Regional average earnings per job are **\$14.2K below** the national average earnings of \$74.2K per job.

Takeaways

- As of 2020 the region's population **increased by 0.0%** since 2015, growing by 93. Population is expected to **increase by 0.2%** between 2020 and 2025, adding 789.
- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 3.5%** in Centergy from 175,126 to **168,952**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 0.0% by 3.5%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 65.3% to 63.1% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.0% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.0% below the national average), and **12.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

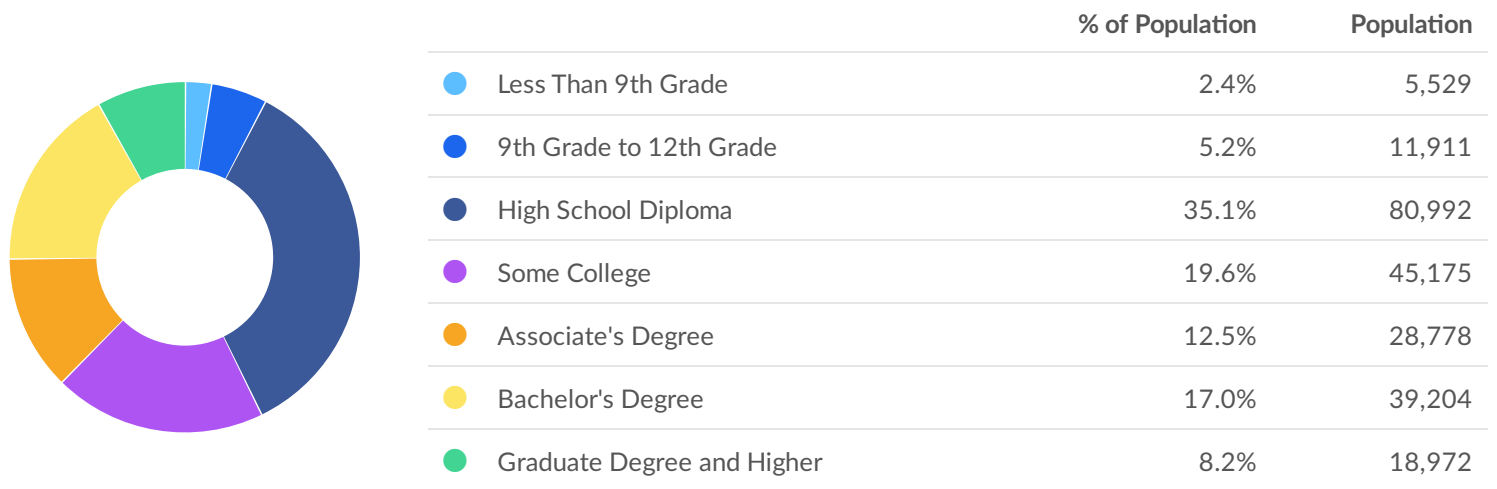

Dec 2020 Labor Force Breakdown



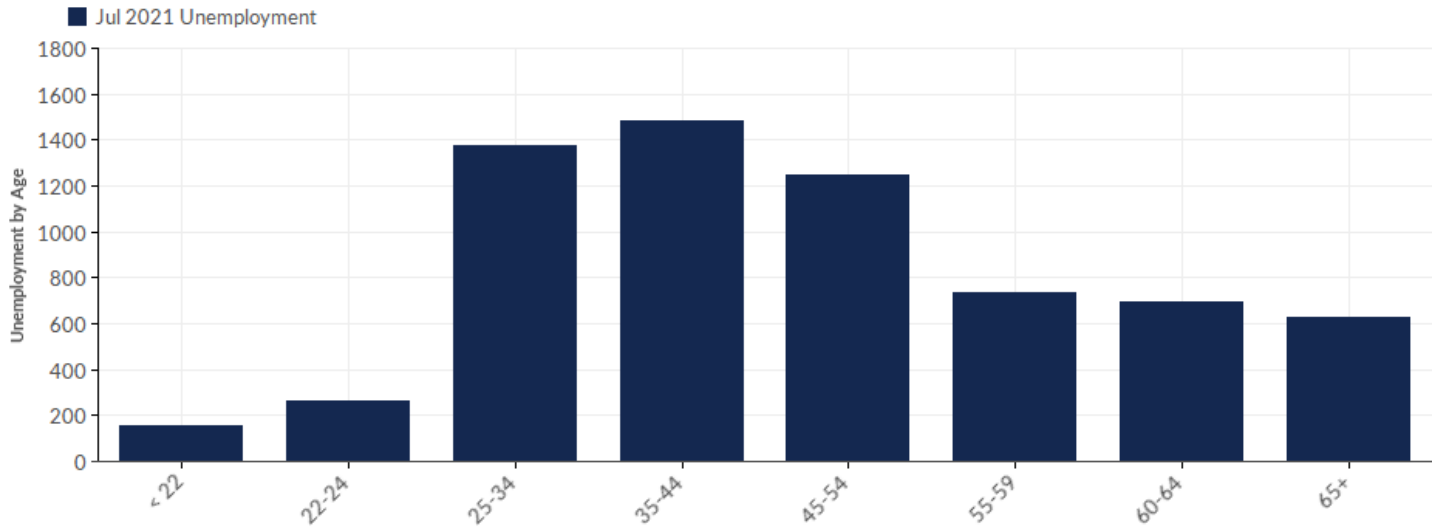
Educational Attainment

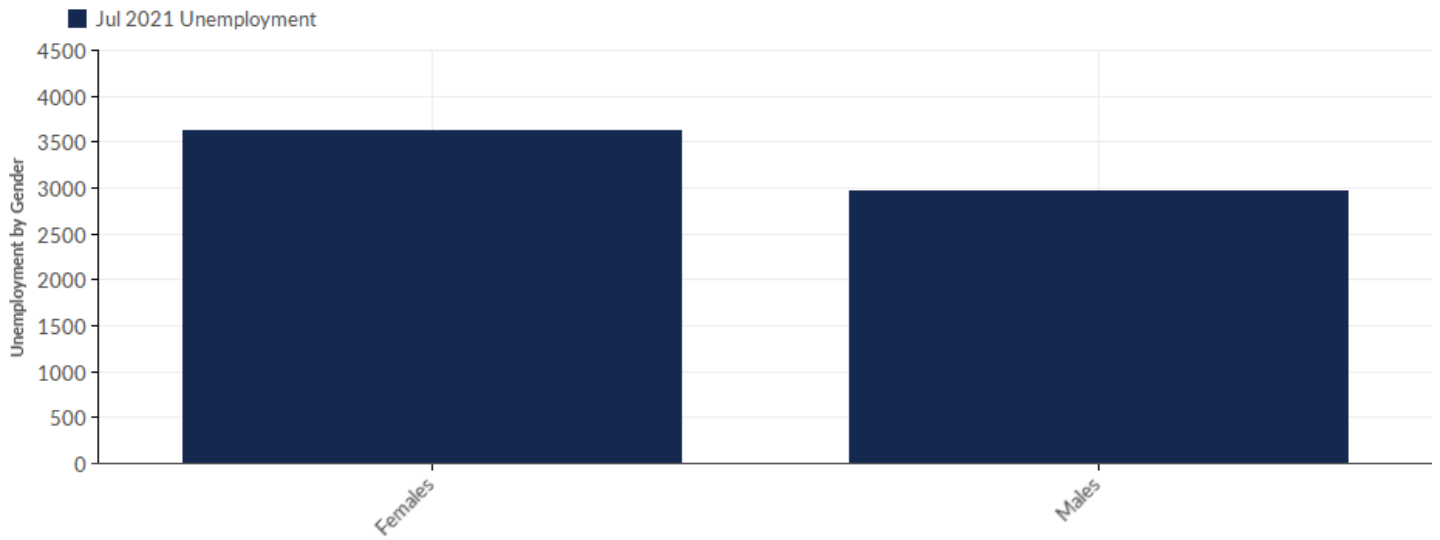

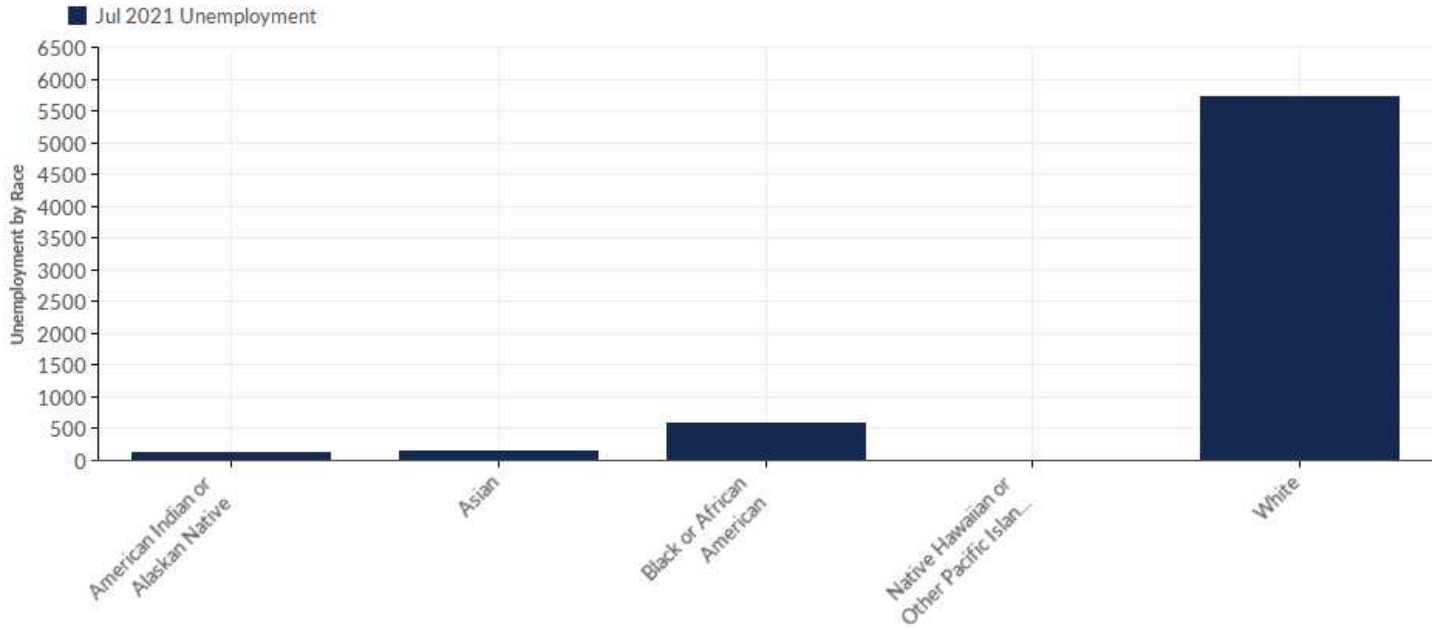

Unemployment by Gender



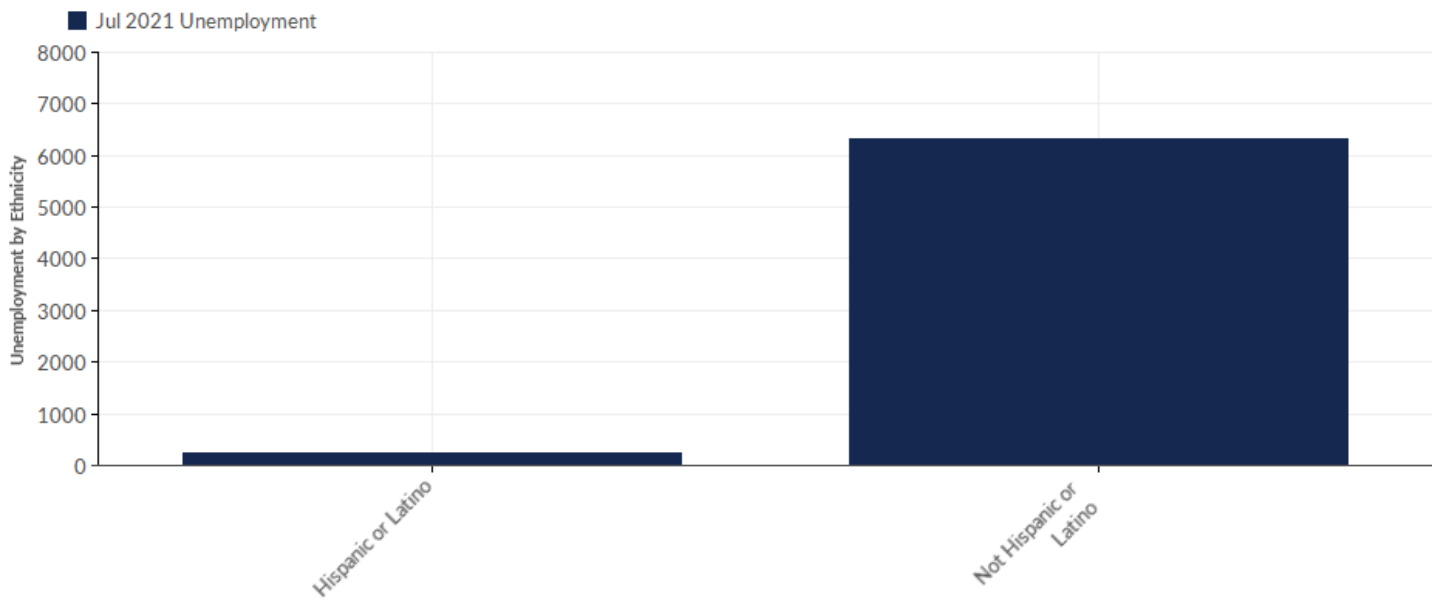

Unemployment by Ethnicity

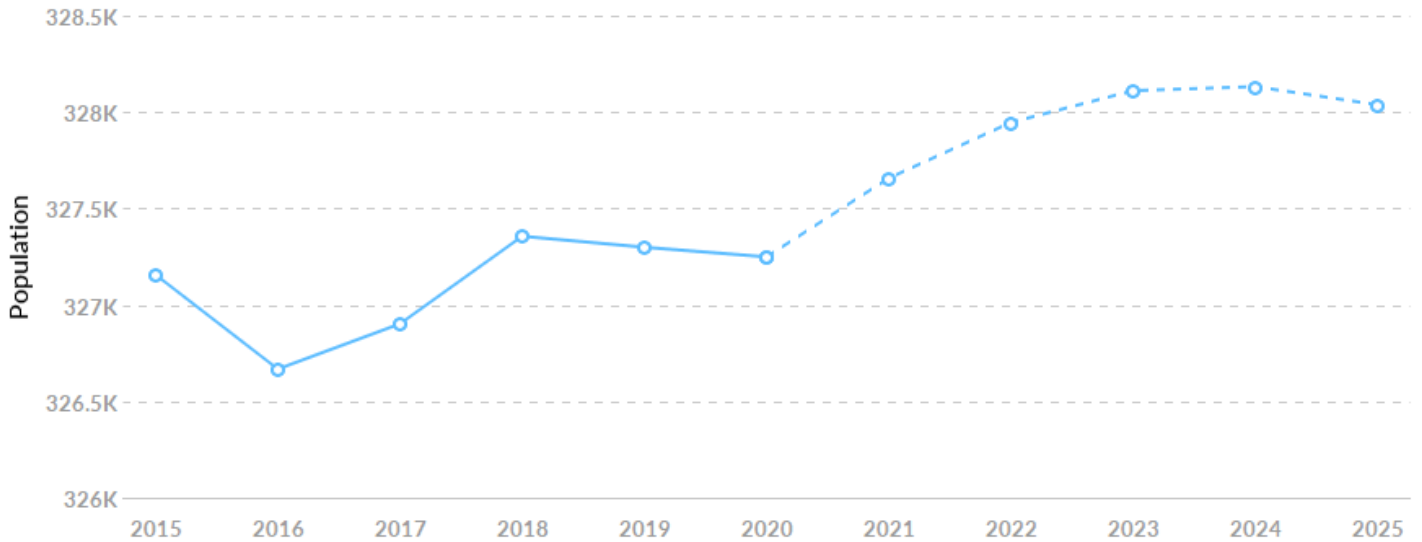

