- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 0.4% since 2015, growing by 510. Population is expected to increase by 0.0% between 2020 and 2025, adding 61.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 1.8% in Marathon County, WI from 77,164 to 75,802. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 3.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 67.0% to 65.3% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.6% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **13.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity








Unemployment Rate Trends

Marathon County, WI had a March 2021 unemployment rate of 3.83%, increasing from 3.48% 5 years before.










Marathon County, WI has 8,589 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 7.536.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 39,895 people 55 or older, while there are 44,382 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 54,125 racially diverse people, while there are 15,954 here.




Property Crime








Top Industry GRP










Top Occupation Earnings


2020 Median Hourly Earnings








