

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population **declined by 0.7**% since 2015, falling by 205. Population is expected to **increase by 0.4**% between 2020 and 2025, adding 104.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 5.3% in Lincoln County, WI from 12,148 to 11,500. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 6.6%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.9% to 62.1% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.2% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.9% below the national average), and **12.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Insurance Carriers, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



#### **Educational Attainment**






### **Unemployment by Gender**



### **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





#### **Job Trends**






### **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Lincoln County, WI had a February 2021 unemployment rate of 5.18%, increasing from 4.26% 5 years before.






#### Millennials

Lincoln County, WI has 4,222 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,689.




#### **Veterans**

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,113 people 55 or older, while there are 11,104 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,006 racially diverse people, while there are 1,331 here.




#### **Property Crime**
















#### 2020 Median Hourly Earnings






