#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.4% since 2015, growing by 471. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2020 and 2025, adding 211.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs declined by 9.3% in Adams County, WI from 5,977 to 5,422. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 9.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 50.6% to 46.5% between 2015 and 2020.
- Concerning educational attainment, 9.6% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (10.4% below the national average), and 8.2% hold an Associate's Degree (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).








### **Unemployment by Gender**



### **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





As of 2020 the region's population increased by 2.4% since 2015, growing by 471. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2020 and 2025, adding 211.



#### **Job Trends**





Adams County, WI had a July 2021 unemployment rate of 6.24%, increasing from 5.88% 5 years before.










Adams County, WI has 1,940 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1.125.

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,101 people 55 or older, while there are 10,277 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,256 racially diverse people, while there are 2,077 here.




#### **Property Crime**






### **Top Industry Location Quotient**







#### **Top Occupation Location Quotient**