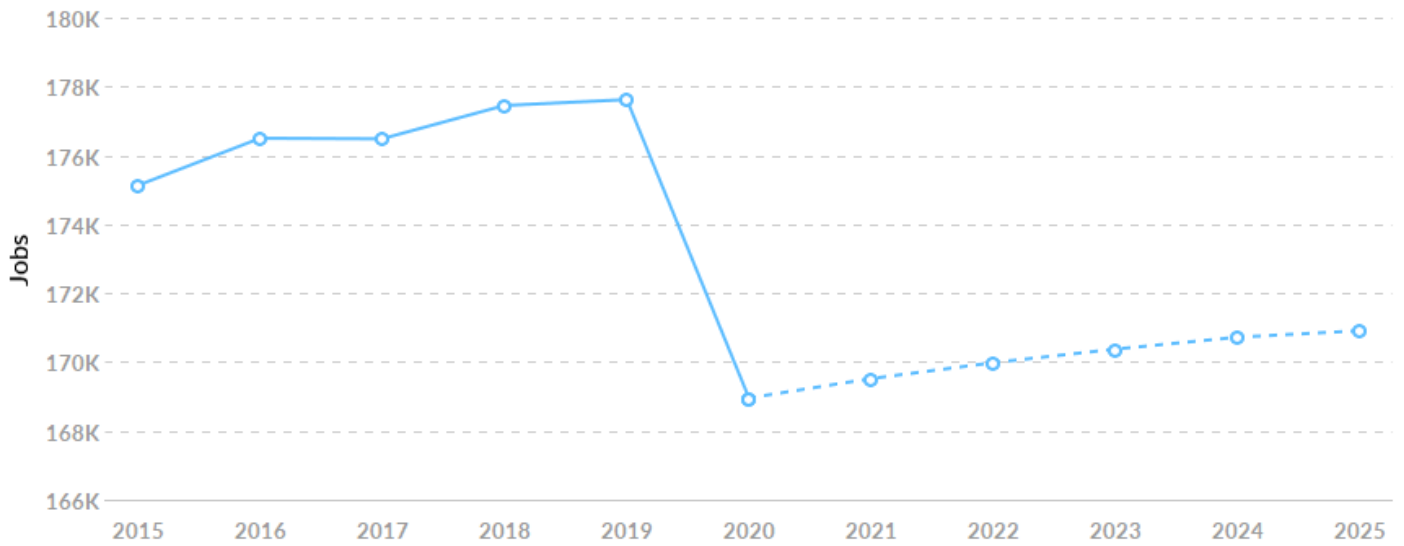

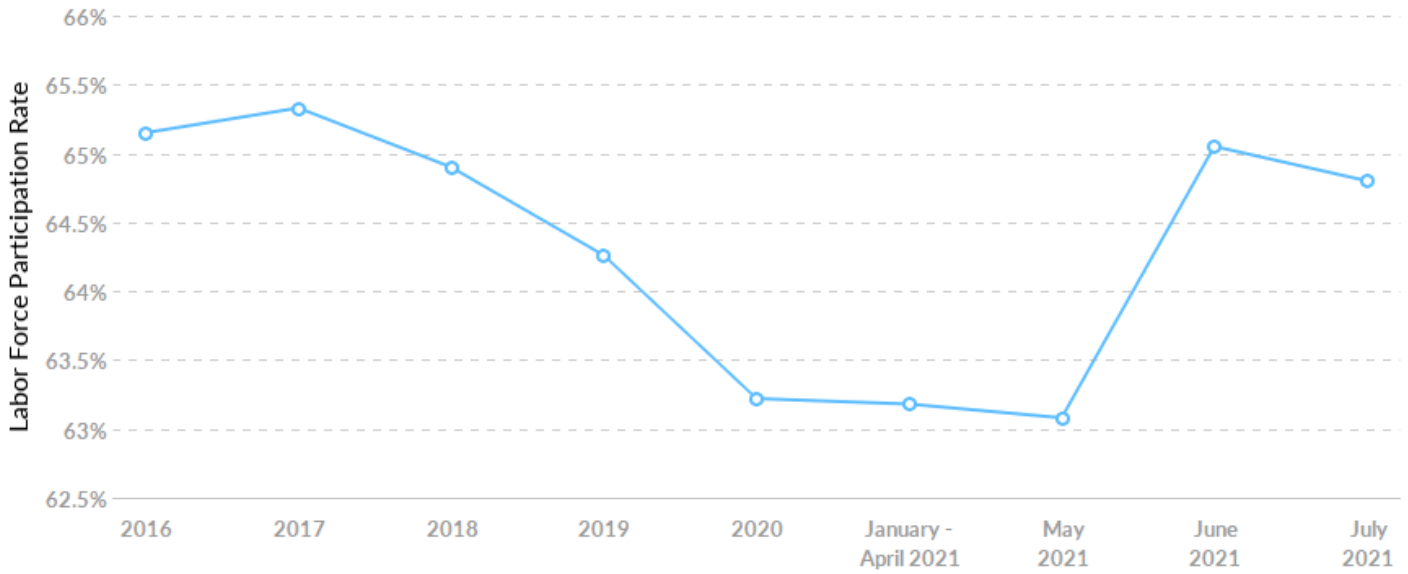
Job Trends

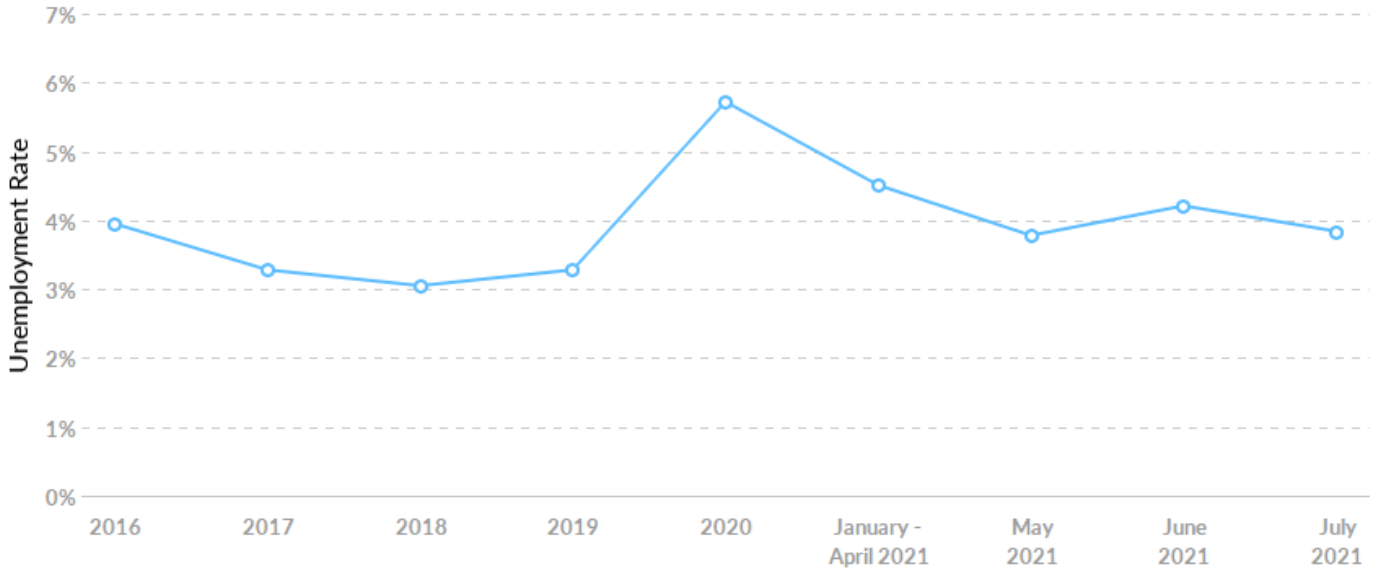

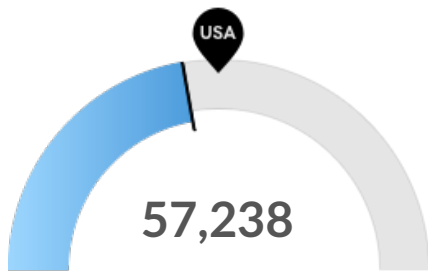

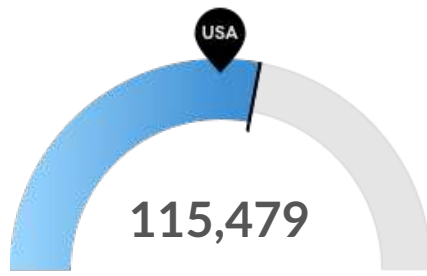

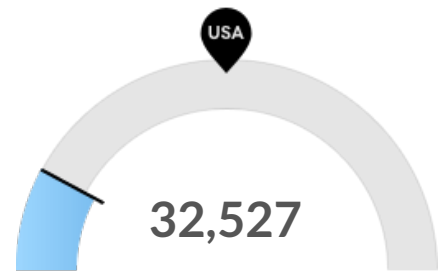
Millennials

Your area has 57,238 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 67,437.



