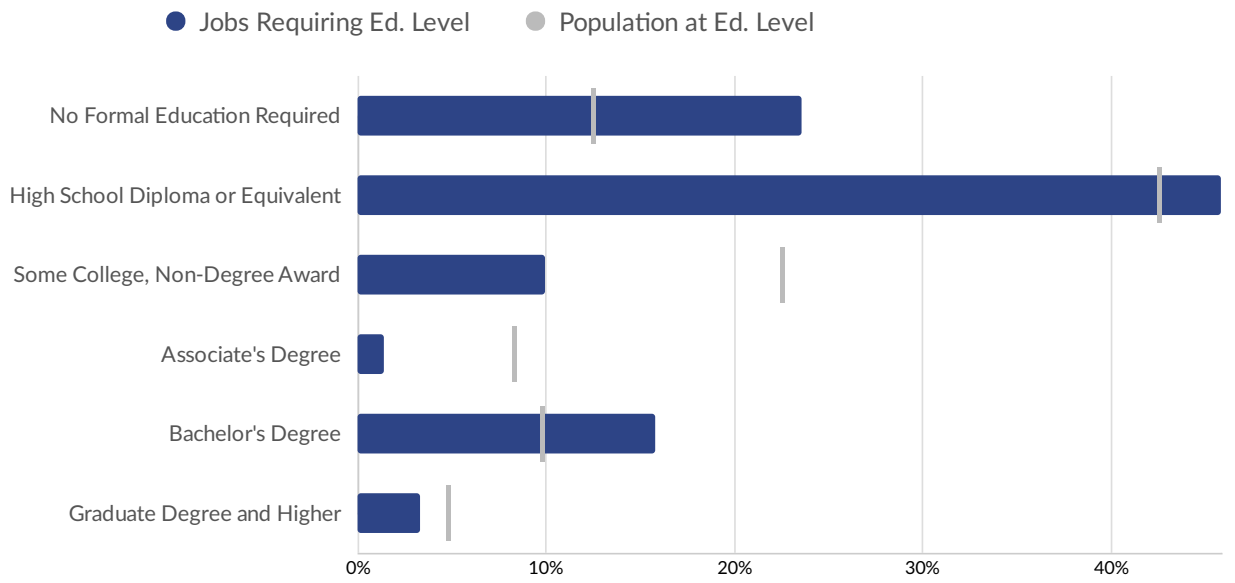

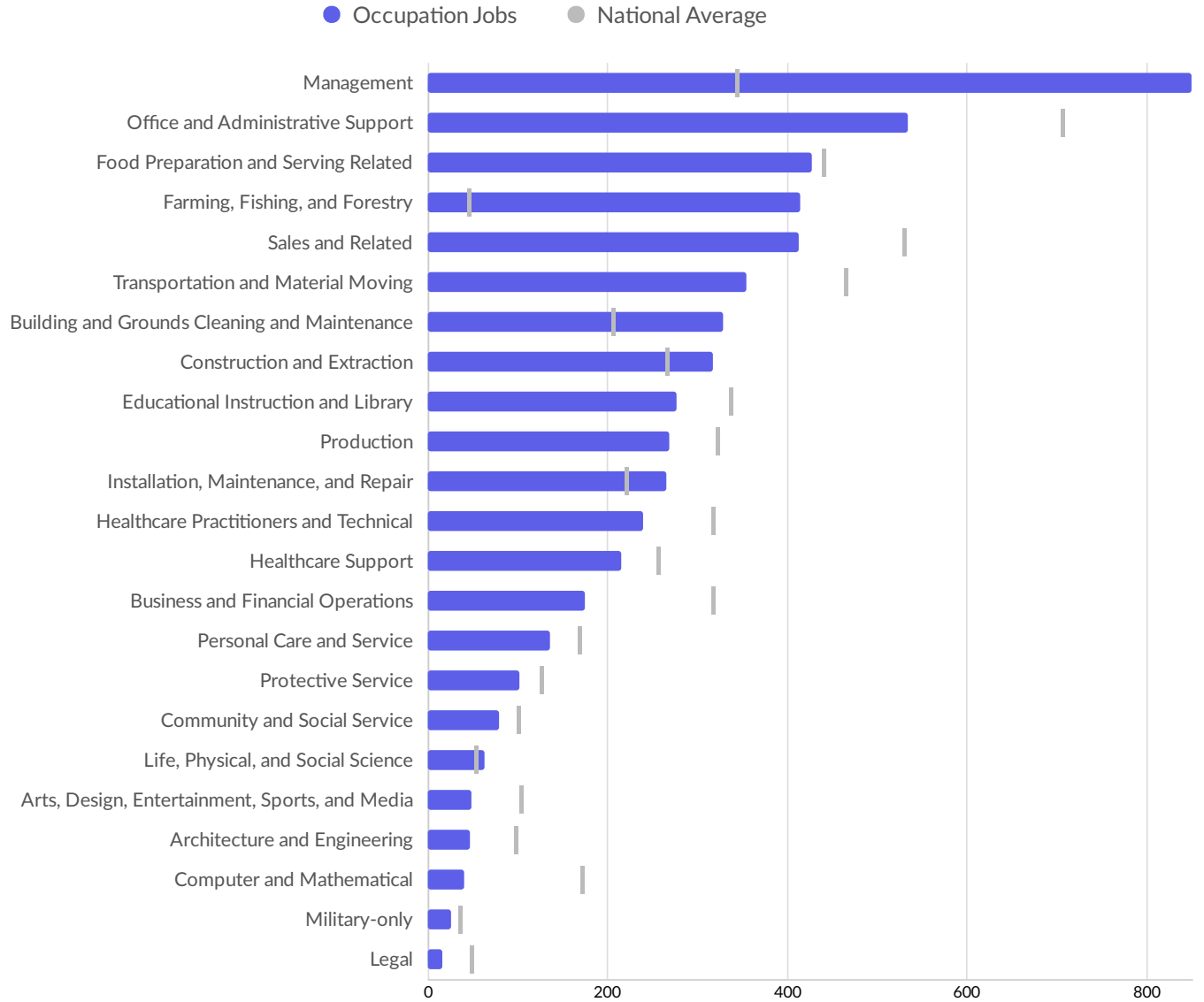