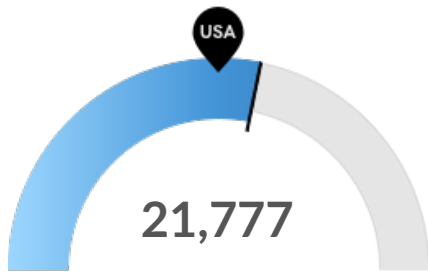
Retiring Soon

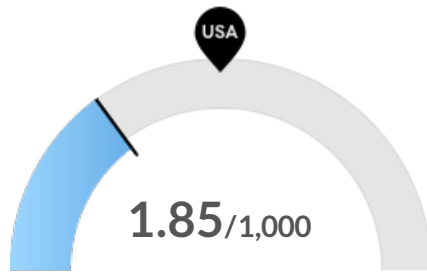
Racial Diversity

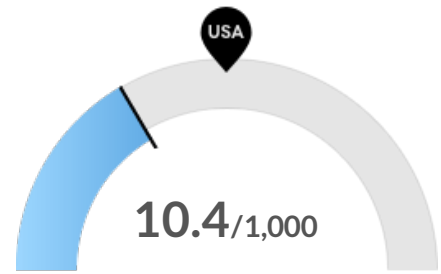
Veterans

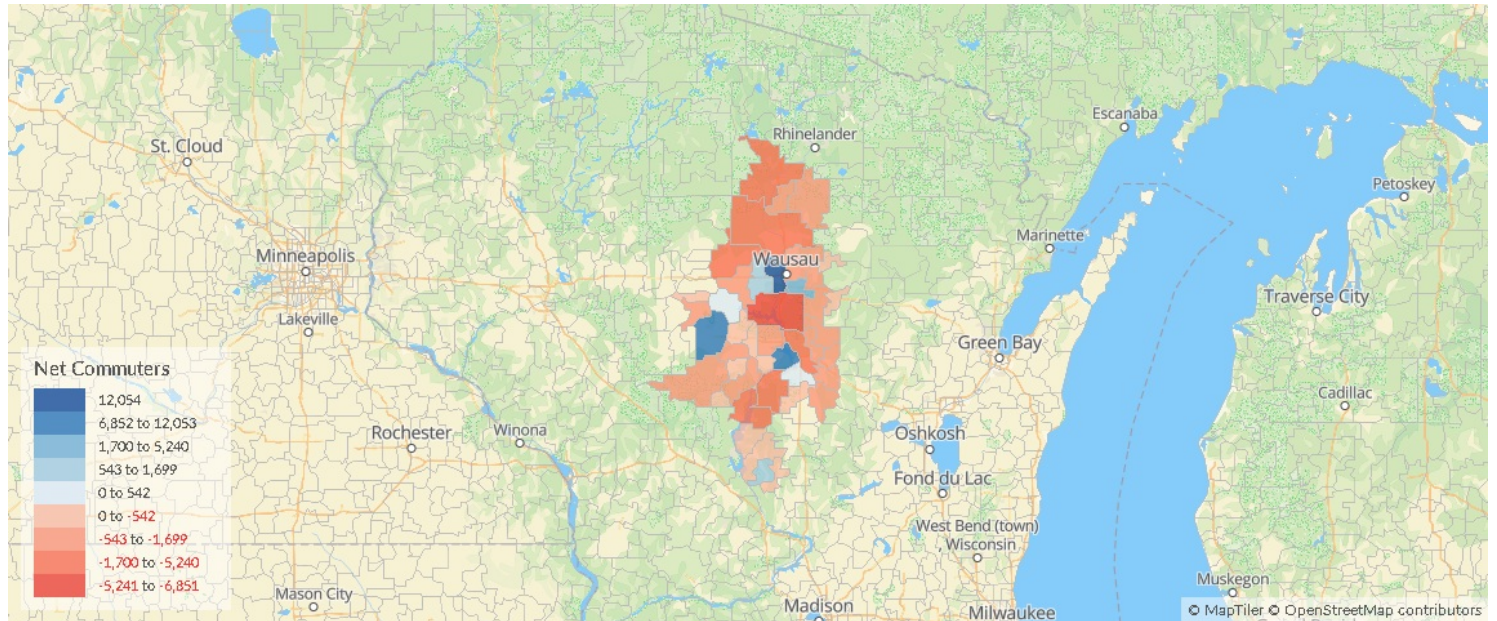

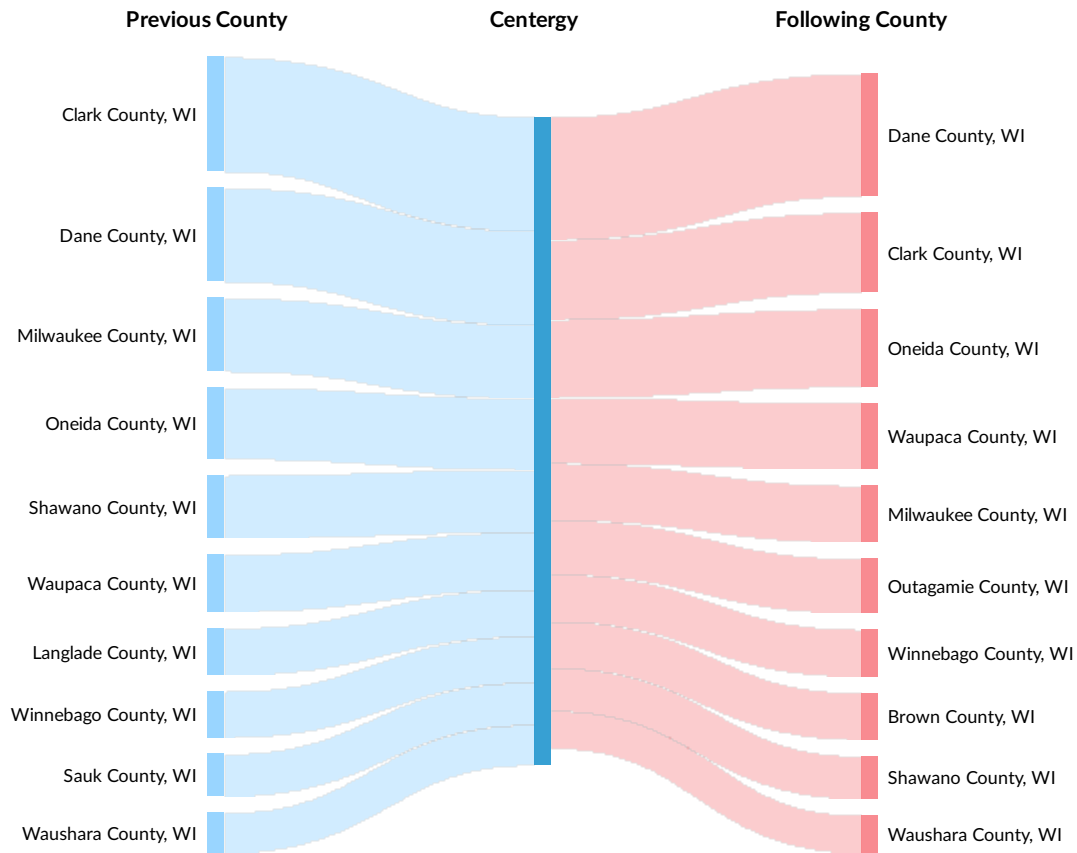

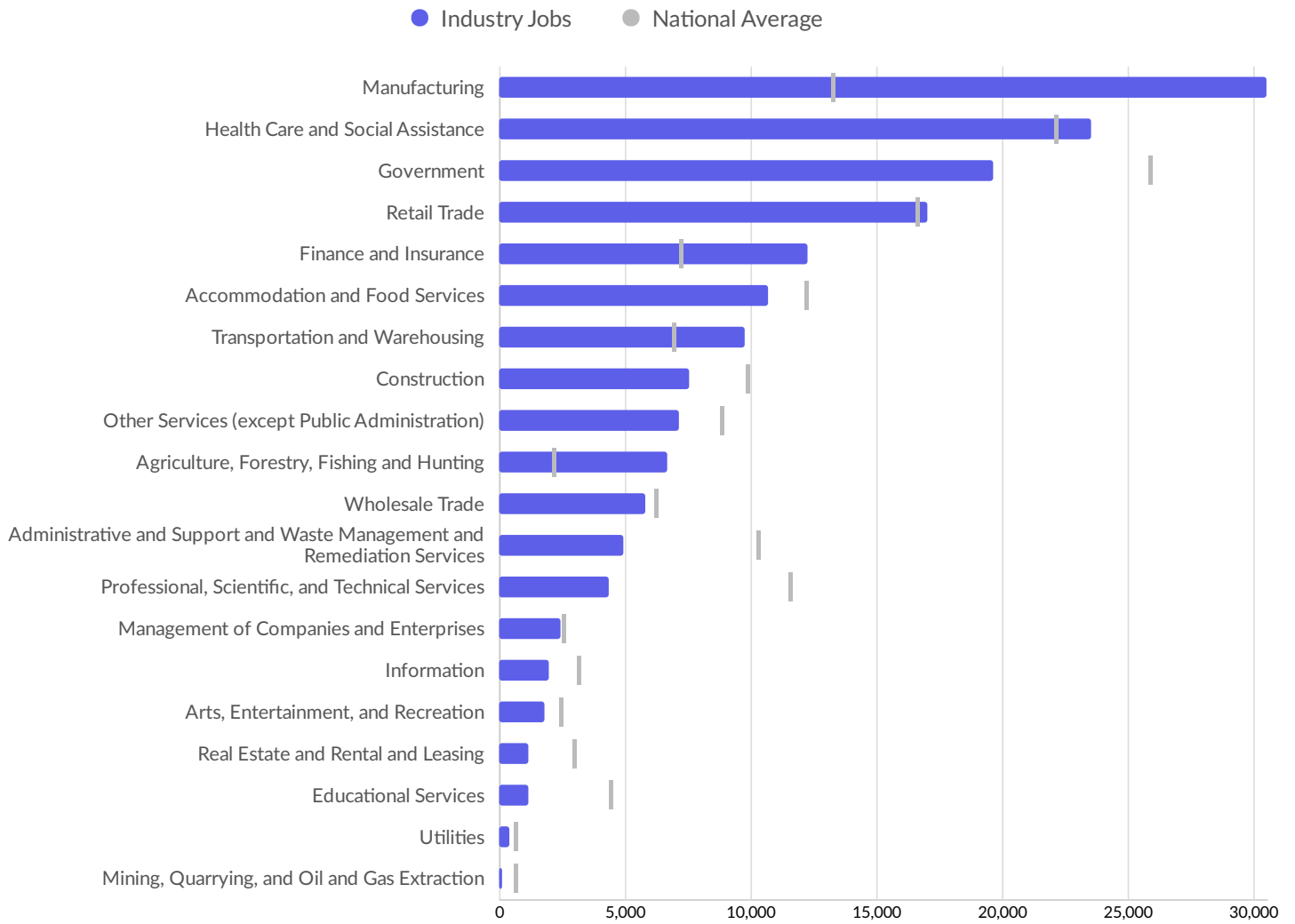

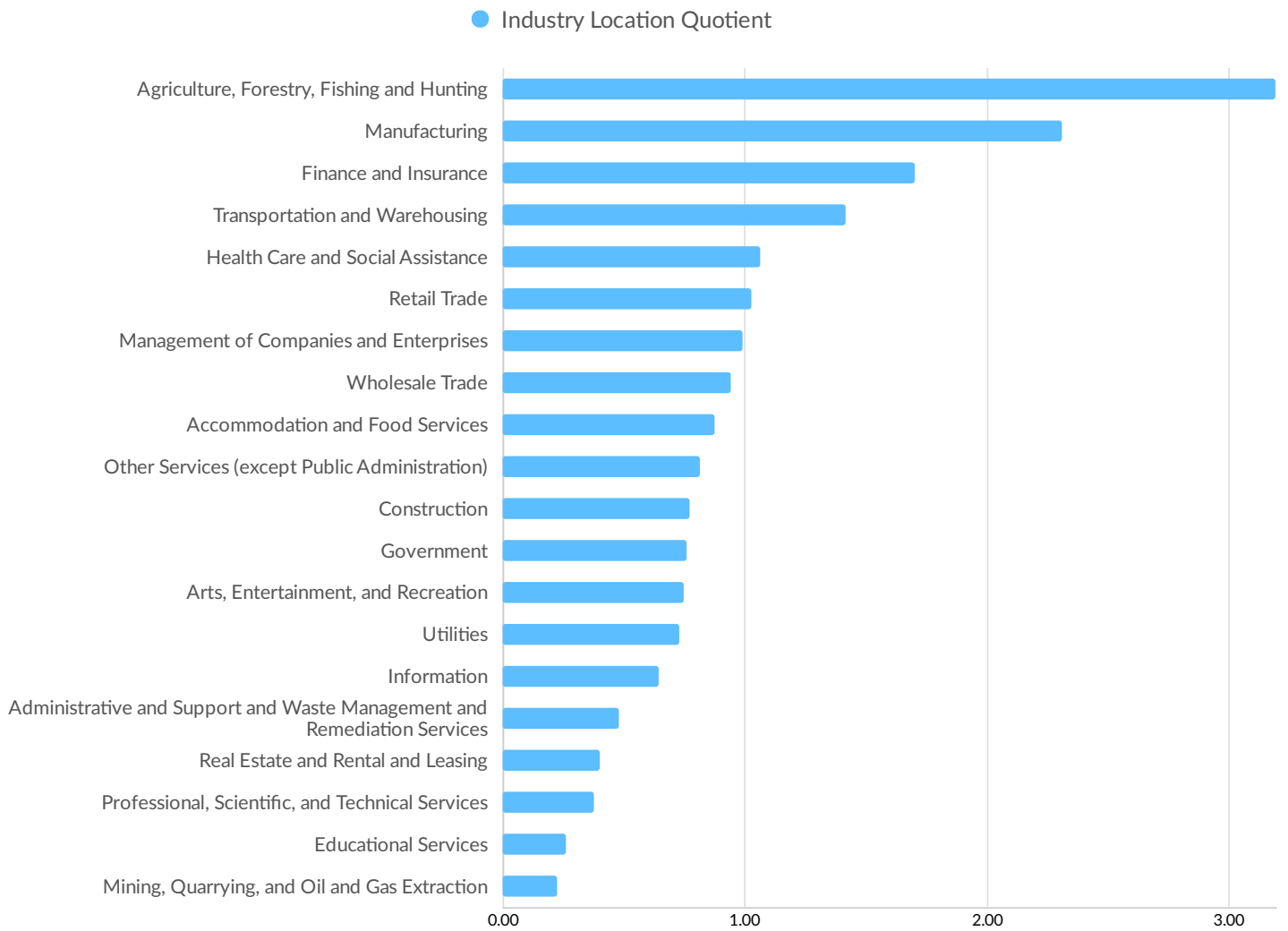

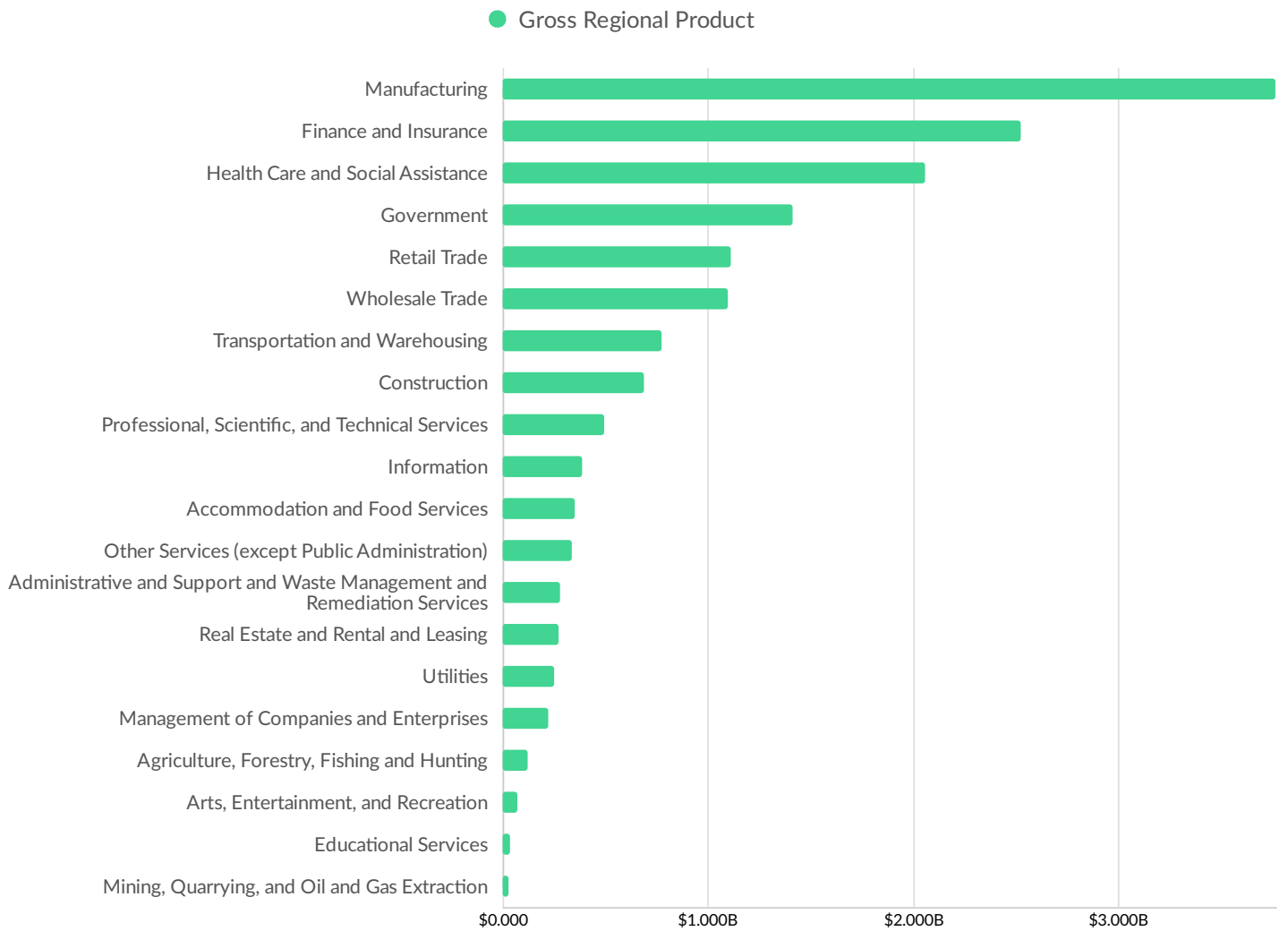
Top Growing Industries



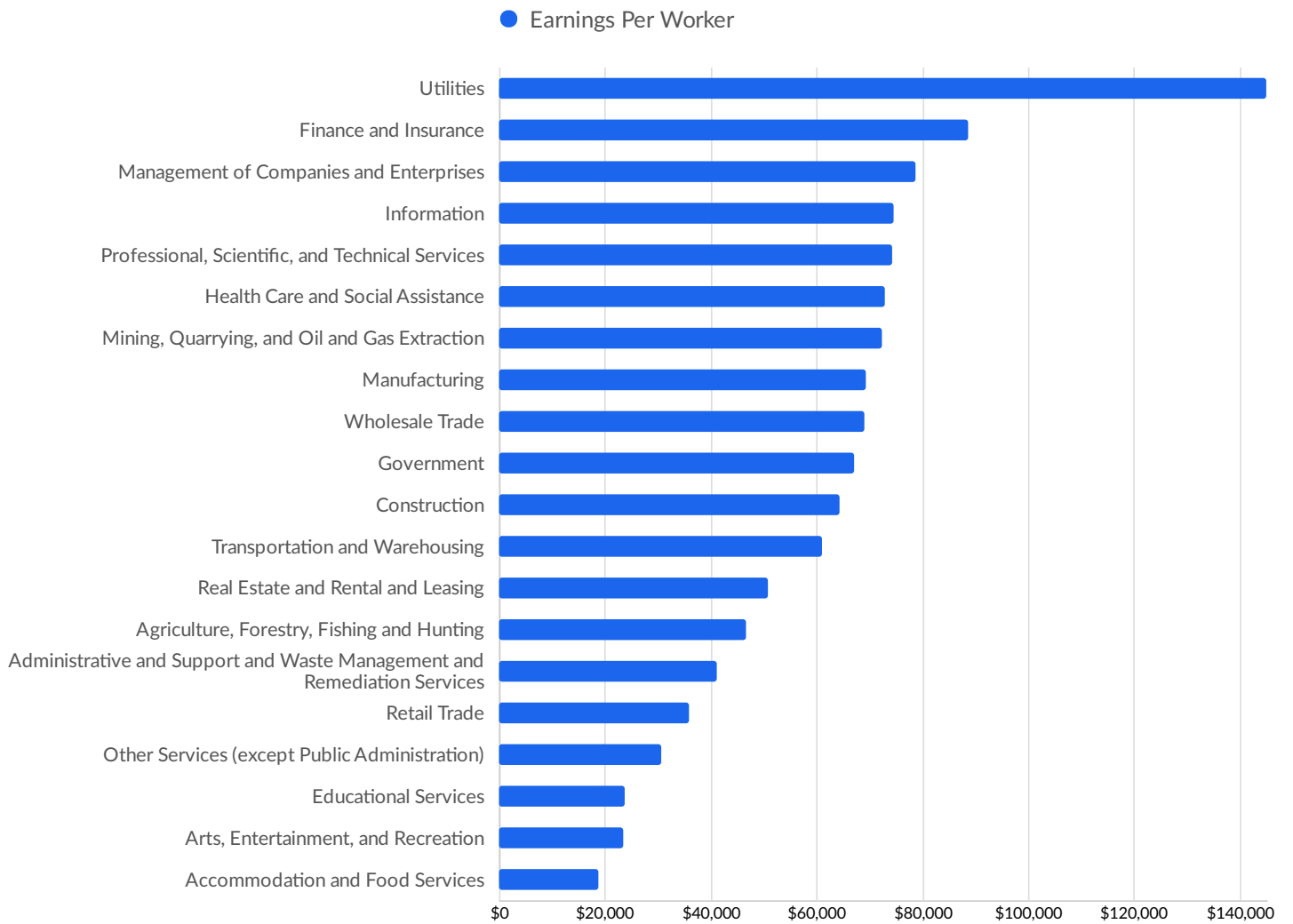
Top Industry Location Quotient

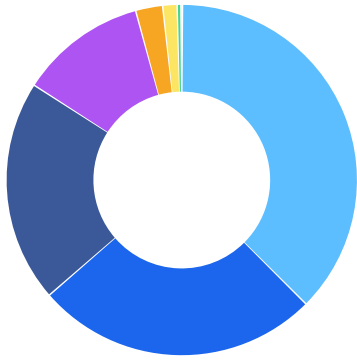

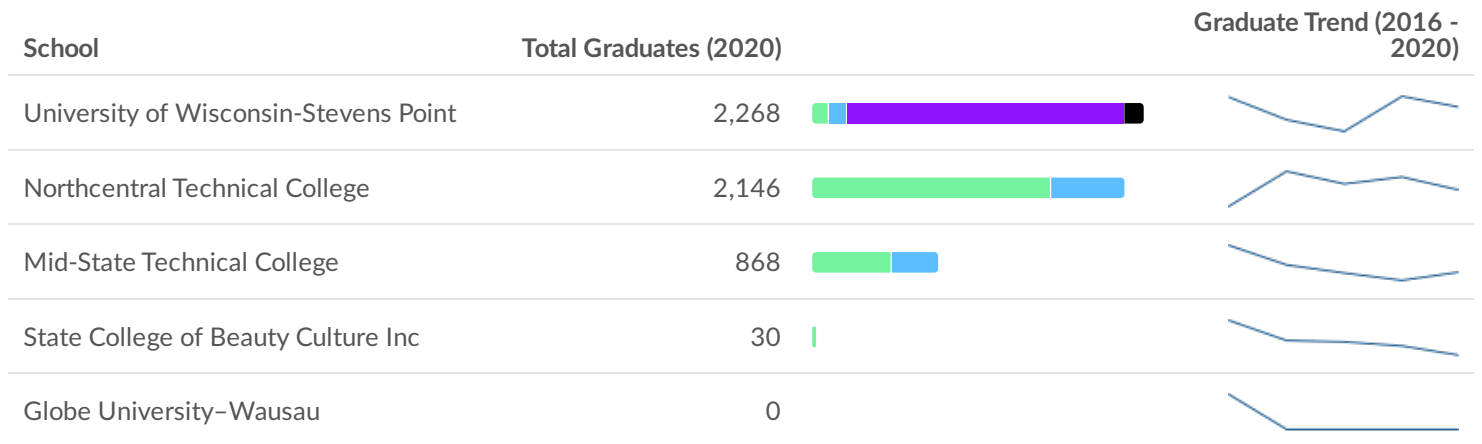
